There were 6 CMS reports filed in the state of Missouri in April, which is appearing to be our average for the last several months. The reports are listed below by town and description.

Raytown: Triangle craft with an entity present

St. Peters: Flashing group of multicolor lights

Kirkwood: Purple oval object with contrail

Columbia: Green ball of light traveling fast across the sky

Independence: Boomerang craft with no sound

Iron Mountain Lake: Historic sighting of balls of light

The reported CMS (case management system) sightings reported to Mufon in the United States was a whopping 316 with an additional 14 in Canada for the month of April. California topped the list with 46, Texas had 24, and Michigan rounded off the top 3 with 19. 30 of the U.S. reports filed in April were of craft or objects seen under 100 feet in altitude, 78 had star-like descriptions, 70 were circle shaped craft, and 59 witnessed Triangles. There were 15 reported landing, hovering, or

take-offs and 8 entities observed.

The latest activity across Missouri seems to be reports of green balls of light reported traveling at high speed over Missouri along Hwy 70. The reports have been from St. Charles, Columbia and Independence, spanning the width of our state.

If you find yourself traveling Hwy 70 after dark, please keep an eye out and report anything unusual to either Margie Kay or me.

Entity Observed by Witness in Raytown, MO

An entity was observed by a retired police officer in April after he went to his backyard to see what the source of a bright white/blue light was. The report I took over the phone is as follows:

I was awakened at 3:15 AM this morning by my German Shepard, who came to get me out

of bed. She would not stop barking at something in the back yard. She wanted me to go to the back door. As I walked through the kitchen I stopped. I could see a whitish/bluish bright light coming in the window in the door and the back windows. I had never seen any lights like this and thought it must be a helicopter looking for someone. I did not hear any sound, though, and thought that

was odd. I am a retired police officer and at that point, I felt uneasy, so I went back to the bedroom to got my gun, which is always loaded. I then went back to the kitchen and opened the back door, at that point the light just blinked out. I looked around the yard and looked up where the light was, and saw a very dark dull black triangle shape above me. It had no lights on at that point.

The object appeared to measure the width of my yard (50 ft.) just floated there, unmoving. I heard a noise towards the back fence and looked in that direction. Then I remembered my flashlight and went to get it from the kitchen drawer, when I heard a sound in the hallway behind me. It sounded like an animal of some sort (two clicks), so I shined the flashlight there for a few seconds but saw nothing.

I then went back out to the back porch and shined the flashlight in the direction of the noise I heard outside and saw a very strange, short (approximately 4' tall), gray, humanoid looking creature with big eyes standing there looking at me for just a second or two. It just disappeared - it did not run.

Then I looked up and the craft was also gone - I did not see it leave. I stood there, frozen in fear. My dog would not come outside, which is not normal behavior. I am hard to scare after 30 years on the police force.

I have FBI training as well and I thought I'd seen everything, but this was not normal at all! My first instinct was to call 911 and I went to the phone, but after picking it up, I put it back down. I know everyone at the police department and even though we have received a

few reports of UFOs in the past, I knew they would think I have lost my mind. But I haven't. I know what I saw. I then locked the entire house up and went to the bedroom, not thinking about the noise I heard in the house before until this morning.

My wife was sound asleep and I did not wake her, and I did not tell her about what happened. I thought I was gone only 10 -15 minutes but my clock said 4:46 AM. I don't know what happened to the time!

Now this morning I have a red sunburn on my face, neck, and arms like I stayed in the sun way too long. I told my wife that I saw a light outside and went to investigate because she is worried about the sunburn. I may go the Dr. about it if it doesn't go away, but won't be able to tell him what I saw. I just had to tell someone that this is real and that I'm a 64-year old believer now.


