OSLO, Norway (UP) — A famed cameraman said today pictures he took during the solar eclipse last week showed "shiny white objects like flying saucers."

Photographer Johnny Bjornulf said "it is especially interesting to find the objects" since they "nearly coincided in time with the observation of six 'flying saucers' from a BOAC plane off Labrador."

The cameraman discovered the shiny objects

The cameraman discovered the shiny objects while showing a color movie of the eclipse in London last Monday. He flew back to Norway and examined still pictures he took at the same time and saw the same objects.

Bjornulf took the pictures aboard a Scandingvian Airanes plane at 13,500 feet attitude while photographing the eclipse of the sun last Wednesday for scientists.

He said he had no like the objects were on the film until he saw the movie in London.

"My sersonal opinion is that the shining white spots of the pictures are some reflex phenomena, although I am quite sure that it is not due to any reflection in the camera lens."

He ruled out lens reflection because the objects appeared on film taken by two different cameras.

Dear Mrs. Lorensen:

Here, I believe, is a UFO report which may be significent: It comes from my daughter, Judy, aged 16. Yesterday she returned from a week's examer camp, at Littleton Depot., Mass. She said that on Monday (JULY 5) at about three p.m., while lying on the lawn, she had looked up to see a strange, sphere-like object crossing the sky from North to South at about 45 degrees above the horison. It was moving at about twice the speed of the second hand of a watch and as she watched it, she saw it base REFORE or HEHRATH some clouds. This was important, because the clouds appeared still and she said there was no wind at ground-level. In apparant size it was about a third or fourth the size of the full moon. It seemed rather glass-like or metalic and strangest of all, there seemed to be a ring ("like about Saturn") which was horisontal in position and below the "equator" of this sphere. (See drawing below.)

We have had a rash of weather baloons over this part of New England this summer which has caused a number of false "saucer" reports. I have been called to see "saucers" twice and through my telescope have clearly made out the baloons. However, because of the shape of Judy's object, plus the matter of speed with NO WIND AT GROUND LEVEL and also its passing REMEATH the clouds, one may assume that this was no baloon. What do you think it was?

Judy called other young people out to look at it, but before they arrived, it had disappeared. It made no noise at any time, Judy said.

The Little Men With Green Heads Land Again

Hold onto your space helmets, folks-reports of "flying saucers" are once more on the increase. Whether it is the advent of summer

increase. Whether it is the sevent of summer heat, the general lack of news or whatnot, we are not prepared to say. But, as the song went, "They're coming through the window; they're coming through the floor!"

Within the last two weeks two unusual sightings have been recorded. At Brookley Field, Ala., near Mobile, a number of persons spotted an unidentified flying object, "brilliant and silver colored." It made no sound nor left any trail. Radar tracked the whatsis as well.

That same night, over the Atlantic off Good Bay, Labrador, the pilot, crew and pas-

coses Bay, Labrator, the pilot, crew and pas-eagers of a British Overseas Airways plane all tracked a black "mother" ship and six satellites for as long as 20 minutes. They vanished when an American air force interceptor came up to check.

Here was a case of several competent filers who said the things "defied all available scien-

Upon reaching London, the plane load set off such a wave of saucer stories that hundreds of them are now being seen each night. Yesterday, to compound the excitement, a silvery "thing" went across London at lunch time. Turned out it was only a balloon.

There is, naturally, a direct correlation between the number of saucer sightings and the amount of publicity they receive in various news channels. But you can't write them all off, when radar and trained observers see strange things.

The air force has installed a number of spectrum cameras at various besses in 33 states and in Canada. They are designed to analyze moving lights to determine if they're merely insubstantial glows or come from unknown solid objects.

"I saw three of them dancing around in the sky, just as pretty as you please," said, Moe Simovitch, a driver for a local taxi company. "They were going terrifically fast, and in perfect formation, looked exactly like giant cigars."

NO SOLUTION

However, a call to the airways control centre at Stevenson field didn't solve the mystery of the "cigars from space," but deepened it. "Yes, we know about them,"

"Yes, we know about them," a cautious spokesman told a reporter. "They are under our control."

