History of Joseph Smith. [July, 1838]

Sunday 22nd, the camp was obliged to travel part of the day to get forage received a salute of rotten eggs from a house as they passed administered the sacrament for the first time on their journey. Sometime during this night a luminous body about the size of a cannon ball came down over the encampment near the ground then whirled around some forty or fifty times and moved off in a horizontal direction passing out of sight. 188 miles from Kirtland.
