### DIRECTOR'S LETTER

Dear Friends and Researchers;

"So what's going on with MIFUN in NYC, anyway? Are there active investigations? Are conferences being held? How can we meet other members to discuss things we've seen or experienced without getting the inevitable raised eyebrow?"

These were the questions I asked myself when I joined MUFON seven years ago. I couldn't ask anyone else in MUFON. I didn't know anyone and no one contacted me when I joined! Who would I ask? I don't know who the State Section Director was at the time, or even if we had one.

For many years I was baffled and discouraged about the apparent lack of local organization. Was I just out of the information loop? What was going on?

Eventually, I did learn some of what was going on. Suffice it to say that normal human vices of pettiness, insecurity, ego needs and greed were involved.

In the meantime, over a period of five years, I attended three meetings arranged by Gary Levine, New York's State Director. I believe there were one or two other meetings which I never received invitations for ... some NYC post office

branches tend to "lose" postcards!

I enjoyed the meetings I attended but I was so frustrated. Why was nothing happening locally? Gary could only do so much for NYC. He lived too far upstate to organize the local membership.

Finally, five MUFON members including myself formed a group in mid-1989 to investigate and research local UFO sightings. It was intended to be an adjunct to MUFON, but soon became only a vehicle for one person's ego gratification. It began to release disinformation, and four of the founding members resigned, including myself. Frivolous lawsuits took up valuable time for the next eight months, and still nothing was happening in the city.

Eventually, the fall—out subsided and I emerged, almost by accident, as the State Section Director for Queens, and Acting Director for NYC. I remembered my frustration with the lack of local organization in the past, and set about forming a group which could provide the information and aid I had desired in years past. I hope we have been somewhat successful.

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## MUFON NYC HOLDS FIRST UFO SYMPOSIUM FIRST INDEPENDENTLY CORROBORATED ABDUCTION REVEALED

Best-selling author Budd Hopkins, journalists J.Antonio Huneeus and Eugenia Macer-Story, MUFON State Section Director Gary Levine, Military scientist Colman von Keviczky, and Jean Mundy, a psychologist specializing in hypnotic regressions, were guest speakers at MUFON NYC's first UFO symposium, held November 23, 1991.

MUFON NYC was formed in May, 1991, to discuss, investigate, and contribute to the eventual resolution of the mystery of UFO's and associated phenomena.

Opening speaker Budd Hopkins told a symposium audience of about 75 that he was now in possession of "the most important abduction case ever," one with witnesses who, from a distance, had observed an abduction. He said that it was the first time that someone had come forward to actually corroborate an abduction claim.

Mr. Hopkins also discussed a forthcoming, privately-funded Roper Poll that would query households regarding unusual experiences. Questions will include: "Have you ever seen a ghost?"; "Have you ever left your body?"; "Have you ever seen a UFO?"; "Have you ever lost an hour or more and found puzzling scars on your person?" (Flash!...DNTRUDERS, a two-part drama, will air on CBS-TV in May.)

Deftly fielding a variety of questions from an enthusiastic audience, Mr. Hopkins averred that "The government can't keep a lid on this any longer!" He said that he alone had so much abduction evidence that, "within a year or two," the government would "have to tell the truth." He assured the audience that UFO investigators as well as those attending UFO symposia were on the "cutting edge" of UFO/abductee knowledge, and expressed regret regarding the degree of in-fighting plaguing Ufology.

One of the more lively question and answer segments occurred when Mr. Hopkins was asked to answer Jacques Vallee's as-


sertion, in his book, *REVELATIONS*, that Hopkins and others were "too literal" in their interpretation of statements made under hypnosis, and that "biological" explanations of UFO entity's goals were "ludicrous." Mr. Hopkins replied that Mr. Vallee apparently knew nothing of hypnosis, and that his recent declaration that Hopkins and others should not be allowed to hypnotize abductees, was contrary to the spirit of free scientific inquiry.

When someone in the audience suggested that more cooperation and less contentiousness would be needed to solve the UFO/abductee mystery, Mr. Hopkins said that he was certainly willing to cooperate, and that he had even invited Mr. Vallee to visit him whenever he was in New York.

International journalist J.Antonio Runeeus provided a slide-show update on the UFO situation in Japan and the Soviet Union. He showed fascinating, unpublished photographs from various areas of Japan and the USSR, as well as drawings made by Russian and Japanese children, of both purported UFO's and entities. Mr. Runeeus noted that Soviet magazines, once heavily censored, were now freely and openly discussing the UFO phenomenon.

