

Another wave of UFO sightings reported last month in Florida

As if Disney World and Universal Studios were not enough to draw tourist to the Sunshine State, Florida now appears to be the place to go to see a UFO.

Witnesses there reported UFO sightings on March 10 and March 30, according to the online UFO newsletter "Filer's Files," compiled by George Filer.

Here's a report from Clearwater: "I almost expected to see a plane crash as the blue-green light was so bright at 9:15 p.m., on March 30 ... however, there was no sound. I saw what looked like a searchlight but there was no plane or helicopter in sight.... The light appeared 60 to 70 feet off the ground and moved from southwest to northeast over our neighborhood. A friend saw a similar light moving from the north to the south over the local beach several nights ago at nearly the same time of night. Bluegreen, close to the ground – moved quickly and disappeared. I felt a strange feeling that there must be something going on."

Filer says that account was recorded by Peter Davenport, director of the National UFO Reporting Center, who reports that multiple motorists in Tampa saw 30-40 flying objects there about 10 p.m. on March 30:

"We all stopped our cars and stared at this strange event. At least 10 cars and 20 people stopped, and I spoke to a few of them. They all asked the same question, 'Did you guys see that? What is it?"

Here's a March 10 account from the Flossmoor community: "At 3 a.m., my friend and I spotted a UFO hovering in one spot for 2 minutes.... A few minutes later, it started flying over us with white lights that turned red. It flew behind the trees and disappeared. I also saw one an hour before this sighting. We saw a red light zip away so fast that it left a streak as if you were moving a laser pointer."

Here's an aerial battle account from that same time and day, this one from the West Liberty area: "At 3 a.m., my aunt, her neighbor, and I were standing outside on March 10 ... when I saw 'Star Wars'-like aerial maneuvers in the sky. The larger shapes had red lights on each corner and a relatively bright central light. The 'G' forces would most likely implode a human. They moved from horizon to horizon in the space of a few seconds. Several smaller craft at intersecting points of its travel were firing off 10-round tracers as if to intercept the other much larger craft. The phenomenal 'Star Wars' battle went on for 45 minutes. They blended in with the starry background almost flawlessly."

Strange Light In Boca Raton Sky Draws Crowd

Observer Says Object Was LED Bicycle Light Attached To Kite

BOCA RATON, Fla. --

Boca Raton police fielded plenty of telephone calls Monday night about a strange light hovering in the sky.

A WPBF 25 News viewer sent home video of the floating light. Michael Speer said he got a call from one of his friends who told him to come to Camino Real to watch the unusual light show in the sky.

"It kind of looked like a star -- just a little white light -- and it just started moving around all weird-like, making all kinds of loops and just moving really strangely," Speer said.

Speer said cars were lined up along Camino Real with people trying to sneak a peak. The show lasted about an hour. "It was pretty crazy," he said. "I didn't expect to see so many people out there. It was wild."

An observer told police that the light was an LED bicycle light attached to a kite. That observer tried to pick it up to bring it to police, but a girl ran by him, grabbed it and fled the scene.

Even after learning the truth, though, Speer admitted the sighting had him thinking UFO. "It crossed my mind," he said.

Youths claim UFO lifted them By JOHN KOZIOL <u>ikoziol@citizen.com</u>

Already well-known throughout the world as being the host of Bike Week, Laconia recently added another item to its resume when a local girl and her boyfriend claimed their car was picked up into the air and then dropped by an Unidentified Flying Object (UFO).

While *The Citizen's* attempts to reach the youths were unsuccessful, a Laconia Police Department report states that Off. Adam Batstone responded at 12:17 a.m. on March 21 to the residence of Linda Dutile where he made contact with her daughter, Emily Moore, 18, and Moore's 16-year-old boyfriend.

Moore, Batstone wrote, was "very upset" and told him that, a short while earlier, she and her boyfriend had been parked at Opechee Park in her mother's Ford Focus, looking out toward the lake, when "all of a sudden a dark object started to float across the sky in front of them."

The object passed over them and returned, Moore said, and, when she and her boyfriend attempted to put the car in reverse, "the vehicle started to shake violently and the windshield smashed as though something had hit it and the air bags went off." There was no one around, Moore stated, and, upon questioning by Batstone, she said a bird had not struck the windshield. "They never saw anything actually strike the car, they just saw the dark object in front of them, heard the windshield smash and the car shake violently and all of the sudden it felt like the car had dropped back down into the parking space. Moore said that she knew it sounded impossible or incredible, but that's what happened," said Batstone.

Batstone inspected the exterior of the vehicle and found no signs of impact on the windshield, adding that the dirt on the car was undisturbed. A check of the interior showed "no indications that any sort of impact had happened" but the damage on the windshield was "consistent with the cover to the air bag being launched into the windshield when the passenger side air bag had deployed."

Batstone next went to Opechee Park where he searched the area of the incident but failed to find any evidence — birds, animals or broken glass or lens covers — "to indicate that a collision had occurred." In conclusion, "I request this case be cleared due to no criminal aspect," Batstone wrote.

As of Friday evening, however, the case remains uncleared because of a discrepancy between where Moore told Batstone the incident allegedly occurred and where she and her boyfriend later told UFO investigators it happened — namely the parking lot at Funspot — said Laconia Police Chief Mike Moyer.

Moyer, who spoke with the UFO investigators and who has a copy of the account Moore and her boyfriend gave of the alleged March 20 event, said Batstone will be meeting soon with both of them to ask about the Opechee Park/ Funspot situation.

The testimony of Moore and her boyfriend is available online at the National UFO Reporting Center, www.nuforc.org.

A Funspot representative said nothing like what Moore and her boyfriend described happened at the facility. "It's a hoax," the representative said; "it never occurred at Funspot." "The long and short," said Moyer, "is that we got this call to Opechee Park and the officer basically closed the case because there was nothing for us to do; and then I got a call from the UFO guys and they came and took statements and I didn't realize until yesterday in reading the statement they [Moore and her boyfriend] gave the UFO people the discrepancy in what they told the police." There was no mention of a UFO, Moyer said, until the investigators contacted him.

Steve Firmani of the Mutual UFO Network New England, which several online articles reported had spoken with Moore and her boyfriend, was not available for comment.

In his remarks to the NUFORC, Moore's boyfriend, who is identified only as "D," said he and Moore went to the Funspot parking lot around 11 p.m. on March 20 because "we wanted to look at the stars." "D" said he observed an object that "blocked the moon" and that changed shapes and whose size he estimated to be "as big as 14 houses." "D" said he attempted to drive away, but "The front end got picked up and the car could not move. We steered left and right but the car just kept going up into the air."

As the car rose, "D" said, he felt "something" yank his wrist but "Not aggressively" while in his head, "something was telling me 'Don't panic,' or 'Don't be scared.' And it wasn't in English in my head but I got the meaning."

There was a smell and "D" said his ears "felt like they kept on popping from the altitude." The force that was tugging on his wrist, "D" said, then intensified. When the car horn accidentally sounded, the grip lessened, he said, and when the horn beeped again, "D" realized "we were still up in the air! It took 2 seconds for the car to drop." "All this took place from 11 p.m. to 12:30 a.m.," D" said, but "It seemed like we were in the air for 10 minutes and it felt like it was forever."

Moore, who is identified in the NUFORC report as "E," recalled seeing "a weird black-shaped object" in the Funspot lot. She, too, recounted there being a smell and also of being "immobilized like I had no control over what I was doing or over my body." Moore said that, after Batstone left, it was determined that the underside of the car was "totaled."

Both Moore and her boyfriend concluded their comments by saying they are scared and don't want to go out at night anymore.

A Laconia police officer for the past 25 years and chief for almost three, Moyer confirmed that his department has in the past received "a couple of reports" of UFOs, although they were never substantiated.

Asked whether there was anything seemingly extraterrestrial in what allegedly happened on March 20 at either Opechee Park or at Funspot, Moyer said there wasn't.

"We did not put out an APB [all points bulletin] for a flying saucer that night," he said, adding that, while he has seen UFOs "many times"— things he could not readily identify — he had never seen an alien spacecraft. "I don't believe in UFOs. Why do they always come down in a rural area? Why don't they land in the middle of New York City? The day one lands on the Boston Common is the day I'll believe."

Neither Dutile nor Moore was available for comment Friday. Calls to telephone numbers that the women provided to police produced recorded messages saying the telephone numbers were out of service.

In the meantime, Laconia's alleged UFO incident remains under investigation. While Chief Moyer does not believe in UFOs, nearly 20,000 hits on the UFO Examiner's article on the incident shows a lot of other people do.

Don't talk to aliens, warns Stephen Hawking By Jonathan Leake

Hawking has depicted what kinds of alien could be out there

THE aliens are out there and Earth had better watch out, at least according to Stephen Hawking. He has suggested that extraterrestrials are almost certain to exist — but that instead of seeking them out, humanity should be doing all it that can to avoid any contact.

The suggestions come in a new documentary series in which Hawking, one of the world's leading scientists, will set out his latest thinking on some of the universe's greatest mysteries.

Alien life, he will suggest, is almost certain to exist in many other parts of the universe: not just in planets, but perhaps in the centre of stars or even floating in interplanetary space.

Hawking's logic on aliens is, for him, unusually simple. The universe, he points out, has 100 billion galaxies, each containing hundreds of millions of stars. In such a big place, Earth is unlikely to be the only planet where life has evolved.