When pressed for further details, the spokesman broke off the conversation about "them" by saying he was "too busy to talk."

"We see them often. They're nothing unusual," a weather official commented. AIR OF MYSTERY

Yet an air of mystery remains, because of reports earlier this week on flying objects spotted near Flin Flon. According to "eye witnesses" from those localities the object was "about 100 feet in diameter, and flying 11,000 feet high."

Residents of the two areas reportedly "lined sidewalks by the hundreds to watch the strange object," and a full report has been sent to the transport department in Ottawa, it was related.

Possibly a more logical explanation is the one recently advanced by United States authorities. They admit sending out dozens of large plastic balloons skyward to obtain weather, ray, and other important data.

Several of these oversized objects have already fallen to the ground in the United States causing a veritable deluge of "flying saucer" reports to U.S. government sources.

But at least one Winnipeg man remained unconvinced. "They were cigars, all right. Fastest cigars I ever saw." up of air units from both nations. Possibly Winnipeg planes may be participating, and the "silence" from local

Last Tuesday, July 13, I spotted an ufo, but after repeated inquiries about it, I received no confirmation, nor denials for that matter. I shall describe the experience catagorically to be more concise.

Place: Northeast Portland, Oregon.

Direction of travel: From approximately five degrees west of north, travelling southeast, then east, and lastly north to disappear. The "U" turn was a foot long across the base, and it travelled parallel to the ground.

Weather conditions: Small, white cumulus clouds at 18,000 feet. Object could still be seen as it met clouds and passed through them. Doubt it could be seen if it were above clouds. After a check with the weather bureau I also found that these clouds were formed in a very unusual way. The air had condenced from having jet planes leave vapor trails through the scarce clouds at an earlier time. The rain had evaporated, however, before it reached the earth. Later, around 2:00 P. M., according to the U. S. weather bureau, these jet planes actually caused moisture in the air to form cumulus clouds. Some were as large as two inches around from where I was standing at arms length. I actually watched the latter phenomena. The planes left ordinary vapor trails which grew enormously in size to form these clouds.

Comment: I was watching the jet planes maneuvering throughout the sky. At the time I saw the ufo, the planes were flying north of my position, and about twelve degrees to the west or slightly west of the object. At 2:00 P. M. the sky was clear blue, except for the jet induced clouds. There was very little wind, and the object appeared to be floating, and in the direction of the wind. The object was round, and bright white, but not silver. It was easily discernable even against the clouds. It seemed to maintain the same altitude at all times, and on occasion appeared not to move at all. I estimated it to be above the airport which is two miles north of my home. I watched the jets when they seemed to "see" the object for the first time. They flew directly under and toward it in a straight line, but were going to fast and overshot past the object. The planes turned around and then circled it twice coming within an inch and a half to one inch of the object. The ufo floated serenely north until it disappeared in the distance. The jets were still flying about when I entered the house and phoned the air base. I had thought it was probably one of the General Mills balloons being sent about 100 miles from Fortland, but the man with whom I spoke said that they knew nothing of any object as I described, and that he doubted that it was a weather balloon. I then laughingly asked if it could have been a flying saucer, and he said that it probably was, and spoke in all seriousness. At the beginning



