UFO News in St Louis

Missouri has been a very active area in May with 12 reported CMS sightings. Of these 12 filed reports, 9 were in the Kansas City area. We also unfortunately have been the center for tornado activity this month with the deadliest one in US history hitting Joplin head on taking 141 lives and leaving one third of the town in total destruction. This is not UFO related but deserves mentioning with Missouri Mufon's sincere condolences to all of Joplin.

The St. Louis Wednesday meeting in May featured Ray Kosulandich, who is a local St. Louis resident and an abductee. Ray told of his experiences since the age of twelve to present, which included information given to him by his abductors of future



events.

We discussed the approaching comet Elenin C/2010 X1 which was first discovered on Dec. 10. 2010 by Leonid Elenin, an observer in Lyubertsy, Russia. As of May 4th, Elenin had closed the gap towards Earth to a mere 170 million miles with its closest distance from Earth being 22 million miles on October 16, 2011. There is a very interesting Website called EXONEWS, which is following the progress of this comet and it's under-play by NASA. We also discussed Teche, which is according to astronomers John Matese and Daniel Whitmire of the University of Louisiana, a giant gas planet located in the solar system's Oort cloud.

This planet is thought to be four times the size of Jupiter and a 9th planet. As the Earth's orbit approaches, Teche is bouncing asteroids off of its atmosphere towards Earth at an alarming rate. Teche is recognized and discussed on the NASA web-site. Our May meeting was one for the records with 31 in attendance, 5 new faces, and a record 4 hour audience participation discussion.

Midwest Regional Independence Day Sky Watch Project 7/4

On Independence Day, American Citizens are always taking to the lakes and parks and all over the countryside shooting and watching firework displays! It is our belief that because more Americans are looking up on this night more than any other, common people are seeing objects that don't resemble Fireworks, thus reporting is increased on this date! This also shows that MU-FON is the place to report these sightings and that's one of the reasons that prompted us to try this Sky Watch Project!

Over the last two years I have documented, from the CMS , multiple sightings in many states on this date. Some, but not all of these sighting reports described the same type of objects, with the same flight patterns and colors! (Orange Orbs/Lights) For Example: If one goes to the CMS and does a search under event date 7/4/2010 and a specific State, say MO. ... 9 sighting reports pop up and the Information from those cases that match will show you multiple sightings of Orange Orbs/Lights/ Fireballs with some reports giving directions of flight paths and times of the sightings... From there it is very easy to make a time line and flight path for these Objects! Doing this from state to state is how we came to our conclusions about this project! This can be confirmed by anyone willing to go to the CMS and make the effort to go through sighting reports!

Last year, I recorded 33 sightings in 14 states and developed a time line on some of these

sightings, and there were many more sighting of Orange Orbs but not have enough information with them to be included in my study, just doing this in my spare time while training to be a FI! Going through the CMS state by state and compiling the reports and breaking them down was a fairly easy process. We noticed One of the reports yielded an off duty police officer who witnessed the same Orange Orb Object at close range and had missing time, leading the Field Investigator to think 'Possible Abduction'!

At this point we realized that this is the one night of the year Americans are watching the sky above and that must be the reason for more reports coming in than usual! So the idea was born...

It is our feeling that this would be a win-win project for us (MUFON) and the public! We will be calling on the public to participate with us in a mass sky watch project in an effort to try to identify these strange objects in the sky! Once the Reports have been compiled and the data will be researched and objects classified, we will report our findings back to the public via the MUFON JOURNAL, MUFON's Website and various other Mufon social networks such as Facebook, Twitter, My Space as well as MUFON Sponsored Radio Programs! Working together with the public and the transparency of the project is exactly what MUFON needs to confirm our mission that we (all volunteers) work for the public and provide a useful ser-



vice to the communities we live in. With that said, the possibility exists that this project would also prompt more people to Join MUFON and get involved in the movement

Our idea is to start this project as a Regional Project. If this project bears fruit, we believe this system could expand to a National Sky Watch Day annually and become a well-known event that could be sponsored within MUFON sections across the nation to generate funds and public awareness to MU-FON Sections at the Local Level!

The West Central Section of Arkansas MUFON is willing to do this work after the Sky Watch Event and report our findings to our State Director Norman Walker for Confirmation on our conclusions prior to release of the data to the public! One more thing I should mention is that this project would also be a useful Training tool for New FI's and FI trainees to participate in and make the public aware of Convenience and Easy use of the CSM Option! We see this as a Healthy Project with Great Possibilities for MUFON and the Public!