"To my mathematical brain, the numbers alone make thinking about aliens perfectly rational." he said. "The real challenge is to work out what aliens might actually be like."

The answer, he suggests, is that most of it will be the equivalent of microbes or simple animals — the sort of life that has dominated Earth for most of its history.

One scene in his documentary for the Discovery Channel shows herds of two-legged herbivores browsing on an alien cliff-face where they are picked off by flying, yellow lizard-like predators. Another shows glowing fluorescent aquatic animals forming vast shoals in the oceans thought to underlie the thick ice coating Europa, one of the moons of Jupiter.

Such scenes are speculative, but Hawking uses them to lead on to a serious point: that a few life forms could be intelligent and pose a threat. Hawking believes that contact with such a species could be devastating for humanity.

He suggests that aliens might simply raid Earth for its resources and then move on: "We only have to look at ourselves to see how intelligent life might develop into something we wouldn't want to meet. I imagine they might exist in massive ships, having used up all the resources from their home planet. Such advanced aliens would perhaps become nomads, looking to conquer and colonise whatever planets they can reach."

He concludes that trying to make contact with alien races is "a little too risky". He said: "If aliens ever visit us, I think the outcome would be much as when Christopher Columbus first landed in America, which didn't turn out very well for the Native Americans."

The completion of the documentary marks a triumph for Hawking, now 68, who is paralysed by motor neurone disease and has very limited powers of communication. The project took him and his producers three years, during which he insisted on rewriting large chunks of the script and checking the filming.

John Smithson, executive producer for Discovery, said: "He wanted to make a programme that was entertaining for a general audience as well as scientific and that's a tough job, given the complexity of the ideas involved."

Hawking has suggested the possibility of alien life before but his views have been clarified by a series of scientific breakthroughs, such as the discovery, since 1995, of more than 450 planets orbiting distant stars, showing that planets are a common phenomenon.

So far, all the new planets found have been far larger than Earth, but only because the telescopes used to detect them are not sensitive enough to detect Earth-sized bodies at such distances.

Another breakthrough is the discovery that life on Earth has proven able to colonise its most extreme environments. If life can survive and evolve there, scientists reason, then perhaps nowhere is out of bounds.

Hawking's belief in aliens places him in good scientific company. In his recent Wonders of the Solar System BBC series, Professor Brian Cox backed the idea, too, suggesting Mars, Europa and Titan, a moon of Saturn, as likely places to look.

Similarly, Lord Rees, the astronomer royal, warned in a lecture earlier this year that aliens might prove to be beyond human understanding.

"I suspect there could be life and intelligence out there in forms we can't conceive," he said. "Just as a chimpanzee can't understand quantum theory, it could be there are aspects of reality that are beyond the capacity of our brains."

I, like so many, was taken aback by the comments made by British physicist, Stephen Hawking, on aliens and UFO

Stephen Hawking got it wrong on aliens and UFO arrivals

In a nutshell, Professor Hawking, remarked that humans should be fearful of any aliens popping in to meet us.

Hawking drew parallels to exploration and colonisation on Earth, noting that the arrival of more technologically advanced Europeans in the Americas did not bode well for the natives. Hawking also mentioned that any aliens landing their UFOs on our planet will be looking to deplete and exploit our resources.

There are serious flaws in the logic behind these comments.

Firstly, it should be noted just how far we humans are from any real long-distance space travel. Any ET race capable of arriving here from a very distant planet, probably many light years away, will be so advanced technologically in comparison to us that an analogy involving medieval Spaniards and Native Americans is absurd.

A more apt analogy would be a bunch of curious Westerners, in say, 100 years time chancing on the last uncontacted tribe in the Amazon. This event would probably be rather peaceful.

It would be fair to say that no home planets of any ETs capable of reaching us exist within our immediate environs or we would have openly been interacting with them already. More likely any alien visitors will be coming from very far: Light years away, as mentioned above.

Chances are that between us and them exist hundreds of resource rich planets not inhabited by technological beings. Coming such distances for the meagre resources of our tiny planet would hardly be a cost-efficient or worthwhile endeavor.

That any alien visitors would have solved the resource issue long ago is Implicit in the ability to travel the mindboggling distances involved in getting here.

It is unlikely that any visiting aliens would need anything from us.

One can also be pretty sure that should any UFO travelling aliens arrive here in an open manner, they have already known about our existence for a very long time. No concrete evidence exists of malevolent intentions from any other-worlders towards us yet.

To sum up, let us not get to self-righteous about nasty aliens coming to destroy Earth's resources: The only ones on record doing that are us. Professor Hawking's comments are unhelpful in putting in place strategies for dealing with the inevitable moment when we do meet technological ETs, an event we should welcome. Chances are that it will be they who will teach us how to value life on this planet.

Baffling UFO Sighting Finally Explained

Mark Zinni Fox 8 Reporter CLEVELAND -- In March, mysterious lights were spotted in the sky over Northeast Ohio. FOX 8 heard from hundreds of viewers after one man claimed it was a UFO, but some dispute that claim after an independent investigation.

Eugene Erlikh first noticed the lights near his Euclid apartment in March, but now that it's May? "There have been more each day," said Erlikh. "They've been brighter, they've been more colorful and more and more people have been seeing them." After first recording the lights on March 3, Eugene said he has heard from people around the world, including Michael Lee Hill. He happens to live near Eugene and claims to have seen the same thing. "As I was down at the beach, over my right-hand shoulder, I see this really bright light and it's coming up really low, right over treetop level," said Hill.

Hill also recorded his close encounter near Lake Erie and described the object as a triangle with lights on each corner. "This was absolutely silent until it got right overtop my head and then it kinda sounded like a vacuum cleaner, that's the only sound, like this low, little hum," said Hill. "We realized later, the next day, the next few days that we filmed the same exact thing, doing the same formations and it is just astounding," said Erlikh.

The Cleveland Ufology Project was founded back in 1952 and members meet regularly to talk about the many reported sightings in Northeast Ohio. "This area has always been pretty popular for UFO sightings," said Aaron Clark from the C.U.P. "People really get interested when there's a mystery and this is one of the biggest mysterious out there."

Some believers say the lake may play a role in the sightings. "Lake Erie has always been a pretty mysterious lake, there's always been kind of strange things happening out there," said Clark. "Sometimes people always wonder if there's a connection back to power plants, other things along those lines maybe attracting something there," said Thomas Wertman. He is a member of the C.U.P. and the Mutual UFO Network, a national organization.

According to Wertman, a team spread out one night near Lorain, Cleveland and Euclid to investigate what Eugene keeps seeing and they did it with Eugene's help. "I happened to be on the phone with the witness that same night and he confirmed, yes, we're both seeing the same object in the same direction in the sky, yes it's appearing at the same time and it appeared multiple times that night."

Using star charts and flight tracking software, Wertman determined the lights are coming from airplanes likely making a turn as they land at Hopkins. "Everything pointed in that direction and there really isn't too much doubt in my mind what it was," said Wertman. But that determination isn't unanimous. "Um, yeah, they're not airplanes," said Michael Lee Hill. "I mean, this is completely unusual," said Erlikh. He's open to the possibility that it could be anything, but there's little doubt in their mind - like it or not, we are not alone.

"Just look up, man," said Hill. "And don't be afraid of this phenomenon. If they meant us harm, we wouldn't be talking right now."

NASA won't comment and a spokesperson for the FAA said they're not funded by Congress to investigate UFO sightings. Copyright © 2010, <u>WJW-TV</u>

New York prof plans to teach UFO course

UFOs and other unexplained phenomena in space should be studied in university courses just like English and math. That's the position of an American anthropology professor who is putting together the curriculum for a credit course to cover the subject.

"My interest in UFOs stems from . . . my interest in anthropology and in different world views and how they affect people's perceptions and behaviours," said Prof. Philip Haseley of the Niagara County College, a state university in New York.

He argues that there is a large body of evidence around UFO sightings and other space news and that students and scientists should have the opportunity to study it, research it and document findings. "There is an enormous amount of evidence to investigate," said Haseley, who is also section director of the Western New York Mutual UFO Network.

"It needs to have exposure to a university setting to students and to faculty who see it being taught as a legitimate subject. "To me, it is something that is a nobrainer. It ought to have been done a long time ago and the fact that it hasn't been done strikes me as extraordinarily strange." There are classes at other universities in the U.S. already. "It is something I would like to see a lot more of," said Haseley.

University of B.C. astronomy and astrophysics Prof. Douglas Scott said UFOs are covered in lectures but the test for students is that extraordinary claims require extraordinary evidence.

"There are lots of things people see in the sky, and people who study them in detail," said Scott, adding that his department regularly gets calls from people reporting "weird things" in the sky. "There is no evidence that there are aliens coming to visit us. But of course we should study these things — a good scientist should be open minded.

"Frankly, all astronomers would kill to find out that there are really aliens coming to Earth. It would be fantastic . . . There is no evidence that we have been visited by aliens even though most astronomers probably believe they are out there."

Chris Rutkowski, research co-ordinator for Ufology Research based in Winnipeg, supports the study of UFOs as a legitimate university subject.

"I think what [Haseley] is saying is sound in the sense that it should be discussed more openly in an academic and scholarly setting," said Rutkowski, author of The Canadian UFO Report: The Best cases Revealed.