of our short conversation he had told me there was a project going on, but declined to ellaborate. That was as far as I got, so I phoned the Oregon daily Journal. The man at city desk asked me a number of questions, and said he'd send a man to the air base. I phoned the paper agin the next day, but was informed that the reporter got nothing more than I did. We chatted for a long time, as he was very much interested in ufo. His guess was that what I saw was something sent up for the jets to seek out. and shoot at, or else a secret weapon of some sort in which case the air force wouldn't discuss. He said that they were very tight lipped out there, and that they always had trouble getting any information from them, even things that aren't secret. The newsman was very courteous and said that his paper would publish anything outstanding or extraordinary concerning the sausers. Do you fish to have any of your more unusual sightings published in daily papers? If so, I won't mind phoning in some of them for you unless, of course, you already have someone here doing that. The Portland papers hardly ever print any saucer stories, but at least I could try if you'd like me to. My attitude is that if if these "things" actually exist, and are not government secrets, (the government emphatically denies them) then interest in these saucers should sertainly be stirred up beyond the point of joking about them. I really do believe in their existance, but somehow I find that most of the book by George Adamski about the sausers is impossible for me to believe. I do think it possible that the saucers may be from some other planet, and there is the possibility that the temperatures recorded by us of the other planets are merely the temperatures in the upper strata, especially when the earth's upper strata temperatures are so extreme. Man has learned so much, and yet knows so little.

I shall continue to send all I can accumulate concerning the ufo s.



Incident - While helping repair the roof of Mr. Paul Carter's house, his brother Jim happened to glance up to the N.W. and saw what he at first thought to be four balloons moving toward the west. Then he realized the objects were circling against the prevailing wind and he called Paul's attention to them. At this point the objects appeared at about eye level to the men on the roof and were estimated to be larger than the size of a fist held at arm's length.

The objects continued their circling motion passing out over Boston harbor before turning inland again. On the inland arc the objects were closer to the observers and Paul Carter estimated their apparent diameter at 10 to 12 inches, and their height at 2500 feet at their closest approach. The objects maintained rigid formation at all times (see sketch) as if invisibly held together, never varying in relation to each others position.

After approximately one pass had been completed,
Paul, realizing the unconventional nature of the objects,
left the roof to call the Bedford Air Force base control
tower about what he was watching. (Bedford Air Force
containing MIT's Lincoln Laboratory was within the
area being circled by the objects.) He knew the control
tower number since he flew private planes in and out of
Bedford.

Bedford responded that they knew 'all about it' and abruptly hung up. Paul, returning outside, grabbed his camera which was an a nearby table. He was in time to snap at least one and possibly three color pictures (he is now not sure of the number) as the objects made another pass.

Throughout the entire sighting the objects were totally soundless and appeared not to reflect the sun.

After two or three passes (Jim thinks two while Paul remembers three) the objects, still in formation, accelerated suddenly up into the sky. In following their path the observers saw the flashing of a Lincoln Laboratory reflector experiment (see below). To the right of the reflector could be seen a 'gray cloud' toward which the formation of objects were lost from sight because of their great distance.

Paul Carter called the Bedford tower again and spoke to a Colonel who attempted to explain the sighting as a metallic reflector attached to a balloon which had been sent up as part of an experiment by the Lincoln Laboratory (reflector dimensions - 40'x40' or 20'x20').

While speaking with the Colonel, Paul heard in the background over the phone the scrambling of two jet interceptors, presumably after the UFO's.

Not satisfied with this explanation, Paul Carter got in touch with a friend of his who was stationed at Bedford in the Air Force, then Tech. Sgt. Frederick Menard who now lives in Minnesota. He asked Sgt. Menard to try to get a look at the control tower log to see what had really gone on. The next day Sgt. Menard found that page missing that pertained to the UFO activity and was sternly warned that he would face disciplinary action if he persisted in his searching.

Paul Carter sent his film containing the UFO snapshot(s) to be processed through normal drugstore channels. After not receiving the processed film for what seemed a reasonable length of time, inquiries were made by Mr. Carter and he was told by letter from the Kodak Co in Rochester, New York that his film had been confiscated! No amount of further inquiry yielded a response and Mr. Carter dropped the whole affair. (Mr. Carter was not able to locate the letter from Kodak for our interview although he believes he still

Comment - The area enclosed by the circling objects seemed so large that one cannot pinpoint any specific location that may have attracted their interest.

It is difficult at this time to assess Air Force policy in 1954 but in view of the fact that this sighting does not appear in those parts of Air Force records which have been published and if the picture confiscation is true then there must be a large mass of material that was at one time classified and still remains so in spite of current protestations to the contrary.