Asked whether the mystery of the socalled "Face" photographed on the planet Mars had yet been solved, Mr. Huneeus said, "No!" but predicted that the next Mars Probe, due in a few years, would certainly reveal whether it was a "construction" or just an epiphenomenon of light and shadow.

Journalist Eugenia Macer-Story presented an original analysis of the all-too-common habit that experienced researchers and laypeople alike have of bringing personal and collective mythologies and belief systems to the UFO phenomenon. Discussing the infamous Area 51 and showing photos taken by a Japanese photographer of various lights and associated phenomena over Groom Lake, Ms. Macer-Story said



that people often see what they are prepared to see. Citing the sky show seen over Fatima, Purtugal, many years ago as a prime example, she explained that while many religious people saw religious symbols, others with a more secular belief system just saw lights.

Speaking "strictly as a reporter," Ms. Macer-Story concluded, "there's a mythology that attaches to sightings over Area 51. But there is no corroborative evidence as to what those lights are."

Jean Mundy, a psychologist who has worked with Budd Hopkins on abduction cases, was another of MUFON NYC's guest speakers. She explained that, apart from its revelatory potential, hypnosis was of significant value to the mental health of the abductee. She said that an abduction experience is an alienating one, given the fact that few if any will believe you. But by delivering hypnotic suggestions to the abductee's unconscious mind, she explained, feelings of alienation and fear could be dissolved.

Asked whether there was a "common thread" running throughout abductee hypnotic responses, Ms. Mundy replied, "Yes! ...Fear!"

Military scientist Colman von Keviczky reported on what he claimed was an ongoing government disinformation campaign. Mr. von Keviczky charged that mounting evidence proves Star Wars Technology was not developed to protect against the USSR or any other potential earthly enemy. Rather, he insisted, it had been and continued to be developed to both attack and repel aliens.

Reading from a variety of sources and notes, Mr. von Keviczky exhorted the UFO community to change the U.S. Government's irrational response to an alien presence whose reality, he claimed, it was determined to deny. He challenged the audience to overcome governmental disinformation and to lobby against Star Wars development so that interplanetary and global devastation might be avoided.

State Section Director Gary Levine provided an update on UFO sightings in upstate New York. Mr. Levine disclosed that, during the past year, at least 12 sightings had been made of UFOs going in and coming out of water, and hovering in the vicinity of local prisons.

Closing comments were made by Phil Lord, Director of MUFON NYC. He advised that, since many had been turned away, the next symposium will be held at the AFS Studios at 313 E. 43rd, a much larger space holding about 200 people. The symposium, whose guest speakers will again include Budd Hopkins, will run from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m..

Additional speakers for the April 4th symposium, as well as another symposium slated for May 30th, will be announced.

THE PROBLEM
IS US

That UFOs must or must not be real, or extraterrestrial, or benevolent, is a posture too many of us affect to protect our too-fragile egos. And yet, other "mysteries" no doubt have the same effect on those who are emotionally drawn to the unknown and unknowable as do UFOs.

No one approaches UFOs, or any religious or scientific conundrum, innocent of presuppositions. Moreover, it's only human to hunger for answers that suit our psychological needs. Given those factors, will it be possible for us to resolve this mystery? Or, does the apparent inability of even the "best and brightest" to see this phenomenon objectively preclude a satisfactory resolution?

Belief systems can have no place in the investigation of UFOs; not unless we only want answers that agree with our particular bias. Ufology already has an abundance of built-in belief systems. There's the belief system of the percipient or contactee; the belief system of the official body to whom the report is made; the

belief system of the scientific gurus who determine the validity of a UFO report. Starting a search for a solution to a riddle with the solution, takes us down a circular road that returns us, safe and sound, to our cherished belief systems. Only if we begin by saying "I don't know...let's find out!..." is the spirit of honest inquiry possible.

Looking at this phenomenon as it has evolved over the last 45 years, one is reminded of its perhaps only truism: those who are certain that UFOs are only what they say they are, are not ready for the kind of discourse the subject so desperately needs. But how about those of us who admit our emotional, psychological and intellectual limitations; who respect evidence, even if it doesn't fulfill our expectations. Can we, "The Willing," make our way through this jungle of mostly man-made illusions that are no doubt masking the truth?

I like to think that we can. But we must summon the necessary innocence; unlock the ability to just "look and see" what's actually there; approach the problem anew, with fresh eyes, minds and hearts.

For example, what if...just what if the sight, experience or actual fact of the UFO phenomenon is a means by which *Nature* transports us to the next evolutionary port of call? If you recall the large, gray, rectangular object in the movie "2001" that evolved those Chimps into the chumps we all know and love, you'll know what I mean. Ooops...sorry...the last thing UFOdom needs is yet another theory.