"I think it is a matter of being brave enough to think about UFOs rationally in an academic setting."

Bright light was UFO says East Texan

NACOGDOCHES, TX (KTRE) - A Nacogdoches man gazed into Sunday night's sky, and was transfixed by mysterious bright shapes. He says he saw a UFO. "It was just sitting up there, just bouncing up and down, bouncing up and down, moving back and fourth," said Albert Davis.

He was driving home from work with his family when bright, flickering lights caught his eye. "We knew it wasn't from here on Earth because...we've seen jets flying around and I don't think [it was] jets," said Davis. "We knew jets couldn't make the moves it was making."

Davis says the UFO hovered above his apartment for two hours. Then, he spotted more. "And, one was over there and one was in the back out there - pretty good distance out in the back," he said. "It was just following us."

Davis believes what he saw was a flying saucer. He says he has never seen anything like it light up the night sky before. "[It] changed colors, threw something out of it, made a circle, it just made a circle and it shot back down toward the east way [and] disappeared," said Davis.

Astronomer Norman Markworth studies the East Texas sky. He says there is a logical explanation for this sighting. "There's a well-known psychological phenomena that if you look at something bright against a blank background it might appear to move on you," explained Markworth. "So, I feel certain that what we have here is a sighting of Venus."

Despite what anyone thinks, Davis says he knows exactly what he saw and will never forget. "Now, I'll probably look into space every night wondering if it's going to return or what's going to happen next," he said.

Davis says he is a little nervous after his UFO sighting and has had trouble sleeping.

Officials: Object not UFO; but what was it?

Something strange was in the sky Tuesday night.

The Schuylkill County Communications Center received several calls Tuesday about an unidentifiable flying object near Pottsville, according to Director Scott Krater.

"The police checked it. It was not a UFO," Krater said Wednesday afternoon.

Even tough he didn't definitively identify it, Krater said the object may have been a balloon of some sort, and the UFO perception was fueled by Tuesday night's full moon and starlit sky.

One witness described the object as looking "like a Christmas tree," complete with red and green lights. "It was coming over top of the courthouse. It was almost following Route 61," Robert Davis, 52, of Pottsville, said Tuesday. Davis said he and others saw the object while inside Schuylkill Medical Center-East Norwegian Street, where he is a patient.

UFOs reported in Alabama, Florida, and over Roswell ... Georgia

As folks in the Midwest today ponder the fireball they saw crossing the night sky, some in the Southeast have their own strange phenomena to contemplate.

More UFO sightings lately have been reported in Alabama, Georgia and Florida, according to the online UFO newsletter Filer's Files, compiled by George Filer.

Here's a report from Jacksonville, Ala., just north of Anniston: "I was driving home on Highway 204 at around 6:30 p.m., on March 31, when a bright flash of lightning revealed a metal object in the sky. There were no lights on the silver object. The lightning flash lasted 2 seconds. After it was dark again, I could not see the object, but I slowed down and the lightning flashed again, but this time the object was gone. I am positive about what I saw. It was cigar shaped, but it could have been a classic disk shape, with the middle being thicker than the ends. Because I only saw it briefly, it didn't appear to be moving, just a pretty big cigar hovering about quarter-mile away...."

On March 28 in Roswell, Ga., a witness saw a craft with a single blinking light move across the sky at 9:27 p.m. Knowing regular aircraft lights, "he was convinced that the craft was not a conventional aircraft." For 30 seconds he watched as it moved "back and forth," dropped rapidly and then vanished, he said.

On April 1 in Fernandina Beach, Fla., a witness reported seeing "large hovering lights covering the ground" in his backyard.

Michigan teen watches small triangle UFO hover over backyard

A 15-year-old Michigan girl watched a small triangle-shaped UFO briefly hover over her backyard and then move quickly away on April 22, 2010, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) database.

The girl's parent reported the incident on April 24, 2010.

"She describes it as being dark, triangular shaped and thick like a rock with a metallic look to it," the parent stated. "She said it remained for a few seconds then basically disappeared to the north."

The parent questioned the child after learning about the encounter.

"I asked her if it had windows- no. I asked her if it was large enough to hold people- she didn't think so. I asked her exactly where the orange lights were located on the craft- she claimed that the corners were glowing dim and that she didn't see any direct bright lights. I wanted to know just how close this thing was and so I asked her if she thought a rock could possibly hit it if she threw one and she replied yes (omg). I also asked her if there was any type of noise coming from the object and unfortunately she had earphones on listening to music from her mp3 but she did turn off the music at some point during the encounter and with her earplugs still in, she still didn't hear any noise."

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. Please keep in mind that most UFO reports can be explained as something natural or manmade. If Michigan MUFON investigates and reports back on this case, I will release an update.

MI, April 22, 2010 - My 15 yr. old daughter witnessed small aircraft hovering right in our yard. MUTON Case # 22951.

On the evening of April 22, 2010 my 15 year old daughter claims to have witnessed a strange triangular object hovering in our yard.

It all started when she was swinging back and forth on the swing and she noticed something in the sky off to the west. It was quite a distance away and as it began to get closer she thought possibly it was a helicopter getting ready to land in our yard but as it continued to get even closer she knew it was too small to be a helicopter.

It started fom the west in an eastward direction then shifted slightly to the north and back eastward until it was over our roof and into the east side of our yard. It suddenly remained stationary for a few seconds.

She describes it as being dark, triangular shaped and thick like a rock with a metallic look to it. She said it remained for a few seconds then basically disappeared to the north.

What was even more astonishing was the speed at which it departed. It was so incredibly fast that it seemed to disappear right before her eyes.

Immediately after her experience she came into the house and stood there with this dumbfounded look. I won't ever forget the look on her face as she was trying to tell us what she just saw, but we were oblivious as we were all laughing and arguing about something that I really don't remember at this time. She had this nervous laugh that almost seemed to be mixed with heavy breathing and panting as she was having difficulty getting any words out.

And then the words came out, " I think I saw a ufo" that was when we all began to lower our voices and focus solely on her.

I must admit sarcasm wanted to get the best of me initially following her comment but her laugh turned immediately into sobbing and she was so visibly shaken that I thought she was going to collapse. All I could do was go over to her and pull her into me to calm her. After she told us what happened we all went outside to see if we could see anything and by this time darkness was falling.

We all witnessed approximately 4-5 aircraft in the night skies over St. Clair County. I personally believe the aircrafts were from Selfridge and maybe they tracked this strange object on radar.

Needless to say I probed my daughter with questions. I asked her if it had windows- no. I asked her if it was large enough to hold people- she didn't think so. I asked her exactly where the orange lights were located on the craft- she claimed that the corners were glowing dim and that she didn't see any direct bright lights. I wanted to know just how close this thing was and so I asked her if she thought a rock could possibly hit it if she threw one and she replied yes (omg). I also asked her if there was any type of noise coming from the object and unfortunately she had earphones on listening to music from her mp3 but she did turn off the music at some point during the encounter and with her earplugs still in, she still didn't hear any noise.

I also want to mention that the entire object was rotating in an unusual manner- not just in an up & down fashion but sideways as well (at the same time). The bottom was flat, metallic and smooth and the top was thick and maybe domed shaped? It had some sort of pattern to it that she isn't very clear about but claims that it sort of resembles a rock cut in half. I am just amazed by the fact that it was that close!!!

Anyway, I still continue to question her.

CA, April 15, 2010 - Triangular craft seen. <u>MUFON Case #</u> 22865.

At approximately 9 P.M. PDT on April 15th, 2010 in Ventura California.

I was looking toward the west at the constellation of Orion when I heard a brief "screech" sound lasting around one second and coming from the vicinity which I was viewing. Thinking it was an owl I quickly looked for it and saw a faint silhouette of something moving in the clear sky.

At first it looked like it was a large bird high in the air as the front and two sides were heavily darkened against the mostly dark sky. It was moving toward me and over a period of about 2 seconds it became clearer and resembled a hang-glider. It was descending and moving toward the east and seemed to be gliding smoothly, making no sound that I could hear.

As it reached its closest point to me, what looked to be several hundred feet or so, a very sharp and definite outline appeared. It was an equilateral triangle and had three circular areas symmetrically placed near the tips. There was a slight contrast between the gray triangular area and the circular areas, as the circular portions had a very faint glowing quality to them.

As it silently continued moving away from me, the craft seemed to have only 2 dimensions. It looked completely flat like it was a projection. It began to gently ripple with smooth wave patterns and disappeared within a little over a second after doing so. The total event lasted around 8 seconds.

I have my master's degree in physics and teach college level physics as a career. I am also involved in astronomy. I am about

20 minutes drive from a naval base and do hear and see military aircraft from time to time. Though it is possible that I was seeing a "secret aircraft", I am doubtful that such a craft would be flown in such plain view as it was very apparent what was seen.

Judging from the change in angular diameter, its descent was fairly rapid and it changed from a dark, fluctuating shadow into a crisp configuration, lightly contrasted against the clear dark sky. I would estimate the base of the triangle to be around 50 feet, though I could be way off. Once leveled off at around 500 feet, it glided forward at perhaps 100 miles per hour until it disappeared from sight somewhat like a mirage does.

The measured angle from the horizontal at which the craft began to wave out of sight was around 20 degrees. It all happened very fast and was short in duration, making it difficult to be definite on measurements. All in all, I saw a craft without doubt and I am perplexed by what I have seen.