Canadian Scientists First

We Trip A Flying Saucer

Ottawa, Aug. 9 (CP). — Is Canada the first country in the world to record a flying raucer with instruments?

That question is being debated here today after the Transport Department's flying saucer sighting station reported that it had detected an unexplainable object in the atmosphere over Ottawa Sunday.

Wilbert B. Smith, engineer in charge of the broadcast and measurement section of the transport Department, said the saucer station's gravimeter was tripped at 3:01 p.m.

Mr. Smith said he is convinced that the deflection on the gravimeter was not caused by an aircraft. It was either something scientists did not know about or an instrument failure,

failure.

"We now are attempting to find out if there was a failure somewhere in the instrument," he said. "If it turns out that there was no failure, then I don't know what it was that passed overhead."

Mr. Smith said it is not possible for anyone to state that the gravimeter recorded the presence of a flying saucer. However, he added, "it also is not possible to say it wasn't a flying saucer."

Mr. Smith, who built and operates the sighting station, said the deflection on the gravimeter was the first that could not be explained since the instrument was installed last October. The gravimeter is designed to detect and record Gamma rays, magnetic fluctuations, radio noises and gravity."

"I dashed over to look at the instrument," he said. "The deflection in the line (drawn by an electronically operated pen) was greater and more pronounced than we have seen even when a large aircraft has passed overhead.

"I ran outside to see what

"I ran outside to see what might be in the sky. The overcast was down to 1,000 feet, so whatever was up there, whatever it was that caused the sharp variation was concealed behind clouds. We must now ask ourselves what it could have been."






Dear Mrs. Lorenzen:

Thank you for your friendly letter. I am sorry, indeed, to hear that your health has been giving you a time, and am happy to know that things now are more promising. I have often thought that I would like to live in New Mexico or Arizona. They sound like very wonderful states.

Let me hasten to say, too, that your letter reached me today-Oct., 12, five days after mailing, and the wax seal was unbroken. So that letter, at least, seems not to have been tampered withi

I was facinated with your personal "release" to me of the Hawaii incident, and promise you that the story will not leave our four walls! It does give one an H.G. Wellesian touch of the creeps, though, to hear such things. But, perhaps, our appearance to the "saucerians" is as upsetting to them as theirs to us! Personally, I have begun to believe that we are dealing with not one "other planet" but with two or more, and that the creatures in the various craft may differ widely among themselves. As a footnote to the theory. I am including a copy of a letter I received two days ago from John J. Swaim. My mother (living in Lincoln, Mebr. sent me the clipping from the LINCOLN STAR about two weeks ago. In case you did not see it, it told of this 12-year old farm boy, who coming in from the field on his tractor, suddenly saw a queer little "man" with very long nose and very long ears, not 20 feet away behind a small rim of land. He (the little man) suddenly fled (seemed to "fly") over a small hill where the boy now saw a saucer-like device about 5 feet above the ground. It opened up, the little man (no bigger than a "five-year old child") then popped inside, the thing "lighted up" and then took off at a speed "so great that it would make our jets look like a turtle". 



SKY 'CIGAR' VISIBLE ON ITALIAN RADAR, SEEN BY THRONGS

ROME. Sept. 18 (Reuters).— The Hallan Air Force today an-nounced that one of its radar sta-tions had tracked for 39 minutes a big cigar-shaped object seen by thousands of Romans Friday

The air force said the object was shaped like a cigar cut in salf, with a big antenna amid-hips. A traif of luminous smoke bound from the pointed rear.

The object flew slowly at first, then it darted oif at great speed and disappeared. It flew at 3600 test along a 15-mile stretch of coast west of the capital.

The air force said the station at Praties of Mare, 40 miles southwest of Rome, picked up the object at 6:40 P. M. (local time) and held it on the rather screen until 7:28. Thousends of Romans phoned the police to say they had seen it.

Are Saucers Over Africa From Outer Space?

