IANS is a nonprofit organization for professional and lay people whose purpose is "to promote a new science that will help the evolvement of mankind in a manner that will complement and preserve the natural order of the universe." The goal is "to unite individuals of a New Science philosophy and initiate a paradigm shift in science and health care."

I didn't know much about IANS but, when I received a call for papers in the mail for the upcoming forum in Fort Collins, Colorado, I thought this conference might be an opportunity to meet like-minded people and to actually

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participate in a small way in helping to change the world for the better.

There were just a few weeks before the deadline for submitting papers, but I quickly put together an abstract which was accepted, and then pulled together a paper based on some of the writing on quantum consciousness I have been doing for The View. My talk was entitled "Quantum Consciousness: Psi, Miracles, the UFO experience and Creativity." I presented it on Saturday afternoon and felt it was very well received.

The yearly IANS conference, called The Forum For New Science, convened on September 13, 1995 at the Fort Collins Marriott, My sister, Jillanne Garrett, joined me and we both experienced a truly inspiring five days of exploration into what leading scientists and thinkers are doing to bring in a new paradigm

What Is The New Science?

One of the first speakers, a founder of IANS, was physicist and former Apollo astronaut Brian O'Leary, Ph.D. He is a former astronomy/physics professor at Princeton University, but a kinder and more likable and down-to-earth guy would be hard to find.

O'Leary's talk, appropriately, focused on defining the New Science. This includes medicine, psychology, energy, environmental sciences, agriculture, non-physical sciences (UFOs, NDEs, OBEs, ghosts, crop circles,

parapsychology, mysticism, and spirituality), biology, physics (especially quantum physics) and its connection to consciousness, other dimensions, and mind/matter interaction. In short, New Science includes the interrelationship of the foregoing disciplines and how they will all be part of a new paradigm of science.

Beyond Quantum

As you can see, the new science includes and promotes healing, psi, consciousness, free energy, UFOs, mysticism and spirituality, and all phenomena not explained by Newtonian science. And more than this, there is an emerging science which goes beyond quantum physics called Zero Point Energy, a science which makes consciousness a major factor in the creation of matter. This zero point energy has been called sacred science in the past, and to understand it we will have to re-examine the role of consciousness (ours and whatever's is "out there"), the concept of the "ether," free energy and the truth in the face of the fact that we create this and all reality. The idea that we co-create, through our consciousness to some extent, all matter and phenomena is something that mysticism has affirmed for millennia. But now science, the new science, is saying the same thing. The new paradigm has the potential to bring in a wonderful new era of cooperation between science and spirituality to heal ourselves and the planet.

The Lapis Pig

O'Leary has developed a charming character named Lapis Pig, a muppet, designed by Jim Henson's group, which O'Leary operates and speaks through. This Lapis Pig is the voice of the old paradigm: the vested interests, the arguments of reductionism, determinism, and materialism. Using this delightful device, O'Leary can quote the old paradigm rhetoric which seeks to delay progress, to debunk anything paranormal, and to perpetuate the rape of the environment. This character, the Lapis Pig, was omnipresent throughout the conference and was an amusing and effective

reminder to all of us of what the old paradigm represents and of who we are up against.

Miracle in the Void

Just a few days before the conference O'Leary's third book had arrived and was available for purchase. This book. Miracle in the Void, is O'Leary's account of his own personal encounter with the new paradigm. He documents the process through which we must all go to arrive at an understanding of the new He describes this process science. "grieving," exactly like that described by Elizabeth Kubler-Ross in writing about the stages one goes through when confronted with one's own death or the death of a loved one. It's our fear of change which forces us to experience denial, anger, bargaining, depression, and, finally, acceptance and forgiveness. This process also ultimately includes creativity, enlightenment, empowerment and transcendence.

O'Leary places us, as a society, in the denial stage now, and just moving into the anger stage of the process. Evidence for the anger can be seen in such events as the Oklahoma City bombing. But completing the grieving process, though difficult, will lead us into a new enlightened paradigm. This is O'Leary's message which he illustrates with his own struggle. He says: "The truth will set you free, but first it will piss you off." This is one of O'Leary's often quoted sayings! I think it is appropriate for our times.

Some Possible Breakthroughs

O'Leary issued a challenge to all of us attending the conference to learn, listen, speak, and especially to think about how we can personally make a difference in the world by actively promoting the new paradigm. Interestingly, he said there is a chance for a breakthrough soon in several projects that he is involved in. IANS may be working more closely with The Institute of Noetic Sciences. Also, O'Leary is part of the group which includes Rockefeller that is working to get immunity against prosecution for violating security oaths. This is expressly for UFO witnesses. This could be very exciting if it occurs.

