

Dr. J. Allen Hynek, "Mr. UFO" passed away on April 27, in Scottsdale, Arizona, after suffering from a brain tumor. Dr. Hynek's death came just 5 days before his 76th birthday. The May issue of the <u>MUFON UFO</u> <u>JOURNAL</u> will include a memorial tribute to this pioneer in UFO research who dedicated 38 years of his life to resolving the UFO phenomenon.




MOST UNUSUAL

Worcester Section Director Jules Vallincourt has been researching reports from Washington State of huge chunks of earth that have been cut out as if by a'cookie cutter'. These chunks have been measured up to 10 feet long and 7 feet wide, and 2 feet thick. They weigh tons. These chunks have been found up to 75 feet from where they were removed. There are no marks to indicate that machines have been used. Also investigating this phenomenon are Interior Department geologists.