By RONALD BATCHELOR Reuters Staff Writer

AIROBI, KENYA, Oct. 16.-A leading Kenya astronomer is convinced that visitors from outer space are observing and mapping the earth, and have recently been directing their "flying saucer" flights over east Africa.

G. Duncan Fletcher, vice president of the Kenya Astro-nomical Association, came to this conclusion after studying the deluge of flying saucer reports from observers in Ugan-da, Kenya and Tanganyika.

Fletcher himself recently observed something in the sky over Nairobi from his observatory here. "It was about 7:40 p

I had four friends in my ob-servatory," he relates. "Very low and toward the east, there was a large light in the sky which had no relationship to anything astronomical, to Verey lights or to the aircraft which had just landed at the airport."

THE ALTITUDE of the "object" was about 2000 feet. It was stationary when first spotted and "emitted a bright or-ange light." This light brightened to a yellowish color and the object rose, dropped and then rose again, finally disap-pearing through the clouds.

Fletcher says there is no question about the genuineness of reports about flying saucers, which "have been given by very experienced observers" in all parts of the

"Not all the people who have seen these unidentified flying objects have been suffering from hallucinations," he de-

THE MOST encouraging thing about reports of unidentified flying objects, Fletcher avers, is that "they seem to be friendly towards the people of this planet."

"There does not seem to be any doubt that they are miles ahead of us in their methods of propulsion, and reports have been made by observers who have seen these unidentified flying objects over atomic plants, dockyards, airfields, naval bases and some of the larger cities of the world.

"THEIR APPROACH to us is, I suggest, similar to what our own approach would be if the boot were on the other foot. Suppose we were to visit Venus. I do not think that, until we had made every pos-

sible investigation, we would

"The obvious thing is that we should map, photograph if possible and carry out a thorough investigation before we wantonly risked life by hasty landings.

It is not unreasonable, therefore, that whatever controls the unidentified flying objects is doing exactly that."

FLETCHER IS CERTAIN that the objects come from outer space and says that "their behavior cannot be mistaken for a meteorite which, on coming into contact with our atmosphere, is pulled at an ever-increasing velocity by gravity towards the earth. This velocity becomes so great that the object burns up because of the intense heat generated by friction with our atmos-

"A meteorite does not rise or hover in the air. Its path is a parabolic curve similar to that of a shell fired from a gun. Therefore, the things which we have seen are undoubtedly unidentified flying objects."

Fletcher doesn't pretend to know how the objects operate, what they contain or where they come from. But he gives this advice: "Vigilance and a friendly approach to their overtures would appear to be the best course to follow."





EXPLANATION: This is, at best, a sketchy recollection of my own personal sighting of UFOs back in Oct-Nov 1954. I do not recall the date nor the exact month, the year could possibly be 1953 but I'm fairly certain it was 1954. I was then a Weather Observer at Reese Air Force Base, Lubbock, Texas. This base is (was) located approx. 15 miles west of Lubbock, and 20 miles east of Levelland, Texas. These observations were witnessed by other Weather Observers and tho ugh no higher military authority acted upon them they were recorded, by the Weather Observer on duty, in the column reserved for remarks that are not disseminated over teletype, on the official weather record (The WBAN 10A).

RECOLLECTION:

Time: about 9:15 PM on a Sunday evening in Oct-Nov 1954. Word came to me that the PIBAL (Winds Aloft) Observer was witnessing "Flying Saucer Formations" from the observation platform atop the one-story Operations Building on the Reese AFB flight-line. As I recall, there were three of us who kept with it for two hours, but there probably were more among us for a shorter time. Sergeant Robert Gift, Airman Jerome H. Carney and myself were the three.

The first sighting for me occurred at approx. 9:45 PM: A V-formation of approx. ten elliptical lights (not unlike blue-white reciprocating engine exhaust flames), each the size of 1/4 the diameter of a dime (held at arms length), the formation being as wide as 1/2 the long edge of a dollar bill and the angle of the formation being 120° to 130°. These dimensions apply when formation was closest. In three seconds time the "lights", keeping formation, travelled a slightly curved arc across the star studded sky, beginning 20° above the horizon at an azimuth of about 320° reaching a zenith of 20° off the vertical and at azimuth 220° and then being lost from sight at 20° above the horizon at 160° azimuth. There was no sound. Their swiftness and silence convinced me they were niether birds nor aircraft. No reasonable estimate of altitude was possible, even for experienced viewers such as ourselves.

