Yvonne Smith Speaks Her Feelings About the Unfair Dealings By UPN And "Lake County Alien Abduction"

More fallout over UPN 50's "Alien Abduction" Hoax

I just want everyone to know that when I agreed to do the interview for Dick Clark Productions, it was as an "abduction expert", I answered questions regarding abduction cases, specifically, from my own caseload. I was not commenting on the video of the "McPhearson abduction", for the simple reason that I did not see the video prior to the airing of the show. The first time I had the opportunity to view the video was with everyone else the first night the show aired. The researcher from Dick Clark Productions

who originally contacted me did tell me that they were planning on showing a video of an "alleged abduction" but, as he told me, their feeling was that it was "probably a fake".

What everyone has to keep in mind is that sex and sensationalism sells in our society and that is exactly what Dick Clark Productions did, they went for the ratings, and, ladies and gentlemen, their ratings went through the roof! As far as I'm concerned, I did my job as an "abduction expert" and I will continue doing interviews and talking about abductions until the subject can be once and for all "out of the closet" and the millions of people who have had these experiences can speak freely and openly about what has been happening to them throughout their lives. What keeps me moving ahead in this work is seeing the constant pain and disruption in people's lives when trying to deal with their experiences.

Am I sorry for appearing on the show? My answer is ABSOLUTELY NOT! I am an "abduction expert" and I will continue my work until we get some answers!! For all of you abductees out there, don't give up, my colleagues and I will continue fighting for you!

Michigan MUFON Interviews John Shepherd, Director of:

PROJECT S.T.R.A.T.

"To explore the mysteries of the cosmos and enlighten those around us with knowledge unlocked from the heavens."

Project S.T.R.A.T. (Special Telemetry Research and Tracking) was established in the Spring of 1972 just outside of Elk Rapids, Michigan. Hard work and dedication brought the project into full operation by the Summer of 1973. The project has grown steadily ever since.

Kewadin Michigan — It's late summer, 1972, and the first ULF (Ultra Low Frequency, 40 hertz to 20 kilohertz) radio marker beacon started broadcasting a 150- watt ULF sequential pulse toward the starry heavens. By the early fall of 1973, John Shepherd found himself investigating in the midst of a massive UFO flap (from the ULF point of view). The flap covered not only Michigan (Antrim County/Dexter/Ann Arbor Sightings) but the entire country and still more sightings were being reported all over the world.

Article by David E. Caywood In those days, what began as a love affair with electronics and the possibility of contact with non-terrestrial beings, coupled with a passion for Ufology, has lead John Shepherd down a road stretching over more than 25 years of research and study. John Shepherd has

gained curious insights into the field of Ultra Low Frequency receiving and transmitting, thus expanding the goals and scope of Project S.T.R.A.T. which is: To explore the mysteries of the cosmos and enlighten those around us with knowledge unlocked from the heavens.

It was in the fall of 1973 and sightings in Antrim County that were really the impetus for Project S.T.R.A.T., recalls John Shepherd. "Actually, the sightings began out near the airport and then spread out from there. I picked up the electromagnetic signals from the UFO's at somewhere in the range of 400 to 800 hertz in the form of harmonic interference, (ULF) range. Far from normal and not naturally occurring in nature (cosmic back ground radiation etc...) At the exact same time as I was picking up telemetry tracking of the objects, eye-witnesses were calling the Local Sheriff's Dept. to report the incredible sightings. I was fairly certain that what I had tracked and received were what the witnesses had observed. After that, I worked with the Sheriff's Dept to help track and identify objects, such as the ones we experienced that fall. It was incredible!"

Since that time, Project S.T.R.A.T. has grown (see picture below) to include a two story accelerator and thousands of square feet of telemetry, receiving, transmitting, and broadcasting equipment occupying more than 4,000 square feet of John's home. At one point he even built an addition to accommodate the extra equipment (mainly for the two story accelerator, a 1,000-watt, 60,000-volt deep space radio transmitter).