Tell you what. How about a belated New Year's resolution to try our damndest to never again assume anything about the nature of UFOs. I for one resolve to be as objective as possible, regardless of the consequences. I also resolve to respect the other person's opinion, even if it doesn't conform to mine. It's a tall order, but I'm going to try a hell of a lot harder than I have.

How about you, Carl Sagan? And you, Isaac Asimov? And you, Bruce Maccabee? And you, Budd Hopkins? And you, Jacques Vallee? And you, Phil Klass? And you, Jerome Clark? And all of the UFO magazine editors, luminaries and hard-science experts? Will you join me?

And, most of all, you, Dear Reader? May I also have the pleasure of your esteemed company on this grand and glorious cosmic madventure?

# JACQUES VALLEE SPEAKS...AGAIN!

Jacques Vallee, a computer scientist and author of many books on the UFO phenomenon including DIMENSIONS, CONFRONTATIONS, and REVELATIONS, recently discussed UFOs and associated phenomena with the magazine, Magical Blend.

On The State Of Ufology
Noting that there is "an alarming level

of insanity in the field" of UFO investigation, Vallee says that his colleagues in science and technology insist that UFOs are just "a lot of garbage." He says that a UFO sighting can't be investigated today without at least considering the "possibility of a hoax..., not on the part of the witness...but...somebody else, like the military."

#### On Crop Circles

Vallee says that his friends have looked at samples under a microscope and observed exploded nodes. "Initially," he explains, "my friends thought it was infrared energy. Now, it looks like microwave energy." His friends further speculate that someone has been testing a microwave weapon, perhaps a Star Wars device designed to "zap electronics on board a satellite." Vallee notes that, in this way, you can "change each stalk of corn into a microwave antenna" and "check the precision of the beam with exquisite resolution." He goes on to suggest that crop circles are getting better and better because the beam is getting "finer and finer." He suspects the entire phenomenon is probably a brilliant physical and sociological experiment utilizing New Age belief and an obsession with extraterrestrials as a means of camouflaging a government/military high-tech experiment.

#### On UFO Investigation In General

Vallee quotes an old friend who once advised: "Consider everything and believe nothing." He feels that when a sighting or group of sightings, such as Gulf Breeze, gain excessive publicity, or when a sighting occurs near a military base, there may be no way of determining what actually happened. He invites the reader to "Suppose...military experts have come to the conclusion that there really is a UFO phenomenon and they want to keep the field to themselves. The best way to achieve that is to send everybody else on a wild goose chase for short gray aliens under New Mexico, since nobody else could check it anyway, and discredit the people who are doing this kind of research on an independent basis."

#### On Abductions

Vallee believes that, though most abduction experiences are probably legitimate, abduction research relies. too much on "amateurish use of hypnosis." Vallee feels that hypnosis is "irresponsible, unethical and unscientific," and insists that, "If and when we get the attention of the scientific community, they will ...look at the methodology that has been used and throw the whole thing out the window as garbage." He says that most of those who hypnotize contactees don't bother to "find out what other kinds of crisis may be going on in their lives .... "He worries that genuine UFO abduction cases are being mixed in with assorted childhood or adult trauma. "To simply hypnotize people and assume...you are going to get...ultimate truth about UFOs," Vallee observes, "is absurd."

#### On Encounters

Vallee speculates that we may be dealing with a non-human intelligence. He suggests that UFO experiences may offer clues to other paranormal phenomena that enable us to test "advanced theories of reality." Speaking of past history, he reminds us that "In the Middle Ages, people confronted with alien beings...

thought of them as angels and demons, or elves...fairies and leprechauns." Comparing the past with present-day encounters with aliens, he observes that "It's natural for us...to think of them as space visitors."

#### On Things To Come

Vallee says that when we discover the truth about the UFO phenomenon, it will "change everything." In fact, he predicts, "It's going to be a revolution."

The full interview is found in the April Issue of Magical Blend."

In Jacques Vallee's book, UFO CHRONICLES OF THE SOVIET UNION: A COSMIC SAMIZDAT, he reports on his 1990 trip to the Soviet Union to investigate a wave of sightings. Vallee met with Russian engineers and physicists who thoroughly researched Voronezh, the site of many UFO sightings. Though the sightings were ridiculed by many in the Western press, Vallee's research led him to believe they were "very solid." In fact, one sighting involved more than 500 people who witnessed an object flying at rooftop level near some apartment buildings in Voronezh.