Another sighting, as I recall, occurring within half-an-hour of the last, was quite similar with these exceptions: This V-formation came from the west, 280°,. Within one second one single "light" broke off and curved to the north, disappearing at a relatively high vertical angle, 45°, at 310° azimuth. Holding our prime attention, the full formation veered sharply to the south as it reached our zenith (two seconds after sighting) and was lost from view in about the same area of sky as the 9:45 sighting. All this happened within four seconds.

Two or three more formation sightings were witnessed by me on this night; each containing no less than five nor more than twelve "lights". A smaller number of solo "lights" were observed as well, some making abrupt changes in direction. "Light" activity waned after 11:30 PM and thereafter we each drifted away, with the exception of course of those on duty.

THE OBSERVATIONS I re-lated in detail in the preceding articles* were almost all made in France. Before continuing my rapid recollection of these flying saucer sightings, I must underline two importants points.

r. 





Mr Gustavo Gonzalez de Leon owns a Panel Delivery Truck and earns his living transporting foodstuff to market. In order that produce should reach market in Caracas in time he has to go to Petare early in the morning, get the stuff there from the producers and be back in time to catch the early morning rush. He always reaches Petare at around 2.00 a.m. in the morning of the same door place on the third or fourth of

On Sunday morning last, he, Custavo Gonzalez together with his helper Jose Ponce reached Petare at 2.00 a.m. and on turning into the street leading to a sausage factory, to the immense surprise of the two men, they found the road blocked by a sort of luminous sphere, some eight to ten feet in diameter, and which illumined the area as though it was midday, and was SUSPENDED ABOUT SIX FEET OFF THE GROUND



Winnipeggers See Weird Object In Sky

A round white "object" with a pink ring around it made a three-hour appear-ance over Winnipeg Tuesday night — unless a couple of dozen Winnipeggers were suffering from the same hallucination.

The Thing showed up ex-actly two days after an "ob-ject" was seen by a number of airmen at the Gimli air station and a "something" was seen by a farmer at Belmont, Man.

Whether the Thing, the Object and the Something were all the same, nobody in either the air force of the weather bureau at Stevenson field was prepared to say Wednesday morning. The air force declined to say whether any of its personnel spotted the Thing. The weather bureau said it did not see it.

But at 8.30 p.m. or shortly thereafter, Murnie McIntyre, a truck driver, of 253 Ellen street, saw "a thing like a steady light moving across the sky like a meteor." the sky like a meteor.

He called the attention of Norman Kowsof, 14, of the same address to it and Nor-man called the attention of all the children on the block to it. The agreed description: thing something like a

mefeor, only bigger and moving across the sky and disappearing to return about every 15 minutes. Don Dickson, 14, says he thought it was "trailing red streaks." The "oohs" and "ahs" and

shouts and howls of the children brought the rest of the block to windows and doors. Some phoned radio stations and the weather bureau where reports of it were coming in from the rest of the city.

Meanwhile, sitting by his radio at 125 Tait avenue, Avrom Kushner, a Grade 11 student, son of a lawyer and regarded as "a very bright student" by the principal of West Kildonan Collegiate, heard the report and looked out the window. There over the treetops was the Thing.

