

WikiLeaks: new diplomatic
cables contain UFO details, says
Julian Assange

New leaked diplomatic cables set to be published by Wikileaks will contain fresh details on UFOs, according to the website's founder Julian Assange.

The 39 year-old Australian, who is wanted by Interpol over a charge of rape and sexual assault in Sweden, said there were some references to extraterrestrial life in yet-to-be-published confidential files obtained from the American government.

He did not disclose what information was contained in the diplomatic memos obtained by the whistleblowing website. It also remains unclear when they will be published.

Mr Assange said his website, under considerable strain in recent days over its "Cablegate" series of leaks, received emails from "weirdos" claiming to have seen UFOs.

"Many weirdos email us about UFOs or how they discovered that they were the anti-christ whilst talking with their ex-wife at a garden party over a pot-plant," he wrote when asked if any of the documents he had received referred to extraterrestrial life.

"However, as yet they have not satisfied two of our publishing rules.

- 1) that the documents not be self-authored;
- 2) that they be original."

"It is worth noting that in yet-to-be-published parts of the cablegate archive there are indeed references to UFOs."

Some websites later speculated that the cables could offer answers to claims from US military pilots that aliens have landed, infiltrated British nuclear missile sites and deactivated the weapons.

Mr Assange's comments were made during a webchat with The Guardian, during which he confirmed his team were taking security precautions due to "threats against our lives".

Mr Assange is under intense scrutiny worldwide after his website began releasing a selection of more than 250,000 classified US diplomatic cables passed to the whistle-blowing website.

Sarah Palin, the former Republican vice-presidential candidate, has called for him to be hunted down like the al-Qaeda leadership while other members of her party have directly called for a capital sentence against WikiLeaks personnel.

"The threats against our lives are a matter of public record. However, we are taking the appropriate precautions to the degree that we are able when dealing with a super power," Assange wrote in response to a reader's question.

A Canadian pundit called earlier this week for him to be assassinated for leaking US diplomatic cables, while former Republican presidential hopeful Mike Huckabee said those responsible for the leaks should face execution.

The Swedish authorities are also seeking Mr Assange over a charge of rape and sexual assault. Interpol has issued an international warrant for his arrest.

British police requested more information about the penalties Mr Assange could face if convicted, according to a statement on the Swedish Prosecution Authority's website.

It is understood that this has now been provided, although the Metropolitan Police refused to discuss whether officers from its extradition unit were preparing to arrest Mr Assange.

Mr Assange's UK lawyer said that neither the British nor the Swedish authorities had sought to speak to his client.

New York witness within 600 feet of hovering UFO

A New York witness drove within 600 feet of a bright light UFO that was hovering 200 to 300 feet in altitude at 7:35 p.m. on November 18, 2010, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

As the witness came close to the object, a helicopter was noticed moving into the location. "As I come around the bend it's on my left hand side," the witness stated. "I'm going roughly 35-40 mph. I caught right up to it. As I got really close I could see a smaller flashing light kind of behind the UFO. Realized it was a helicopter coming towards it!" The witness then got out of the car.

"If I were to hold my hand out at arm's length it was just a little bigger than my hand. While im doing this I'm listening. No noise except for the approaching chopper." The object then began to move.

"It had a white light shining out of the back. Appeared to be the back because the direction it was moving. It then stopped again, the light switched ends and it started moving slowly to the left. With in the next 5 seconds the end with the light lit a bit brighter and then shot off - so far the only thing I could see was a faint glimmer of the light in the distance."

No town name was mentioned in the public portion of the MUFON report, which was filed on November 23, 2010. No video or images were included with the report.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. Please keep in mind that most UFO reports can be explained as something natural or manmade.

NY, November 18, 2010 - While Driving see brightling on horizon, happen to drive to it. Then i watch it hover and then take off. MUFON Case # 26715.

I was driving back from a friends house. Its dark at this time around 735pm. As im driving I see a bright light on the horizon. I watch it for a good ten minutes and it never got dim or changed course(as far as I could tell). I happen to be driving in its direction on Albany County Rte 208. I even tried to catch its attention per say by flashing the high beams at it from time to time as I got closer. As I neared I started to go through all the possibilities as to what it could be.(been involed in two other UFO encounters soo this isnt new to me).

At this point im roughly a half mile away from it. As far as I could tell it was around 200-300 feet in altitude. The road

starts to bend around to the right. As I come around the bend its on my left hand side. Im going roughly 35-40mph. I caught right up to it. As I got really close I could see a smaller flashing light kind of behind the ufo. Realized it was a helicopter coming towards it!!

I stopped the car parralel with the ufo. Now its maybe 600 feet from me. If I were to hold my hand out at arms length it was just a little bigger than my hand. While im doing this im listening. No noise except for the approaching chopper.