A few of these boomerang objects have been seen over California in the past few weeks which has prompted some enthusiasts to pay closer attention to strategic areas such as military and research facilities for some sort of new flying machine. MUFON report April 17, 2010

My friends and I were in our hometown of Red Bluff, CA, for the annual rodeo each year, on April 17, 2010, and we had just finished eating dinner at our friend Barry's house. Around 9:30 PM we decided to go into town for the festivities, and since there were more than a handful of us, a few of us had to jump in the back of my buddy Travis' truck. We were all laying down in the bed of the truck so that we wouldn't be pulled over. It was myself, Ken, Barry, and Barry's brother Corey, who were in the back of the truck.

As we drove along, we were all talking loud, looking around at different things as we whizzed along Wilcox Rd, when suddenly I hear Ken yell out, "Hey, I see a f---ing UFO!!" and I was like, "What? You're kidding," and I look up into the middle of the sky directly overhead and see this strange shape that at first reminded me of an angular cloud, in a kind of boomerang shape, but a cloud that was moving, and moving quite briskly. It immediately clicked in my mind that this was not a natural object or a natural cloud. It moved in a fashion that is impossible for a cloud, and there was not a natural cloud in the nightsky, it was completely clear out. As my disbelief turned to awe I continued to stare at the object as it glided over our position in complete silence, and I saw that within the cloudy substance that flowed from the front of the object to the rear, was a geometric boomerang shaped object, with sharp lines, as if drawn by a ruler, contrasting against the background. The cloudy mist-like substance seemed to spring forth out of nothing from the front of the object, and trailed over the rest of the craft towards the rear. And as we gazed on in amazement for what was probably at most, 10 seconds, it approached the tree filled horizon, and that coupled with our turn on the road, took it out of our view.

We could not believe our eyes, and started cursing a myriad of profanities uttering our complete amazement at what the hell just happened, and what the hell we just saw. Barry and Corey had looked up a bit later than Ken and I, and had failed to see the geometric boomerang shape within the cloudy substance, but they did see the cloudy mist, in an angular fashion, gliding across the sky in a straight line briskly. It had absolutely no sound at all, no lights, and moved in a completely straight line, in a direction that I believe was North or Northeast. We have no idea how big it was, only that it looked extremely large. When talking about it with Ken later he told me that he held his hand up to the sky afterwards, with his pinky finger and index finger extended outwards, the others tucked in, in a sort of devil's horn you might say, and he felt like the distance between the two fingers pointing outwards was a good approximation of the wingspan of the strange object in the sky. This however, really does not

solve the qustion of just how big it really was, rather it only makes the argument for it being rather large. If it was close to us in the sky, it was still huge as all hell, and if it was even higher up in the sky, then its size is even larger, almost mind boggling large.

This story is written with all honesty and complete truth. Both Ken and I had always believed in the possibility of UFOs, but had never seen or experienced anything like this in our lives. After talking about it more and more, we both feel like this is an event that has changed our lives forever. To us there is no question about it: this was a real UFO, and it was not of this Earth. There is absolutely nothing manmade out there, not the stealth bomber, or anything, that can match up to what we saw that night. Immediately the following day after seeing the object, I began to research online what sightings of UFOs were out there that met the same description, and I came upon a sighting of a UFO seen over Belville, Texas, in September of 2009, Case Number 19343. The article describing the UFO fit our description perfectly in almost every detail. The way it was described to be moving, that at first it seemed to be a fast moving cloud, but not a cloud at all, the way it looked, and the way it glided across the sky in a straight line. After reading this I knew that this was the exact same craft we saw, and that we were not alone in witnessing such a spectacular object.

I will forever be changed by this. Let people judge me how they may, but I speak the truth. This is what I saw, and I was not alone in seeing it. Something IS out there.

UFO 'five times size of moon' reported over Warm Springs Indian Reservation

Warm Springs Indian Reservation is in north central Oregon. An Oregon witness watched a mostly dark object "five times the size of the moon" move over the Warm Springs Indian Reservation on April 10, 1988, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) database. The sighting was reported to MUFON on April 21, 2010.

The object's surface was described as rough with debris falling off of it.

"I noticed a very rough surface and saw a very small piece of debris fall away at the same spot from which arose a small bluewhite flicker of flame," the witness stated. "The object was moving slow enough at this time, that the flame was not influenced by the wind or the forward motion."

The witness found two others who watched the object that day.

Warm Springs Indian Reservation is located in north central Oregon and is governed by the Cofederated Tribes of Warm Springs.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. If Oregon MUFON State Director Tom Bowden investigates and reports back on this case, I will release an update.

OR, April 10, 1988 - I was one of three witnesses to a roughsurfaced, silent, slow-moving, large, spherical object at approximately 9:30 pm. <u>MUFON Case # 22923</u>.

In the spring of 1988, i was walking from the hot-springs fed swimming-pool and daytime resort complex, across the unlit road, to the employee housing complex, probably one-quarter mile southeast, and uphill.

After leaving the pavement, I was on the steeper narrow dirt path, and had to hold an arm out to block tall weeds and shrubs.

As I walked, I was looking forward and up, and I saw what I first thought was the moon, but it was moving toward the east very slowly.

As I stopped and watched the object,I realized it was slowing down. I noticed a very rough surface and saw a very small piece of debris fall away at the same spot from which arose a small blue-white flicker of flame. The object was moving slow enough at this time, that the flame was not influenced by the wind or the forward motion. The object moved from approximately a 7:00 position to a 4:00 position across my field of vision. The object took maybe two to two and one half minutes to cross my field of vision.

I was walking south- south- east. After the object passed over the trees and ridges to the east,I stood still, and hoped to hear it hit. I heard nothing. I then hurried the next couple of hundred yards to my apartment, and rushed in to tell my girlfriend about the funny-moving, odd-looking thing I had just seen. She pretty-much just appeared uninterested.I then went back outside to see if anyone else was able to see what I saw.

The security guard was just pulling up outside by the side walk. I asked him if he had seen what I had just seen. He said he had and it scared him. I suggested that he should report it to someone. He didn't act like he was in any hurry to tell anyone. I do not ever remember discussing the subject again with him. I asked around and only one other person admitted to me that they had seen the object. The other person was born again religious and simply shrugged it off as a manifestation of god.

This incident occurred on (over?) the warm springs indian reservation. The object was easily five times the size of the sun or moon. The object was mostly dark, but was clearly visible, and had small patches of reddish-orange, and other small patches of blueish-white. The small piece of debris that sort of popped out or off was from a blue-white patch.

US: Pennsylvania MUFON investigators capture triangle UFO on camera Roger Marsh

Witness image was cropped and enlarged. A Pennsylvania Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) Chief Investigator and State Section Director out investigating a UFO sighting with a witness at two locations captured on camera a triangle-shaped object at the first location and witnessed an "arc-like, crescent-shaped light that glowed pinkish-red" at the second location, according to testimony from the MUFON witness reporting database.

Pennsylvania MUFON Chief Investigator Bob Gardner said that he and State Section Director Michael "Doc" Melton concluded that the triangle object was "a solid object, cloaked, but with enough physical substance left to pick it up on this camera, 12.1 megapixel, and obviously sensitive to both UV and IR spectrum."

Both Gardner and Melton are based in the Philadelphia metro area. The triangle sighting area was an "old farm site" in the region. The two were taking photos of the horizon and later noticed orbs in the image and the triangle-shaped light.

The second area was a state park several miles away from the farm where they noticed the pinkish-red light in the shape of an arc or crescent.

Both sightings were at night. The second object was not captured on film. Pennsylvania State Director John Ventre said it is unusual for their own investigators to capture craft on film, but points out that Pennsylvania in general, and especially the eastern end of the state has been a hot bed of UFO traffic over the past year and-a-half.

While UFOs are being reported on a regular basis from most states, Pennsylvnia is currently one of the highest reporting states for UFO activity. Other states include Florida, Texas, and California.

The following is the unedited report filed Gardner filed with MUFON.

Pennsylvania, April 15, 2010 - While out on a follow up investigation of an assigned case CI, SSD, & case witness witnessed several unexplained events. MUFON Case <u>a. 22852</u>.

1. Investigating a case for MUFON by taking photographs & readings of an old farm site, we captured on film a triangular shaped craft that appeared to be a light in the sky (a) & a bit later while on location in a State Park several miles away, we witnessed a arc-like/crescent shaped pinkish-red light/craft (b) in the sky.

2a. Checking the digital pictures & saw orbs in the picture, but then I said what the hell is that dot of light in the upper corner.

2b. Checking the horizon.

3a. A light in the sky not seen with the naked eye.

3b. Looked like the bottom crescent of the moon, but in the wrong direction.

4a. n/a.

4b. It was moving slowly towards us & moving up @ a 45 degree angle then it dematerialized before our eyes.

5a. We were like wow that is strange. It wasn't till we arrived home that the SSD downloaded the pics & saw it was triangular.

5b. We were awe-struck because we never saw anything like this.

6a. We never saw it until viewing the pics on the digital camera.

6b. It dematerialized slowly & faded away.

'Meteor' Lights Up U.S. Midwest

The U.S. Midwest is abuzz with UFO talks after a huge fireball lit up the skies late Wednesday night. The National Weather Service said the light lasted about 15 minutes and disintegrated into smaller pieces before disappearing. The fireball was reportedly seen in Wisconsin, Iowa, Illinois, and Ohio.