By over the treetops, Avrom explained, he referred to its position in the sky. It might have been five, 50 or 500 miles away. He trained nine-power binoculars on it. It was white in the centre, with a pink hazy ring around it. It seemed to grow larger and larger, as it apparently drew near. Then it would fade back till the white spot became a tiny pinpoint. Then it drew nearer again, became very large, moved from side to side and up and down. Then it faded. This kept up

for over two hours.
Avrom's mother, Mrs. C. N. Kushner, looked at it. Fred Whiting, a CKY announcer, rushed out to check Avrom's reporter and, says Avrom, the announcer gazed on it

for a while too.
The Thing differed in description from the Something. John Beckam, a man who had always been skeptical about flying saucers, says that he saw "something like a meteor" in the sky near his home at Belmont Sunday night. "It seemed to be a blend of fiery red and blue and green undertones and altogether it gave the impression of tremendous heat," he wrote the Free Press, "As it travelled there were flashes of fire as if it were flaring from the parent body. It also left a long trail of fire behind it."

"I am convinced that it was a powered missile guided by intelligent beings." Mr. Beck-ham declared. "But I can't emphasize too strongly that this is not an hallucination on my part."

NO REPORT

The air force had nothing to report on its investigation of what four airmen des-cribe as a "flying object" seen near Gimli three hours before Mr. Beckham saw his phenomenon.

And weather observers de clare emphatically they did not see the Thing. Perhaps, they said, it was simply their wind balloon. But the wind balloon was up at the wrong time. One weather observer had only a question to offer:

"Did anybody happen to notice," he asked, "if between the white centre and the pink ring there were any little green men?"

Winnipeg, Mani Toba Eight miles east of Alliance is located the small town of Damascus, which has contributed several exceptional UFO reports. One of the sightings is absolutely incredible - a big rumbling object seen at close range which frightened a housewife nearly into hysterics. I found out about this incident nine days after it happened. In the course of an afternoon saucer discussion with John Krizay (Jr.), a college student in my chemistry class and a former B-47 crew chief. John mentioned the Damascus sighting. He had heard about it from a friend who knew Keith Sidinger, the observer's husband. Only one or two intimate friends had been told about the sighting. John arranged for an interview and on December 3, 1954, we drove to the Sidinger farmhouse on Route 534 a half mile north of U.S. Route 62 at Damascus.

Both Keith and Polly Sidinger were 25 years cld. They admitted that they had seen "objects" on several occasions but had kept their sightings hushed up for fear of gossip and ridicule. They obviously were not publicity-seekers or hoaxers; both urged me to keep rather quiet about it. not to mention their names or the locality in my report. (I abided by this for a while.) Understandably, Polly was not particularly anxious to relate her experience to me. During our conversation I could easily see by her facial expressions that she was reliving her experience. In fact, the Sidingers impressed me as being honest, sincere, straightforward people. Without a doubt in my mind, I am convinced that they told me nothing but the complete truth.

Keith Sidinger was a TV repairman and worked late. He also was a radio ham. Around midnight Polly usually turned on her husband's radio set and waited for Keith to call on his mobile unit. At 12:30 a.m. (EST) Tuesday, November 9, 1954. she had the set on and was waiting for his call when suddenly she heard a rumble outside the house. At first she thought it was a nearby train, but the rumble became almost deafening and rattled the windows and the dishes in a corner cupboard. Looking out a front window, she saw to her amazement a huge, glowing, oblong object hovering over Goshen High School directly across the road and not more than about 200 feet away. Polly's senses were thoroughly jolted and she couldn't believe her own eyes at first. But there it was - definitely a solid, material object with a dull metallic skin giving off a pale glow. Polly said she noticed no detail on the object's surface. The thing was practically as long as the old portion of the school it hovered over, which would make the UFO roughly 100 feet in length.

Now Polly heard a jet flying over at an extremely low altitude, possibly searching the area. She was becoming panicky, frightened, but she claimed the object seemed to vanish - one moment it was there, the next it wasn't! After the jet had circled a few times and gone away, the UFO appeared again in its former position. Just before it vanished for the second and final time, it dropped a small, sparking object like a ball of fire that might have fallen on or back of the school. The UFO's second disappearing act was exactly like the first.

When Keith arrived home - he said he heard a faint hum in the southeast - he found his wife frightened, shaking, and crying. He said he had never seen her so upset.