Other Speakers and Their Messages

The IANS conference presented an array of impressive speakers. Michael Grosso, Ph.D., the first speaker of the conference, spoke on "The Future of Death," what science tells us about our destiny of overcoming the limitations of the human body. "Being in the spirit implies being above the law of death," he said. The mind, he affirmed, is inherently able to transcend the body. The secret of life and death, according to Grosso, is the power of imagination. Through it we can "will" immortality.

Kurt Donsbach, D.C., spoke on alternatives for cancer cures. As part of the new science, Donsbach uses many "unconventional" approaches to curing cancer. One fascinating point he made was that cancer cells don't use oxygen in replication—they use fermentation. They use glucose to make energy, therefore if we stay away from sugar we help "starve" any cancer cells in the body.

I attended Richard Hoagland's talk and also his evening workshop. He elaborated on the Mars and Moon anomalies and showed how the zero point energy (or tetrahedral) concept of new science is evident in the movement of the solar system. He cited some little-understood equations of Maxwell which support hyperdimensional physics and stated that we live in "a universe of abundance—the sun is proof of it."

The tetrahedral geometry found on Earth, Mars, and the Moon isn't naturally occurring. These structures show that the "new science" was in operation perhaps millions of years ago when some intelligence built the structures.

Hoagland showed a slide of a frame from the recent Clementine Moon mission which shows the "spire" and other structures photographed by NASA years before. Thus, Clementine seems to confirm the moon structures.

John Mack, MD was honored by IANS at the Saturday might dinner with an award for "being out there and taking the flack." This referred to the recent attempt by a Harvard committee to strip him of his tenure because of his work with abductees.

Happily, Dr. Mack will retain his position at Harvard and is continuing his study into the abduction phenomenon. He showed recent raw footage of interviews he did with school children in South Africa who had a mass UFO sighting, and with a Zulu shaman who claims to have been abducted when he was going through shamanic training in the bush. This was fascinating stuff. Dr. Mack said the footage was to be included in a video which will be commercially available sometime in the future.

As for the reality of the abduction phenomenon, Dr. Mack stated that he feels that "we co-create the phenomenon on some level." This, of course, supports the new science theme of participation of human consciousness, of consciousness being an essential part of all paranormal phenomena. The abduction phenomenon "challenges the fundamental world view of the human mind," he said. But he added that "a blow to human arrogance can only be a good thing." He reminded us to keep looking for patterns, to remember that <u>love</u> is "the umbilical cord that <u>connects</u>" because "graduation time is coming."

Michael Lindemann, futurist and UFO lecturer, was the speaker at the Saturday night banquet. He didn't give his usual talk on the reality of UFOs, but, instead, spoke about other related matters. His theme was that contact with non-human intelligence will be, or is, the most important force shaping the future. He feels we are in the "endgame" of the UFO coverup; he thinks patterns are emerging that show that there is more than "alien beings" in the non-human intelligence idea.

Lindemann spoke of the angelic realm and the huge percentage of people who believe in that reality and the lives that are moved changed, and improved due to angels. What are angels? "It doesn't matter," he said. "What's important is that lives are changed."

Contact and communication with gorillas or dolphins may prove enlightening. "They're just as smart as us and a lot nicer," he quipped. Artificial intelligence (computers) is another avenue of research that may bring interesting results, he says.

"The dumbest question to ask is 'Are UFOs real?" Lindemann said. "Because your world is falling down around you and those who know are scared. They don't want to be out of a job prematurely!" Lindemann suggested rather than prosecute the leaders of the old paradigm that we should "give them an early pension, say

thank you, and get on with it." According to him, we should overcome our fear because we're all in this together. "The new world will be quite wonderful, but unrecognizable." We should "wake up, smell the coffee, and get ready for the ride of a lifetime," he advised.

Some Additional Remarks

The IANS conference included more than 75 speakers, some well-known scientists and authors, and many unknown to me. Obviously, there were many more talks and workshops than my sister and I could attend. But we kept hearing

the same theme run through the presentations. And that theme seemed to be that we are on the verge of a new paradigm, a new world where consciousness will be recognized as an integral part of all material and spiritual life.

There was a great deal of excitement, optimism and hope for the future expressed by everyone, and it looks like we are indeed on the verge of an undeniable shift of consciousness which will affect our world like nothing has in the past.

Dear Ms. Duce-Ashe:

I have been programming UFO sightings into a database of my own design for the last decade. *U* is a stand-alone program (written from the ground up in C-language), with over 12,500 well researched UFO sightings from about 230 separate sources. The ENTIRE RUN of MUFON JOURNALS is just ONE of these sources. *U* is constantly updated, so my flyers are out of date as soon as I print them!