Some people reported hearing a long sonic boom at the time that the fireball was seen over the Midwest skies. The huge noise was followed by the shaking of houses and trees, among other things, the NWS said. Experts have yet to exactly identify the fireball, but the NWS believes that it may have been a wayward meteor that made its way into earth. According to the NWS, The Gamma Virginids meteor shower, which began on April 4, is still ongoing and it may have caused the massive fireball.

The NWS said it has yet to determine if parts of the suspected meteor hit the ground after disintegrating.

Meteor falls from the sky, bits found near Livingston

Many people were astonished recently when a flash of light crept through the blinds and a sonic boom rattled the windows, on the night of April 14, around 10 p.m.

Reports from the Associated Press speculate that a meteor may have strayed from the meteor shower "Gamma Virginids," which ran April 4 through April 21.


Doppler radar from the National Weather Service in La Crosse was able to observe entry across the Grant, Iowa, and Lafayette County area.

"My wife and I were arriving home for the night and we were just walking up the sidewalk as everything lit up just like it was day break," reported Gays Mills barber, Robert E. Lee.

There have been rumors circulating among the people of the area that the meteor set a few trees on fire by Blue River and Avoca, but the Grant County Sheriff's Department confirms that they were indeed just controlled burns that were conducted by the DNR.

"We were outside enjoying the beautiful night, we had a great view of little lights flashing," reported Patrick Schendel of rural Mt. Sterling. "Then suddenly there was this huge flash, and the boom. I knew it had to be a meteor. Others I was with were convinced it was some sort of UFO or something."

Many chunks have been found by

meteorite hunters near Livingston, Mifflin and Linden. The largest piece has been found in Livingston.

One owner of a few pieces of special history is Tim Boldt, Platteville. Boldt's family owns farmland in the Livingston area. On the night of the crash, men who are renting the Boldt family's land witnessed the large fireball and subsequent sonic boom. They figured it was a dangerous storm moving into the area and proceeded to move the tractors inside the barn. A few moments later they heard something strike the shed roof. They walked outside to find a piece of what later was identified as a meteorite, most likely the first piece found in what continues to be an ongoing search for treasure.

The piece that was found was sent to UW Madison for analysis, which concluded that it was, in fact, a meteorite.

Boldt and others hunted the land on Friday and Saturday, walking for about four hours on Saturday. "It was like looking for a needle in a haystack," said Boldt. They have been able to collect four pieces to this point. The largest piece weighs about 135 grams. Tim's wife, Angie, a teacher at Iowa-Grant, took one of the pieces to show the students on Monday. Boldt hasn't had any problems with hunters on his land without permission. He explained the hunters walk along the road looking for the pieces and if they find any they take them to the landowner in hopes of buying them.


Of the four pieces that have been found on the Boldt land, one was sent to the Field Museum of Natural History in Chicago, Ill., for studying, one was sold to Mike Farmer, a top meteorite hunter in the world, and the remaining two are being kept by the family. One of the two the family is keeping will be loaned to the geological museum in Madison.

Boldt believes the 135-gram piece that was sent to Chicago will be used to classify the meteorite.

Keeping with tradition the meteor will likely be called Livingston, as a meteor is typically named after the post office closest to the largest piece found.

People have been coming from far and wide to try and get their hands on a small piece of history. Many serious researchers have been combing the area, from UW-Madison, Chicago's Field Museum of Natural History, and even Europe.

It is reported that meteorite pieces can fetch between \$2 and \$8 per

gram.

Although the meteor caused no damage, area law enforcement received an overwhelming amount of calls regarding the incident. Grant County Sheriff Keith Govier appreciated all the citizens' calls and sent out a statement to news outlets apologizing to those who felt as though they were not taken seriously.

Engineer spots disc-shaped UFO over Warwick, Rhode Island skies

A Warwick, RI, civil engineer reported seeing a disc-shaped UFO on April 24, 2010, at 3 p.m. that was observed from a local parking lot, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) database.

The witness describes the object as "a intensely bright, white, circular object in a northeasterly direction and approximately 70 degrees above the horizon."

"I thought it funny that it just hung in that position for many minutes," the witness stated, "but it was lazily moving extremely slowly generally in a figure-eight pattern, which I verified by lining the object up with the edge of my car door jamb. As far as I could tell, the object did not vary in brightness, color or shape during my total observation. It was brighter than a daytime observation of the planet Venus and it definitely exhibited a diameter (disclike). I did have the distinct impression that it was spherical but without the aide of optics I was unsure."

Warwick is a city in Kent County, Rhode Island, the second largest city in the state, population 85,808.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. Please keep in mind that most UFO reports can be explained as something natural or manmade. If New England MUFON State Director Steve Firmani investigates and reports back on this case, I will release an update.

RI, April 24, 2010 - Bright White Circular Disc Observation in Warwick, RI on 4/24/10. <u>MUFON Case # 22957</u>.

My observations were made from the parking lot in front of TJ Maxx store in the Target Shopping Center on the west side of Bald Hill Road (Rte 2), in Warwick, RI on April 24, 2010 at 3 pm. Sky condition was 35% scattered thin cirrus clouds (wide bands similar in shape to jet contrails) in a transparent blue sky. Temperature was about 70 deg F.

I was sitting in my car looking in an easterly direction with sunroof open, due to the heating from the bright sun. I was waiting for my wife while she was shopping at the Maxx.

To pass the time while eating my apple snack I started to watch jet planes high overhead (approx 15,000) as they were making a beeline to and from Boston's Logan Airport. I watched several of the northbound jets and at one time I noticed what I first thought was a white jet at a higher altitude traveling southeasterly (diagonally) across the apparent path of a Boston bound jet.

I then noticed 3-4 of these small white winged objects and concluded they must be seagulls soaring high above Warwick, which is not uncommon for this city of 100,000 +/- on Narragansett Bay.

Anyway, I watched another jet continuing along the same "to Boston" trajectory and then noticed a intensely bright, white, circular object in a northeasterly direction and approximately 70 degrees above the horizon. I thought it funny that it just hung in that position for many minutes, but it was lazily moving extremely slowly generally in a figure-eight pattern, which I verified by lining the object up with the edge of my car door jamb. As far as I could tell, the object did not vary in brightness, color or shape during my total observation. It was brighter than a daytime observation of the planet Venus and it definitely exhibited a diameter (disclike). I did have the distinct impression that it was spherical but without the aide of optics I was unsure.

After several minutes of watching the object at the initial altitude, it started to drift slowly in a nearly straight path to the northeast --- my tall vertical light stanchion was my reference to determine this, for sure. I continued watching until the object met a cirrus cloud and then I lost it at about 40 degrees above the horizon. At last sight, the diameter of the object did appear to shrink a little bit, but the brightness did not. My sighting lasted apporximately 25 minutes and, unfortunately, ended about 10 minutes before my wife returned from shopping...I was hoping I could show this to her to get her impressions.

After I spotted the object I wondered what it could be. Venus? No, wrong position. Another plane with lights coming toward me? No, too slow and not a pinpooint light source and planes don't wobble in an almost stationary position. A helicopter? No, uniformly lit and probably too high. A weather balloon? Maybe, but strange behavior for a weather balloon. I also initially thought it might be a daylight supernova until I examined it more intently and noticed the slight wobbling motion.

I did not think of UFO at first but I came to that conclusion as my observation went on. It brought back a memory of the same kind of sighting I had when I was about 13 years old when one summer day I was playing in a park with the neighborhood kids, also in Warwick, RI. I have had several other sightings over the years but never reported them to anyone. My last sighting was a few years ago when I was in Florida on vacation.

I have been an amateur astronomer since a teenager and own a couple of telescopes. I am also a ham radio operator. I am a professional engineer (civil) licensed to practice in several states.

Fleet of objects maneuvering over Sacramento region of California, May 7th 2010.

This is more of a common occurrence then most people are aware of. The majority of people live their lives with their eyes at or below the 20 foot level. How often do you really keep your eyes tuned into the upper areas of the sky and for how long? If you want to see something wild and crazy, validating what many claim to be UFO's in the sky over head, then take a few hours with some friends on a clear night in an area where the stars can clearly be seen and just pay attention. Lay back on the front windshield of your vehicle and take it all in.

The difference between aerial observation in a large city and a secluded area of less population is like night and day. Decrease the amount of smog filters and big city lights your looking through and what your left with is a clear unobstructed canvas to see a sky that will reveal an array of unfamiliar objects buzzing around.

There they are,....those UFOs are real...... What are they?

The following is one of those UFO reports that was not accompanied by any footage or images to validate the witnesses claims yet exciting enough to post for our readers entertainment.

The event occurred in the Sacramento area of California between large city areas on the open freeway on May 7th 2010. Once again a better place to observe. Many creditable sightings are made by witnesses on the open road while traveling between destinations. This particular sighting was witnessed by a fellow enthusiast and local UFO researcher, K. Piper, from the Sacramento area of California. We recieved the following notification from K.P. and felt compelled to post this one for some of you locals out there who have also witnessed such activity.