Besides tracking and receiving, Project S.T.R.A.T. is dedicated to transmitting. Curious about what John was transmitting, I asked him to explain it in more detail. "Mostly, I transmit music and tonal pulses and patterns. Over the past 12 years, I have been broadcasting a wide variety of jazz, ethnic, folk and electronic music into space, for about six to eight hours daily. To more accurately "home them in" a 24-hour vertical marker beacon signal is used."

When asked why he transmits music, John replied: "Music doesn't take decoding and if any being has a spirit, that being will naturally gravitate toward it (music). I use music because it goes right to the soul. As things change, so will the project and its direction. In

the future, I'll be concentrating more on new areas of scientific research and less on the electrical equipment development end, which has been so much a part of the early years for Project

S.T.R.A.T.

I was wonderfully surprised by his good natured humor and his insatiable curiosity to know. Intrigued, I asked him what had compelled him to choose such challenging life direction as Project S.T.R.A.T. John replied: "Most of my life has been a genuine challenge, due to my strong and compulsive desire to seek out answers to things that have intrigued me since childhood. I've always had a strong connection with electrical energy and the machines that generate it." John has described his work "as the embodiment of that energy into physical fram." John is a true renaissance man. He is a successful artist, inventor and scientist.



John Shepherd's work has been chronicled and celebrated all over the world and on numerous TV network shows such as Searching for UFO's (Turner, June

29, 1997), The Joan Rivers Show (1989), P.M. Magazine (1980). Upon our arrival, we were greeted by approximately 15 "eager to question us" students, and their substitute instructor, who seemed somewhat less eager, at first. However, as the morning commenced, the instructor was shooting his quota of questions at us, right along with his students. 
more interesting than reading words out of a book."

Book Review

At the Threshold; UFO's, Science and the New Age, by Charles F. Emmons. Wild Flower Press, Mill Spring, NC, 1997.

I recommend this book for anyone likely to be reading this review. The writer is a professor of sociology at Gettysburg College in Pennsylvania who is obviously thoroughly familiar with UFO phenomena through reading, attending meetings of relevant groups, and talking with UFO researchers and experiencers. A list of chapter headings suggests the scope of the book: (1) The Strange Range of UFO phenomena; (2) Labeling Ufology a "Deviant" Science; (3) Mass Media and UFO's; (4) Daring to Study UTOS; (5) Debunkers, Skeptics, and True Believers; (6) Normal Science Under Attack- (7) The Crumbling of Certainty- (8) Physical Evidence of UFO's; (9) Witness Reports of UFO's; (10) Ufology's Great Debate- (11) At the Threshold. There is an extensive bibliography.

In my opinion, Emmons does a good job of summarizing the history and present state of Ufology. He describes differing viewpoints on a set of highly controversial topics without losing his own balance. He warns again and again against dogmatism and disregarding discordant evidence.

Emmons has a lot to say, particularly in Chapter IO, on the tension between what he calls the "nuts-and-bolts" and "New Age" approaches in utrology. Let me quote a few sentences: "Essentially, what is going on is a pull in two directions. One pull is toward standard science (playing the science game), and the other is toward the apparently paranormal or high-strangeness aspects of UFO reports. In order to maximize legitimacy in mainstream normal science, Utologists should just forget about people who claim to channel aliens, to be married to aliens, or to remember past lives as aliens. In order to maximize learning about UFO's, however, Utologists may have to follow John Mack into the never-never land of altered states of consciousness and bizarre personal experiences."

Chapter 11 takes its title (and the book's) from its opening sentences: "Is the scientific quest for understanding of the UFO phenomenon nearly complete? Are we at the threshold of solving the enigma?" Toward the end of the chapter he repeats the question and says: "I don't know. ... In the meantime, I have some significant hope that at least we are at the threshold of open and serious *inquiry* into the UFO phenomenon." Many other pertinent remarks could be quoted in between.

I like Emmons' general attitude very much, and would like to see it shared more widely. Once again, I strongly recommend this book.



VEX GALUFO NAS ON

TWILIGHT OF THE GODS

ROB IRVING casts a baleful eye over the stream of remarkable UFO footage which has been emerging from Mexico...