This close-up observation of a UFO took place during the fall saucer wave of 1954 when the mystery objects were being seen near or on the ground in Europe and South America. There were many reports from all over Ohio and locally. Among the local sightings in November was one describing a "cigar-shaped object with three pale orange lights on its side" seen on the 12th at Loyal Oak, just west of Akron (from Fred Kirsch's Fils) and one by amateur astronomer James Ansley (Jr.) who saw two orange oval-shaped objects projecting 3 or 4 beams of light from each side on the 15th at Alliance.

The Nevember 9 case was carried in the APRO Bulletin of April 15, 1955.

The Sidingers recalled other sightings. Back in the summer of 1951, about 2:30 one morning, Folly was watching a late, late movie on TV. Suddenly the picture on the screen began to flutter. Just a plane passing over, they thought. Keith went upstairs to the bathroom. For about 15 minutes the flutter continued, building up at a frightening tempo until the picture disappeared completely. The screen image remaining produced closely spaced rhythmic white flathes turning the dark room to a ghostly flickering daylight. The volume acted in a similar pattern. Polly quickly turned off the set and called her husband. In the bathroom Keith heard a loud pulsating hum coming from outside. Then an orange glare bathed the walls with a weird light and vanished. Keith looked out the window but could see nothing. Polly had seen the same light through a window below. Keith said the hum was similar to a "60-cycle note, only pulsating" and reproduced the sound on his shortwave set. Neither had seen the actual craft.

The next sighting occurred about 3 a.m. in the spring of 1954. Keith was listening in on the 75-meter band of his short-wave set on the back porch when the volume began to fluctuate. It became so bad that he turned off the set. Then he heard a pulsating hum of the 60-cycle type and looked outside. High overhead in the sky was an orangish light which







PROFESSOR BORIS BOSSIO SAW A LUMINOUS BODY AT THE LEVEL OF THE "CHAIR OF CARACAS" (name of this mountain). The strange gadget emitted "beams" of intermittent light and after 20 minu tes started up in a straight ascension. The luminous globe was seen by the famous Mathematics professor between 10 and 11 ho urs in the night d, last sunday, 28th .- Prof. Boris Bossio, ma-

thematician, author of numerous textbooks of mathematics for high school and professional s tudies, a man of absolute seriousness and far from all publicity stunt, and last sunday, between 10 and 11 in the night, one of his most exciting experiences as a man and as an astronomy fan. "At first, states Prof. Bossio to our reporter, I thought of going to the offices of National Security, at Los Dos Caminos, as my house is only two blocks far from there, but then I decided to keep it as an impressive experience, only shared by me and my wife. The next day, many persons like me, at Los Palos Grandes, had seen the sa me strange luminous globe, in the Chair of Caracas (Avila mts) right perpendicularto the sumnit of the mountain; and then, when I read about the news that the newspapers brought monday morning, I surprised and felt all full of doubts and wondering. Prof. Bossio, a man of seriousness and uncapable of believing anything not proved by logic and reasoning, until sunday, Prof. Bossio doubted of the existence of flying saucer and mysteriou s celestial bodies. He even doubts of the fight the meat-trader had with the crewman of the saucer, and can't relate one thing to the other. Yet, his' might be a very serious investi gation that may unsolve the phenomenon. Tells Prof. Boris Bossio that, around 10 and 11 in the night (sunday) he was in the yard of his house, when suddenly, at the right side of the mountain called "the chair of Caracas" being the city wrapped with a thick fog, which made impossible any visibility, he was surprised by a very luminous body, of giant size, which emitted "beams" of light intermittently. Then he went up to his terra ce(roof) and there he was able to behold the phenomenon in all its magnitude. He called upon his wife and he asked her: What do you see? ... She said: "A gigantic thing that emits lu minous rays, right of the mountain, at its level, but without touching the ground. That is, like "suspended", hanging in the space, right at the same lever as the summit of the "chair". And that was exactly what he was seeing. The thing kept that position, throwing off luminous "beams" which pierced through the wall of fog, extraordinarily, by ten minutes. Afterwards, it began to diminish until fampletely faded.