Below is the statement submitted by the witness regarding this incident on May 7th 2010

I'm kicking myself really hard right now... I had an amazing sighting this morning on my way north toward Yuba City. I was just south of Lincoln ... I saw 12-15 shiny objects in the sky. I was on my motorcycle so I could not pay 100 % attention right away. I saw a "cluster" of objects... my mind said balloons at first... glanced between the sky and the road in front of me several times ... the objects moved from a "cluster" to a "wedge or V" shape in what seemed to be 2-3 seconds. I took the next right off the highway road to find myself in an empty parking lot between two short buildings ... the lot was completely vacant. The group of objects moved slowly north by north east. I watched them travel for about a minute and then all but one of the objects vanished instantly. The one remaining object moved back in a south by south west direction and stopped nearly directly over my head. It hung above me, for two or so minutes before moving back in the north by north east direction where another object moved in from a right angle to fly beside it. I lost sight of both objects after 2 to 3 minutes. I tried to get my wife on the phone while this was all happening but ended up leaving a very excited detailed message in her voice mail box. I had my camera with me but failed epically to get pictures because I didn't check all the pockets of my back pack and consequently convinced myself that I had left it at home... I guess I was too distracted. I had the camera all along. Epic failure ... but what a sighting. I hadn't seen anything since 1993 and now I've had two sightings this year ... this one was pretty epic ... it reminded me greatly of the "cluster" videos taken in Mexico ... the fact that they moved into a formation was amazing to me. I saw two large birds in the vicinity, one jet airliner, one smaller plane, and the moon was over my left shoulder during this event. From my perspective the unidentified objects seemed to be higher than any of the other flying things I witnessed.

Russian MP calls for UFO probe

A Russian MP has called for an investigation into a government official's claims that he had contact with extraterrestrials.

On April 26, Kirsan Ilyumzhinov, the leader of the southern Russian region of Kalmykia, told a prime time television show that he was taken to a spaceship sent to Earth by extraterrestrials.

Ilyumzhinov told television host Vladimir Pozner on Russia's Channel One that he had spent several hours in the company of aliens. He said they visited his apartment in downtown Moscow on September 18, 1997.

"I believe I talked to them and saw them. I perhaps wouldn't believe it if it wasn't for 3 witnesses — my driver, my minister, and my assistant," who were apparently in the apartment at the time, Ilyumzhinov told the television host.

Ilyumzhinov said the aliens gave him a tour of their spaceship and said they had come to Earth to take samples.

On Wednesday, Russian parliamentarian Andre Lebedev called for an inquiry into the claims and wrote a letter to Russian President Dmitry Medvedev raising a list of his concerns. In his letter he said that — assuming the whole thing was not just a bad joke — it was a historic event and should have been reported to the Kremlin.

He also asked if there are official guidelines for what government officials should do if contacted by aliens, especially if those officials have access to state secrets.

NASA spacecraft 'hijacked by aliens'

A GERMAN UFO expert has claimed that a NASA spacecraft may have been hijacked by aliens - who are now attempting to contact the Earth.

Hartwig Hausdorf claims that *Voyager 2* - an unmanned interplanetary probe blasted into space 33 years ago - has started transmitting strange, unintelligible signals, *Bild* newspaper revealed today

NASA installed a 12-inch disk containing music and greetings in 55 languages in case intelligent extraterrestrial life ever found it.

But last month the probe began sending back distorted messages from its location near the edge of the solar system that baffled NASA scientists were unable to decode, Mr Hausdorf says.

"It seems almost as if someone had reprogrammed or hijacked the probe, thus perhaps we do not yet know the whole truth," the author of *UFOs* - *They Are Still Flying* told *Bild*.

The signal from *Voyager 2* - which takes 13 hours to reach the Earth - broke off fully on April 22. NASA said engineers were working to solve a data transmission fault.

The space agency has not commented specifically on Mr Hausdorf's comments, although it says the fault is likely to be a glitch in the probe's computer memory

Voyager 2 and its twin, *Voyager 1*, were launched in 1977 to explore Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. Three decades on, they are the most distant human-made objects in outer space.

Voyager 1 is currently more than 8.5 billion miles from Earth. It will soon travel beyond the heliosphere - a bubble the sun creates around the solar system - into interstellar space, scientists say

Mysterious UFO footage shows craft hovering over village

A MYSTERIOUS video has appeared on the internet, supposedly showing a UFO hovering over Chalfont St Giles. The video, which has been posted on You Tube, shows the alien aircraft over the pond and Merlin's Cave pub in the village centre. It stays there for a short while before being chased off by two military jets and disappearing into the sky.

The video appeared online on Saturday and was filmed in broad daylight. The Advertiser was informed of the video in two different emails, although the authenticity of it is doubtful.

One of the emails came from someone calling themselves Ant Grewbag, which is the name of a website which looks into UFOs and conspiracy theories surrounding the phenomena. The website says: "On Wednesday, April 14, 2010, military jets were involved in a high speed air pursuit with an alien spacecraft. "The chase began over Northern Europe and ended when the saucer type craft crashed 25 miles outside of London.

"This is Britain's very first Roswell type incident, but, unlike the events of 1947, the British Ministry of Defence have not managed to catch their alien.

"The being is alive and on the run." The site goes onto claim that the craft eventually crashed near to Chalfont St Giles in Coleshill, and also give pictures of what "experts" think the alien would look like.

Myers, 27, said she stopped her car on the side of the road to grab her camera from the glove box, but the light disappeared. "It was pretty spooky," she stated.

There were more sightings at Coolalinga on April 24, Acacia Hills on April 25 and again in Howard Springs on April 27.

But astronomer Geoff Carr told the Northern Territory News he was "far from believing any of this UFO stuff". "Unless aliens have found a way to travel faster than light speed, it's a doubtful thing to believe they came to visit us," he said. Carr added he believed 99.9 per cent of all the UFO sightings could be explained as simple weather phenomena. (ANI)

ANOTHER UFO has been spotted over the skies of InvernessThe sighting of "an orange fireball" in the sky over the city on Sunday night was reported by an RAF serviceman and his wife. Their description of the object is similar to that reported by Culloden man Rob Jackson who in March told the HN he had seen a UFO four times over Nairn and Inverness.

Further claims of UFO sightings in the area followed.

This week, Heather and Karl King said they were in their garden on Sunday night when they spotted the unusual phenomenon at about 10.30pm in the sky from their New Elgin home in Moray. Mr King (33), who is ground crew at RAF Lossiemouth, is an aviation enthusiast and plane spotter.

Mrs King said they saw what looked like an orange fireball and her husband reckoned it was above Inverness. "It was an orange flame and was hovering. It came towards us then the light died out and it became a black sphere and started to spin towards the ground but we lost it in the cloud. It was really big and there was no noise."

She said they couldn't believe what they were seeing and Karl went inside to get a telescope and they observed the light for a couple of minutes before it finally disappeared. Mr King said: "We went online to see if there were any meteor showers and there were none that we could find. But we came across the Highland News stories and the description was very similar to what we saw.

"As an RAF man I'm an aviation enthusiast. I know planes when I see them but I have never seen anything like this before. My thoughts were at that height it must have been in the Inverness area.

"UFOs are not something I have really thought about but this was definitely unexplained and it was definitely not a Chinese lantern." Mr King even considered the possibility that it could have been debris from a space shuttle.

"But I don't think a space shuttle separation could be seen in this part of the world and if something like that was going to happen we would have heard about it. I couldn't put my finger on what it was, but it wasn't an aircraft."

Mrs King added: "I would be amazed if we were the only people who saw it."

Earlier this year, Mr Jackson described how he saw an orange fireball as he travelled along the A96 approaching Nairn from the east. He parked on the Grantown Road to observe the strange phenomenon. The following evening, joined by his mother, they saw the same spherical orange light the size of a tractor cab travelling at speed along the Moray Firth coast. He had similar sightings in Inverness on February 27 and again at Nairn links on March 6.

"I am pleased someone else has come out and reported a similar experience to mine," said Mr Jackson. "I would urge other people to come forward. I am positive thousands of people must have seen what I saw but 99 per cent would have put it down to an aircraft. No-one has come anywhere near to explaining my sightings."

Michael Mulford, an RAF spokesman, said: "The UK is ringed with a sophisticated network of radar. Our primary interests would be search and rescue and protection of UK air space. Anything suggesting a plane in distress or our air space was being violated would have been picked up but we have no record of any unexplained activity on Sunday night."

UFOs spotted over Hounslow West

HOUNSLOW is known for it's large amount of aeroplane activity however it seems more mysterious types of flying object have also been visiting the borough.

A number of people in Hounslow West have reported seeing a UFO with five lights travelling across the sky, shortly followed by military crafts, and a young woman from Brentford spotted an unnervingly bright light.

Michal Czyz, 28, was barbecuing in his garden on Sunday evening when he and his four friends spotted five unusual lights travelling across the sky for about 10 seconds, before simply disappearing. "It was really strange, I've never seen anything like it before," said the bar tender from Avvisom Avenue. "Living in Hounslow I know what a plane looks like and this was definitely not a plane. I tried to film it on my phone but my hands were shaking too much." Mr Czyz's two friends who were on their way back from the corner shop also spotted the lights at around 9pm and saw others filming it in the street. The lights were followed by three military aircraft which Mr Czyz said patrolled the skies for about 30 minutes.

A woman from Brentford, who wishes not to be named, has also had a recent brush with paranormal activity in the borough. While driving home from work on March 20, she saw a strange light descending upon the part of the Great West Road where it first meets the M4. She told the Chronicle: "The light was so intense and bright that I was momentarily blinded and disorientated. It lasted about five or six seconds and I was too shocked to look again to see if it was indeed a vessel or another object."