U was warmly endorsed by Dr. Jacques Vallee, Dr. Richard Haines, James McCampbell (former MUFON scientific director) and others. Many of my small clientele are at the doctoral level, but *U* is surprisingly easy to use. You DO need a DOS/Windows type computer, however, there is no Apple or MacIntosh version.

For research purposes, the *U* package may serve as a super-index to UFO sightings in the literature or media. Each book case cites reference and page number. Magazine cases give the Issue number. There is no faster, more inexpensive way to footnote/verify sources, or to find additional materials related to a given study. An automatic "demo" routine runs endlessly for an interesting lecture aid.

There are 85 search paths including 64 attributes. These may be used in ANY combination to display maps, dump files to screen or printer, export data, or perform a whole menu of statistical functions and test theories. One statistics function graphs sightings frequencies versus Earth-Mars relative orbits; i.e. when the two planets are close together. This yields some surprising data.

I cannot afford high-profile advertising, but send mailers like this one to UFO groups, researchers, writers and journals. I rely on sales of *U* to continue my research. I certainly hope you can make some mention this software to your associates!

I will gladly send a mailer like this one to anyone who drops me a card or calls with a mailing address. I respond immediately to all inquiries and promise same-day shipping. Updates to *U* are offered to registered users at about 9-month intervals so they may stay current. Please call/write if you have any questions!

From the Producer's Corner...

Very early on Friday morning, December 8, I was lying awake, waiting for sleep to come, so I turned on Art Bell's radio show on KKOB radio to lull me into slumberland. To my great surprise, I heard him announce that in connection with the flurry of news about remote viewing, he was about to interview Ed Dames!

Dames, who used to reside here in Albuquerque, now lives in Hollywood, CA. He talked for an hour minus commercials and was reserved and polite; he took no audience questions (Bell didn't open the telephone lines at all). He said little those who follow him don't already know, and he said nothing about UFOs. His main bits of news included that his group is looking into the Unibomber and expects success, and that Gordon Michael Scallion will be right about his predictions (another topic on Bell's mind lately.)

New readers may not be aware of the previous articles we did on Ed Dames, remote viewing and related topics, so I went through the back issues of *NM MUFON News* and found this...

I notice we had a short article in the first issue, "PSITECH moves to Albuquerque," a quarter page on the company's move from Washington and how the team is interested in cattle mutilations and the face on Mars.

Our next Dames mention was in issue #4, under the title "UFO 'Big Event in New Mexico' Confirmed at Treat V. The article was an excerpt of an article Editor Duce-Ashe wrote for *UFO Magazine*'s V8, #3, 1993 issue. It reviewed Dames' talk at TREAT V and his claim that something would be happening between the talk and August of 1993.

In issue #5, we had an article on remote viewing in general with a mention of Ed Dames.

In issues #6 and 7 we ran a two-part article by yours truly (me, Debby) called Talking to Ed Dames. This was an actual interview focusing on UFOs and similar activities he and his team had looked into on a whim. If Art Bell had known about this when he interviewed Dames...! Dames probably wouldn't have said anything, but...

In issue #6 we also had a short article on Dames looking into the origin of what is now known as the hanta virus.

Issue #9 headlined with "What is Happening? Ed Dames' 'Big Event' and the Mars Observer'. This issue was printed in September '93 and we quoted Dames as saying "You have my word that things are happening." We also had some editorial and producer opinions about this... We two newsletter

creators were obviously milking this for all we could, but it was fun:)

Issue #10 reported two telephone conversations with Dames.

In issue #12 (Jan. 1994), we reported on John Alexander's talk to our group. Alexander laughed off the Aviary rumors, explained what was really going on, and mostly talked about his interest in thanatology. Also in that issue we reported that Dames said cattle mutilations would continue in NM. True, 1994 turned out to be a big year for them, though, fortunately for the ranchers, 1995 was very quiet...

Issue #15 reported a list compiled by Victoria Alexander of the *Top Ten Reasons Why The Aliens Failed to Make a Big Display in New Mexico* in August. It spoofs a lot of researchers.

I am on the internet and have joined a UFO mailing group. I wrote up an announcement about Ed Dames and posted it, and soon thereafter received the following message from Belgium:

Dear Debby,

I am a member of MUFON, and edit a magazine on UFOs in Belgium and Holland.

We are doing a story on Dames, Alexander and RV-ing shortly, and with great interest I read how you were on the story for several years. In Holland, it is all happening. I've seen the pre-release of Courtney Brown's book on Remote Viewing, and though it is highly speculative (talk about how the greys have ranks amongst them), I'm told the other people who read it, informed the possible Dutch publisher to go ahead with it.

Anyway, I was wondering whether you could send me, through email, the article on Alexander that appeared in the January 1994 issue (No 12). If sent by regular mail, I'm afraid we'll miss the deadline by some days, which would be a pity. I will later order for more issues of the magazine.