July 11, 1991, 1:29pm. The people of Mexico City were witness to a juncture of apocalyptic harmony. According to an ancient



Mayan astro-calendrical record known as the Dresden Codex, this total solar eclipse would set off a dramatic sequence of events, marked by potentially catastrophic activity at Mount Popocatèpetl, one of the world's largest volcanoes thirty miles to the south-east. Previous eclipses (albeit nocturnal, from the Mexican perspective) preceded the devastating 1985 earthquake and the 1519 invasion of Cortèz, the latter instigating a "plunge of indigenous people into darkness, where they remained for 500 years".

This unveiling of the legendary Sixth Sun would also light the return of Quetzalcoatl, a bearded, fair-skinned, feathered serpent of a god representing the social, technological, and agricultural enlightenment of pre-Hispanic America, heralding "the end of cosmogenic obscurity, giving credence to the prophecy given in the year 755 that the sun of 1991 would usher in not only earth changes, but also cosmic awareness".

Thus the dramatic introduction to Messengers of Destiny, Masters of the Stars, and Voyagers of the Sixth Sun, a series of videos produced by US documentary-makers Lee and Brit Elders, and Jaime Maussan, described as "the most respected and popular investigative journalist in Mexico". Maussan, himself fair-skinned and bearded, fronted that country's version of the acclaimed CBS TV series 60 Minutes before adopting a title which better reflected his distinct eschatological slant on current affairs; Tercer Milenio, or Third Millennium. He also hosts a weekly radio show, Jaime Maussan, UFOs and other Mysteries, and lectures widely on the subject of UFOs.

Bright points of light pierce the numinous twilight during the solar convergence, attracting crowds of skywatchers, many with camcorders running to record the event. Never before have UFOs been observed and recorded by so many witnesses simultaneously. Following Maussan's televised account of the mass sighting he is inundated with tapes from across the region, all showing the same thing; "a stationary object, hovering" and gradually disappearing as the sun emerges.

Steeped in Cronkitian gravitas the commentary glides from this tentative description to "craft", and "spaceships", and "gods in silvery chariots" with unmarked ease. Having presented the Elders' documentary on Swiss contactee Eduard 'Billy' Meier's alleged encounters with Pleiadean beamships in a two-hour 60 Minutos special, Maussan invited them to investigate this latest visit.

We see him briefing them on the ancient prophesies, Lee & Brit eagerly taking notes. The nuance of their conversation deserves wider note: "We don't want to speculate..." warns Maussan sagely...


Lee: "Otherwise, how long was the ship over the city?"

Brit: "Is it the same ship... all of the videos are of the same ship?"

Maussan: "Yes, absolutely the same ship"

Brit: "Is the movement of the craft unusual?"

Maussan: "Well, it seems to be hovering, it's not static..."



Comparative that is, in that the objects recorded during the eclipse - their ET status unquestioned - are used throughout as a touchstone for subsequent sightings. What might otherwise be mistaken for aircraft, stray balloons, blimps, car headlights meandering along distant hillsides, glimpses of other realities, and who knows what else - piezoluminescence? - are loaded together as genuine "Unknowns". One segment, for example, shows two 'unknowns' passing in the night sky appearing to "merge as one, as if docking", before continuing smoothly on their way. Another shows a dark object "narrowly avoiding" a low-flying commercial aircraft. Within weeks of the eclipse fifteen different types of UFO - or OVNI in local parlance - had been observed in the region's airspace, reportedly posing an urgent threat to conventional craft and the citizens below.

Enter field energy propulsion specialist H. David Froning with his expert opinion. Freeze-frame magnification confirms Maussan's observation of the craft's movement: "The propulsion", explains Froning predictably, "is indicative of the repetitive cyclical motion that you would expect with a field propulsion system... one might speculate that a magnetic device is actually causing the pulsation formation". One might, but would that also explain why the surrounding sky 'pulsates' at the same rate? To Froning this simply indicates that "the energy emitted by the craft is disturbing the space surrounding it". If comparisons was made with mundane objects, no mention is made of this. Lee Elders draws Froning's attention to a tiny white dot on the screen, caught in a single frame. "Oh boy!" says the analyst. Another unknown...