The Brentford woman told how the UFO descended vertically and hovered, before either disappearing or zooming off at high speed. The woman says the UFO experience, which is her first, has had a "profound effect" on her and took her over a week to recover from the experience, suffering from regular panic attacks. "I feel better about it now," she said. "But it would be reassuring to hear if someone else might have seen the same thing."

A TERRITORY family has told how they held their breath when a UFO hovered over their home.

It was around 8pm on Friday when Susan Clarke, of Howard Springs, heard her partner yell out to her "to come out quick".

"Myself and the lad were sober, and we saw a huge spherical object that was moving horizontally across the night sky very slowly," Ms Clarke told the Sunday Territorian. "It was amazing and unnerving at the same time "It was glowing red, orange and gold - none of us had ever seen anything like it before." Ms Clarke said she grabbed her camera, but didn't manage to capture the mysterious flying object in a photo."I was shaking just looking at it, it was very eerie and made my knees weak."

The Howard Springs resident said she watched the UFO for about three or four minutes, together with her partner and his 16-year-old son, before the object took off into the night. "It veered off at a right angle, then in another direction, then just shot off at a great speed (and) disappeared. "We rang friends and asked if they had seen anything and we were totally shaken up by the experience."

The UFO is far from being the first to be seen in the Territory. Only three weeks ago, UFOs had been spotted stalking the site of the proposed NT nuclear waste dump at Muckaty Station.

In March, a Queensland businessman had an eerie encounter with "bright lights zipping around the trees" when he visited the NT's alien hot spot Wycliffe Well.

In June 2008 the community of Marlinja came to a standstill when UFOs descended on the town.

Orange lights latest UFO sighting?

FIVE mysterious orange lights spotted in the sky by a Sully family have become the latest potential UFO sighting in the Vale of Glamorgan.

The Richards family saw three of the bright lights in a triangular formation above their Oyster Bend home on Wednesday (March 24) at around 8.30pm. The quick-thinking family recorded a video of the moving lights and have posted the results on video sharing website, You Tube.

Christine Richards said: "My daughter saw the first light, then there were four more. "It was very unusual because there wasn't any noise coming from them and they looked to be in a triangular formation. "At first I thought it could be an air balloon but whatever it was, it was motoring, not floating around. "We're used to planes flying over our bungalow but this was very different," she added. "These looked like a ship or craft."

Lights that were spotted in Barry last month were said to be from Chinese Lanterns. The paper lanterns, which are lit up by a candle and drift on the wind, give a glow depending on the colour of the paper shade. Many of them are red-orange, the same colour of the glow that UFO spotters have reported. Barry Island Coastguard member Dave Ball said: "These lanterns are becoming more common and are a cause for concern around the coast of the country.

"They should not be flown around here as there is a warning on the packet not to fly within five miles of an airport.

"The light lasts for approximately 20 minutes, and light up the inside of the lantern, giving an orange-red glow."

A UFO researcher says a mystery object followed him home through the night sky.

Pat Regan, who set up the North West UFO Research project, left his son's home in Aveling Drive, Banks, West Lancashire, at around 11.30pm on Friday after a family meal.

He said: "I was travelling alone and had just passed the Plough Hotel near Banks as I made my way along the coastal road." He spotted a pale orange/white light and slowed his car down to watch the strange object as it seemed to hover motionless.

He said: "My first consideration was that this must have been one of the ubiquitous Chinese lanterns that are so popular these days. However, as I picked up speed and kept glancing out of my right side window, I noticed that the object rose in altitude and seemed to be keeping pace with my car. It was as if it was following me but keeping its distance." Pat said the UFO continued to travel above the righthand side of his car as he got closer to his home, on Brook Road, Ainsdale. He said: "This meant that the object had been travelling parallel to my course in a North to South direction for a distance of around seven to eight miles.

"Realising that lanterns are flimsy things, as soon as I got home I walked into the street to check the wind direction. "It was quite calm but as I was walking back to my door a strong gust hit me in the face – from the South West. If what I witnessed was a lantern it had hovered, and then travelled some eight miles at good speed against the prevailing wind. "I also checked weather reports which indicated that the winds for that weekend were coming in the opposite direction to that travelled by the UFO. Chinese lanterns cannot achieve feats such as riding into the wind."

Pat has set up a website and has written a book called UFO: The Search for Truth. Pat said: "My new UFO Ning site was set up to help extend the UFO debate and inform the international community about the new release of the book."

A few weeks ago, Chile was hit was one of the <u>most</u> <u>powerful earthquakes on record</u>. Now citizens of the region are coming forward with stories of UFOs on the night of the quake. Did aliens make the earth move?

People in Chile Report UFOs, Lights Emerging From The Ocean Before The Earthquake

The earthquake was followed by a boom in UFO sightings, but sixteen cases occurred on the night of the tragedy alone (some of them accompanied by significant visual material) which have been subjected to study by UFO researchers.

Researcher Rodrigo Fuenzalida told Publimetro that the highest concentrations of reports appear to be Las Condes, Peñalolén, Providencia and Colina. "We have eyewitness testimony from a couple that refused to sleep in their apartment on the night of the earthquake, choosing instead to spend the early morning hours in the street. They were able to see an object that looked much like the moon, but immediately realized that the moon was on the other side. This event may have been seen by residents of other communes," said Fuenzalida.

Another major sighting took place on Isla Robinson Crusoe, part of the Juan Fernandez Archipelago, where people witnessed an object emerging from the sea shortly before the earthquake.

Regarding the case involving a humanoid reported by passengers on a bus in Iquique — Fuenzalida notes that while startling, he is aware of other similar cases, but people "do not dare report them, fearing that they will not be believed.

"I've heard of the manifestations of these "luminous men," said the ufologist. "We are in an ideal period for sightings. I would ask everyone to be alert, but be mindful to avoid confusion, or a state of hysteria."

So lights coming out of the sea are not startling, but reports of humanoids are? I'm starting to think the aliens are planning a giant resort off the coast of Chile, and this whole thing with smashing two tectonic plates together is part of their nefarious plans.

intermittently gave off a bluish light, first one and then another. The mechanic had the impression at times that he could see through windows on the side nearest to him and on through to the other side. But he saw no movement or any other signs of occupants within the UFO.

A wide band of highly polished metal, resembling pol-ished brass, extended around the dome like a ring. On top of the dome was what looked like a retractable antenna network.

The entire object appeared to be metalic in color, but the actual color was underminable in the dusk.

The mechanic continued to stare intently at the strange craft. He had zever before seen anything even remotely resem-bling it. Along the thick rim's outside edge were what looked like evenly-spaced short jet nozzled. These were located every few feet around the entire rim. He suddenly remembered his companion, working on the F104's landing gear. The second mechanic had his head up inside the landing gear wall. The first observer frantically called to him, and after some insistance, the other man dropped down and managed to see the object for about three seconds before it shot away from the field at a high rate of speed.

Just before the UFO had sped off, the first man had seen the ball-like landing gears retract, into the bottom of the UFO, and their doors flip shut.

"We learned of this case through a NICAP member in San Francisco, Frank Micali, a. friend of the mechanic." Cerny

says. "Micali arranged for us to meet him, and his wife, but he was quite reluctant to talk or elaborate very much on his experience. To get the story at all we had to ask him questions and urge him to tell us about it. During the evening we asked if he would be willing to fill out a standard NICAP report sheet. When he found out we wanted to take his statements in report form, even though we assured him his name would be kept confidential, he clammed up.

"Shortly after the incident occurred," continues Cermy, "Air representatives aD-Force proached the two mechanics with a large book measuring about 1 1/2 inches thick. It was full of photographs of UFOs, and the men were asked to pick out the photo most nearly resembling the object they saw. The book contained pictures of many UFOs of all types and kinds, many taken off the wing tips of aircraft, others from gun cameras, in close approximation with missiles, others out in open sky, and other lesser situations. Mechanic number one found his similar UFO on a page of the book well in excess of page 300! "The two mechanics were

told," Cerny says, "that personnel in the base control tower had been watching this UFO for two or three minutes prior to the mechanics' observation of the craft from under the F104 wing. The mechanics were both told not to talk about the incident to anyone whatsoever and were asked to sign a statement to that effect, which they did at the Air Force's insistence."

Cover-Up Exposed Of UFO Landing Near Holloman Air Force Base

By ROBERT B. KLINN and DAVID BRANCH L O S ANGELES—The San Francisco Bay Area. Subcommittee of the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP) has uncovered three suppressed incidents of UFO activity over or near Holloman Air Force Base, White Sands Proving Grounds, New Mexico.

The first of these events, detailed in last week's column, involved the sighting of a lowlevel, domed disc by flight-line mechanics and tower personnel at Holloman Air Force Base. This week we received the second and third reports, which were forwarded by Paul C. Cerny, an electronics engineer who heads the subcommittee.

The second report is titled: "UFO Landing in the Proximity of Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico." The document relates the experience of two informants who have insisted upon anonymity, but who are known to subcommittee members as credible and responsible citizens. The report includes the names of eight other persons who have knowledge of the landing, including two U.S. Air Force sergeants and two colonels.

