Place: East Hereford, Quebec, Canada

(Adjacent to Vermont border)

Date: January 13, 1996

Time: 8-8:30 PM

On the evening of January 13, 1996 a

man and his wife observed a large round object hovering in the sky in the direction of the Vermont boarder. It was large about ten times the size of the moon with multicolored lights around it. They described it as looking like a Christmas wreath with lights around the outside edge.

Place: East Hereford, Quebec, Canada (Two miles from

US border)

Date: March 10 & 11, 1996

Time: 8-8:30 PM

Investigator: Sandra Black On the evening of March 10, 1996 a woman was in her home watching TV when she noticed a bright red light streaming through the living room window. She became frightened, closed the curtains. locked the door and called her neighbor. She described the light as large and red glowing like a diamond. The size was that of a car headlight at arms length. It appeared close and remained for about thirty minutes then blinked out. The next night the scenario repeated itself but this time the light was white and larger. Betty Hill has received information on a bright red light case similar to

this one which took place in Lincoln Maine in late December 1996.

Place: Canaan, Vermont and Stewartstown, New Hampshire.

Date: March 18, 1996

Time: 8:30 PM

Several men in Canaan Vermont noticed an object in the



Eastern Sky over the New Hampshire border. The object was hovering and was the size of a quarter at arms length. There was a white light in front and a flashing yellow light in the rear. When the object started moving slowly to the northeast they jumped into a car and gave chase into New Hampshire. They stopped at a place where they had a good view and noticed no sound nor could they see a shape. The object changed directions several times before going out of sight. They described the movements as "stopping on a dime" and "making right angle turns".

Place: West of Lunenberg,VT.

Date: October 5, 1996

Time: 8:45 PM

Investigator: Sandra Black

A man and his wife were driving east on Rt. 2, west of Lunenberg when they saw very bright white lights ahead of them. The lights were hovering and pulsating at about 75 degrees from the horizon. There were at least four lights about the size of a fifty cent piece held at arms length and seamed to be emitting light rays that looked like electrical bolts. The man estimated the distance at about one mile. The sighting lasted about ten minutes and then it just disappeared. After a short time two planes flew over the area.

Place: Lancaster, New Hampshire

Date: July 26, 1996 **Time:** 4:00AM

A man was driving south on Rt. 3 just below Lancaster when he saw a tractor trailer parked on the side of the road. Near the truck hovering in the brush was a craft. The craft had green lights running down each side giving the appearance of a Christmas tree. On the top was a brilliant white light directed toward the parked truck. The man drove away as fast as he could. On site investigation revealed no marks or traces where the vehicle had been hovering.

Place: Pittsburg and Clarksville, Hew Hampshire

Date: December 9, 1996

Time: 9:30 PM

A man and his wife were driving south on Rt. 3 about three miles south of Pittsburgh village when they saw a very large oblong object in the sky. The object was at about 45 degrees from the horizon, dark in color with 5 or 6 pulsating white round lights. They estimated apparent size of two and one half feet long and one foot high. It remained in one place as they drove for approximately 7-9 minutes turning east on West road toward their house. They drove their car into the garage and went outside to view the object again but it was gone. They heard no sound during the event.

Place: Pittsburg, New Hampshire overlooking the First Connecticut lake.

Date: August 1986 Time: 11:00 PM

Investigator: Michael Leclercq

A man, his wife and a visitor were in a house overlooking the First Connecticut lake trying to see Halley's Comet. In the background across the lake is Mt. Magalloway. All three people noticed the far shore of the lake, near the mountain, light up for about a mile. Something was illuminating the entire area with a bright white light. A large object started moving toward them over the lake as two large white beams of light were projected toward the water. Both lights went off and the object settled into a cove just across from their house. Through binoculars they could see the elongated side of a craft lit up by a dull red light. At this

point they estimated the size to be ten inches long at arms length. After a while the object just disappeared. No sound was heard, no smell, no reaction from the family dog was noticed. Shortly thereafter the wife noticed a strange triangle mark on her leg. It is still visible ten years later. It should also be noted, details such as the time line of events are not clear of what happened after the object settled into the cove. There have been other sightings from this household in the following years.

Place: Columbia, New Hampshire

Date: Jan 22,1997 Time: 6:50 PM

Preliminary report:

The witness was driving home from work heading north on Rt. 3. She saw a craft come from Vermont and pass in front of her car. She was able to count six yellow windows. After it crossed Rt. 3 it hovered and then headed north east. She heard no sound.

Place: Dixville Date: Jan 23, 1997 Time: 4:40 PM

Preliminary report:

Two men were driving east on Rt. 26 when they observed a football shaped object standing vertical with a dark line joining the two sides together. At the very top a bright white light. The object was hovering in one place even though there were thirty mile per hour wind gusts in the area. It was said to be baseball size at arms length.