UFO Reports in KC in May

May, 2011 was the busiest month I've ever had for UFO reports. There are still reports coming in so the real numbers won't be known for a while. I don't know what was going on but SOME-THING was happening in the

Western side of the state in May!

23 Sighting reports of UFOs in the greater Kansas City area and East of Kansas City were received from May 7 - 21 in my office. This is an unusually high number since the average number of reports for the entire state of Missouri has been about

six per month in the past *Photo* year. Some reports came through the official MUFON website at www.mufon.com and others called me directly from my other website.

Witnesses reported a large orange craft in Platte County, 125 orange lights in Raytown, a large metallic craft in Lee's summit, a large grey craft in Liberty, a white craft in Odessa, a large orange craft in Liberty, and numerous reports of anomalous lights too far away to see structure.

The number of reports is not the only unusual factor. I also received reports of three abduction experiences that involved missing time. These occurred in Liberty, Lee's Summit and Independence, and were all women who were involved. I can say that abduction experiences are very rare and to have three in the same month is highly unusual.

We have two cases of large, grey metallic craft. One in Liberty may have been caused lights to be burned out in an apartment.

The events were reported to the media and Chanel 5 News interviewed me about it then ran the

story twice and put it on their website at www.kctv5.com under "UFO Watchers Experience Busy Weekend." Roger Marsh wrote two articles about the events, which were published at www.examiner.com under "Kansas City Reports High Number of Orange Lights, UFOs," and the article on the next page.

I got my first picture of a possible UFO on May 7, while traveling back to Kansas City from St. Louis. I held my cell phone out the window and snapped a picture of the sky, not knowing what was there, but sensing something was nearby. After I saw that there was something in the picture, I pulled off to the side of the highway and looked up, but



saw nothing. I then took another picture (see above) and this was in the photo, but I could not see anything with the naked eye.

I then drove home and found

out later that from May 8 to May 14, multiple witnesses saw fully armed Apache Helicopters flying over the Lee's Summit and Blue Springs areas day and night. A call to Whiteman AFB was fruitless as they said they had nothing in the skies during that time. Yet, two witnesses said they saw the helicopters landing and taking off from the Lee's Summit Regional airport,

not far from where they saw a huge disc shaped UFO on May 15 at 4:00 am along with other witnesses in the same vehicle.

Another unusual factor in this case is that one witness got 13 photographs of the orange orbs on I-435, I got one photo, my secretary got two pictures off her TV screen during a Channel 9 newscast which were taken by an unknown person, and several witnesses have submitted drawings. Photographic evidence is normally difficult to obtain, but in this case (lumping all the May cases together) we have several.

As I'm writing this article I just received another call! Attend the July meeting in KC to hear more!

UFO Flap in Kansas City, Missouri

An unusual amount of UFO activity in the Kansas City area in April and May, 2011, has prompted a serious investigation by the Missouri Mutual UFO Network (MUFON).

MUFON Missouri Assistant State Director Margie Kay has received reports from multiple witnesses who saw UFOs, orange orbs, and an entity.

The following press release was issued by Missouri MUFON.

May 18, 2011 Kansas City, Missouri: A large number of calls were received at the MUFON office by Margie regarding orange orbs and a large silver UFO on the evening of May 14 and the early morning hours of May 15. The sightings occurred during a 9 1/2 hour period from 7 p.m. Saturday until 4 a.m. Sunday. Some of the reports were filed at mufon.com.

A 7-year-old was riding in a car with his mother on Highway 635 headed south in Kansas City North at 7 p.m. on May14. He told his mother that he saw a large, round orange colored UFO moving in the clouds. The mother is a UMKC University professor and a member of the Kansas City chapter of MUFON.

Orange balls of light were spotted East of I-435 southbound at Gregory Boulevard (Raytown) low in the tree line, going from north to south at 9:30 p.m. on May 14. Witnesses pulled over to the side of the highway to watch. The objects appeared to be shooting out of something at about 90 mph, then slowed to about 50 mph. All then rose into the clouds and disappeared. There were approximately 125 of these orbs appearing in a half-our period, according to a local insurance agent and a friend who witnessed the objects.

Another witness, who was called by one of the men watching the scene from I-435, claims to have photos taken from his house.

A woman saw a lighted craft just above the clouds on Saturday night, May 14 at approximately 10:32 PM over Independence, MO, South of 39th Street and Lee's Summit Rd headed in a NW -SE direction. It was not defined and difficult to see - only the large bright circular white light was clearly visible.