A subcommittee investigator first discovered the case through casual conversation with one of the informants, a co-worker in the San Francisco office of an international electronics firm. The informant had previously served as a civilian intelligence specialist at Holloman Air Force Base. The subcommittee member had read the book, Flying Saucers—Seri-

ous Business, by Frank Edwards. He mentioned to his coworker one incident described in the book, a landing at Holloman Air Force Base. The man assumed that the incident was the same one of which he had personal knowledge, expressed amazement that it had been published, and when questioned, related his experience. The subcommittee member soon became aware that the event being described was not the same one about which, he had read. Katha was

"Early one September morning in 1956," the subcommittee report states, "while dozens of employees of Helloman Air Force Base were driving, to work on U.S. Route 70, a disctype, domed UFO landed alongside the highway. This was at a point approximately 12 miles west of Holloman Air Force Base. The closest eyewitnesses were within 25 yards of the landed UFO.

"Associated with the landing of this craft, there appeared to be a strong, electromagnetic force field, because the radios and ignition systems of automobiles close to the object ceased to function.

"The resulting engine failures caused the morning commuter traffic to back up for a considerable distance. Individuals at the rear of the traffic jam were not aware, at that time, that an unusual craft had landed. The UFO was on the ground for 10 to 15 minutes. Eyewitnesses noted that there was a whirring sound ssociated with the landing and takeoff of the object.

"The landing was the 'talk of the base' that day, 'apparently," the report c.o n t i n u e s, "and

many people talked freely about it. However, officials at Holloman Air Force Base informed the Pentagon about the incident. Within a short period of time, Air Force intelligence and Central Intelligence Agents from Washington, D.C. arrived. Employes were assembled in a hangar, questioned, and sworn to absolute silence regarding the incident.

"The veil of secrecy forced upon all witnesses was not, according to the informants, a directive from United States Air Force officials. Rather, the United States Air Force was the instrument used by the Central Intelligence Agency to enforce a policy of absolute silence."

The emphatic conclusion that the Air Force and CIA agents wired to the Pentagon, the report states, was: The UFO was definitely not any type of aircraft under development by the United States or any foreign terrestrial power. The UFO's origin was unknown.


The third report from the San Francisco subcommittee was given to us by telephone by Chairman Cerny. "There were 12 engineers and technicians at a radar installation on top of a low mountain called Twin Buttes," Cerny says. "It was in the summer of 1962. A UFO approached their installation and began circling around it. The engineer who first told me of the incident said that the UFO circled just like a Piper Cub airplane would. This was in broad daylight, and apparently the object was observing the radar station.

"It was a double-sided disc, like two bowls put together, and it was a silver-coin color. There were no windows or anything else visible. It was about 50 feet in diameter, and was only a few hundred feet away—very close. One engineer grabbed his 35 mm movie camera—he had been taking pictures of missile launches—and started shooting. He shot 90 feet of color film. Two days later the Air Force came up there and confiscated the film."

The Air Force has repeatedly stated: "The Air Force has no files or photographs that indicate our planet has been visited by extraterrestrial vehicles." "If we could get hold of that

"If we could get hold of that film we'd really have something," says Cerny. "But it's buried someplace in the government's secret files."

In search of the skunk ape Callers say they've seen it

VALDOSTA - Referring to the Skunk Ape story in last week's editions of The Valdosta Daily Times, the man's voice paused on the recorded phone message. "... I saw it."

The Times received calls from readers who believe they have seen what may be a Skunk Ape in South Georgia. One reader account came from Brooks County, the other from Berrien County.

A Skunk Ape is reportedly a hairy humanoid creature that walks on two legs. It is described as being similar to the legendary Bigfoot, but of slighter build. Skunk Apes grow about seven-feet tall and weigh 200 to 300 pounds, according to witness accounts. The creature is called a Skunk Ape because of the foul odor accompanying most sightings. The smell is described as being similar to rotten eggs. Skunk Apes reportedly love wooded, swampy areas, and the Skunk Ape legend comes primarily from the Florida Everglades.

While the Skunk Ape ranks among legendary creatures such as Bigfoot, the Loch Ness monster, the Mothman, and others, numerous Internet sites report witness accounts. Several sites mentioned recent Skunk Ape sightings along the Withlacoochee River between Quitman and Valdosta in Brooks County. This repeated Internet mention to South Georgia led to The Times story last week.

The article led to these subsequent reader accounts. Both sightings occurred prior to the article's publication, according to these readers. Both readers gave The Valdosta Daily Times their full names. One asked that we not publish his name. We use the first name of the other caller. Did these folks see a Skunk Ape? We'll share their stories and you decide.

• Between 10-10:30 p.m. Wednesday, April 21, Joy was driving along Highway 37 in Berrien County. She had a friend on her cell phone. Outside of Ray City, she had her car's bright lights on and she saw something hairy, walking away from the road, into the woods. "I saw the back of something," Joy says. "It was tall. .. I thought it was a bear but a bear don't walk on its back legs. ... Honestly, it looked like an ape." Joy said her husband's about six feet tall and she gauged what she saw to be about the same height as her husband. She didn't smell anything driving by the creature. She told her friend on the phone that she thought she saw something like a hairy man walking into the woods. Her friend laughed and asked if Joy had been drinking. "I told her I hadn't been drinking and, sir, I don't drink," Joy told The Times.

Joy continued driving that night. She mentioned what she saw to a few people, but didn't give it much more thought until her mother told her about the article in The Valdosta Daily Times.

During daylight, Thursday, April 29, the day after The Times story, Joy and her mother traveled to the same part of the road where she claimed to witness a creature. She said the area has numerous trees and is swampy. Joy believes she saw a Skunk Ape or a creature like it.

- Last Friday, The Times received the phone message from the man in Brooks County who claimed " ... I saw it." Calling him back, he said earlier this spring, before the leaves returned to the trees, he was smoking a cigar on the back porch of his Brooks County home, three miles outside of Quitman. It was between 10-11 a.m., when he "saw something walk out of the woods."

He first thought it a deer but saw that it had no hind quarters. He then thought it "an idiot in a ghillie suit," a type of camouflage clothing covered in loose strips of cloth or twine designed to look like foliage. But even then he thought something wasn't right.

He went inside his house and got a pair of binoculars. He saw a hairy humanoid, with the hair being red, fading to brown and grey. The creature was lean and at least over six-feet tall.

The creature was probably about 500 yards away, too far away to smell, he said.

He watched the creature for about eight minutes through the binoculars. During that time, the creature leaned on one arm against a tree, looking around. It scratched its left calf with its right foot. Then it ran away. "It didn't walk like a human," he said. "It's joints don't quite move like a human."

He said if you throw a sheet over a man or a woman, you can tell the gender by the way the person walks despite the sheet. This creature had a strange walk that did not match the movements of a human, he said.

The man thinks the creature is an omnivore, an eater of meats and plants, rather than a vegetarian. A vegetarian has a bigger belly, like a cow, he said. He believes this creature stays lean from eating meat. What kind of meat? The man says he's taking no chances.

"If I go out in the woods now," he says, "I make sure to carry something with me that goes bang."

He believes he probably isn't the only person to see the creature. "If I'm calling, there's probably nine other people who've seen it who haven't said a word to anyone," he says, "because they don't want people thinking they're crazy."

Above the Law: Crop circles remain unexplained

Crop circles have defied explanation for nearly 350 years. A couple of weeks ago, I wrote an article about paranormal investigators and how their research is something that should be appreciated, even though they do not always get the credit they deserve. Here is an example of exactly what I am talking about.

Crop circles have been around for approximately 340 years. Probably the most well-known case was the "Mowing Devil" (1678) in Hertfordshire, England, in which a farmer's field was said to have been visited by an entity that trampled his crops down in a circle.

This occurred well before any claims surfaced of humans actually making the circles themselves for a publicity stunt. So, if it was probably not people that did it, what made the circle?

This is exactly what researchers like those at

www.bltresearch.com set out to answer. These researchers have dedicated their time and talents to learning everything they can about the scientific abnormalities that exist within "real" crop circles.

When you begin to analyze the data they have collected, you can clearly see there is something very strange going on.

Some kind of an outside force is interacting with these plants, which causes them to have strange properties afterward. Node expulsion cavities, from what is believed to be short bursts of microwave radiation, have been detected. Elongation of these nodes within the plants has also been seen in a large number of these circles. The complete absence of seeds after re-growth is noticed in some plants, and in others, there is a "statistically significant massive increase in growth rate and vigor, with growth-rate up to five times the rate of the control seeds. Further, these seedlings can tolerate extreme stress (lack of water and/or light) for considerable periods of time without apparent harm," according to

www.bltresearch.com.

In addition to these strange findings, tiny magnetic iron particles of meteoritic origin have been found strewn about the outer edges of "real" crop circles. The researchers believe this is due to some form of centrifugal force pulling this material out of the upper atmosphere and distributing it over the circle. Also, there are changes in the crystalline structure of the soil within "real" crop circles, which would require the soil to be heated to 600-800 degrees Celsius for several hours in order to achieve.

Interestingly, a very rare phenomenon called a "snow circle" was recently found. The snow was flattened in circular shapes, no human footprints were anywhere in the snow, and the crops underneath were flattened after the snow melted too. Curious.

In crop circles created by humans, these abnormalities do not exist. This leads back to the original question: What made the circles then?

The answer is that we simply do not know. We do, however, have the scientific tools and researchers available to record this data and report it back, so that we may better understand this phenomenon. That is my point.