I get back in the car and make a phone call the place I work.(I dont own a cell, havent since 05. Well im supplied a company phone. Basic model no camera and a restricted call list.) I called one of the people I work with. I needed to have some sort of other human contact at that point because I was starting to kind of "panic". He found it funny untill he heard the fear in my voice. Those were his exact words.

Well back to it, as I got on the phone it started to move to the right. It had a white light shining out of the back. Appeared to be the back because the direction it was moving. It then stopped again, the light switched ends and it started moving slowly to the left. With in the next 5 seconds the end with the light lit a bit brighter and then shot off soo far the only thing I could see was a faint glimmer of the light in the distance.

Thats my encounter, havnt been able to sleep or think the same since. Also interesting is that where this happened is only minutes away from the Thatchers park mountains. Ive seen the same light up on that mountain randomly. Now when I go up there to investigate theres no evidence. I can go right to the area where the lights would be and theres nothing but woods. Maybe the same ufo, I dont know? I do know that im having a hard time driving now because all I do is look towards the sky. Dangerous ..lol ..

Green triangle UFO takes 'impact' from ball of light

By Roger Marsh Two Florida witnesses watched a "green triangle" UFO take an impact five times from a "white ball of light" after they pulled over along SR 528 on November 13, 2010, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

They first noticed the white ball of light, but as they traveled over a bridge, they also noticed a green triangle in the sky. They pulled their car off the road to stop and get a better look.

"White ball of light would travel from an obscured point (behind the bridge) near the water line in an indirect path, at variable speeds to rise and strike the green triangle," the reporting witness stated.

They observed the triangle to move when struck by the light. "When struck, the triangle visibly moved from the apparent impact. On one impact, a flash of light occurred." The witness reports that there were a total of five impacts. They called 911 and reported the incident. They also observed a "law enforcement vehicle" pull up and stop.

The witnesses watched for 20 minutes, and then drove away, with the green triangle still in the sky.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. FL, November 13, 2010 - Green Triangle Taking Impact. MUFON Case # 26565.

- driving west to east on SR 528/Bennett Causeway
- noticed white ball of light on south side of causeway, thought it was a reflection
- traveled over the bridge and then noticed green triangle in the sky
- pulled over at mile marker 52
- 2 sober witnesses
- white ball of light would travel from an obscured point (behind the bridge) near the water line in an indirect path, at variable speeds to rise and strike the green triangle
- triangle had 3 illuminated side illuminated in green - 2 sides were flashing and the third did not (nor was the third illuminated across the length of the side).
- when struck, the triangle visibly moved from the apparent impact
- on one impact, a flash of light occurred (one witness to this - the other was dialing cell phone and was not looking in that direction for this impact)
- witnessed 5 impacts
- 911 was called (8:12pm time on my iphone)
- what appeared to be a law enforcement vehicle parked away from us in the median and seemed to be looking in the same direction
- after approx. 20 minutes of viewing drove away - green triangle still in the sky

UFO Over New Jersey: Boomerang UFO Sighting Reported By Witnesses. The reports of UFO were aplenty in the month of October and they came rushing in from all quarters of the United States of America. 'UFO Waves' that began on November 29th, in 1954 and 1989

Two notable UFO waves began on November 29th, 35 years apart. One of the waves is considered to be one of the most well-documented and intriguing flaps in history. The other is notable for the man who claimed to have witnessed the UFO activity, while conducting bizarre weather experiments meant to bring rain to a community in the midst of a drought.

The Belgium UFO Wave of 1989 to 1990

As written about in Leslie Kean's book, *UFOs: Generals, Pilots and Government Officials Go on the Record*, Kean wrote: "the UFO wave in Belgium was handled rationally, openly and responsibly by the government."

The wave included a series of sightings of triangular UFOs in Belgium, which lasted from November 29, 1989 to April of the following year.

There is no one better to tell the story of the Belgium UFO wave, than the late, great Robert Stack. I remember watching this episode of *Unsolved Mysteries* nearly 20 years ago. The YouTube clips that follow (a two-part post), do include some commercials of the day.

Wilhelm Reich sees UFOs in Tucson

In 1954, the world was fascinated with UFOs, and so was William Reich. In fact, much of what was wrong with the world, according to Wilhelm Reich, was due to repressed sexuality and UFO invaders.

Reich was an Austrian psychiatrist and psychoanalyst who trained under Sigmund Freud in Vienna. He was known for forging ahead with work for which the world wasn't quite ready. He was labeled as a "quack" by the FDA and deemed mentally ill.

Reich relocated his family to Tucson in 1954 to conduct weather experiments. On his way to Tucson, he drove through Roswell, NM, feeding his fascination with UFOs. Though Reich called the otherworldly life forms EAs ("E" for Energy and "A" for Alpha). EAs impacted the weather, according to Reich. With the aid of a "cloudbuster", Reich was determined to bring rain to Tucson.

On November 29th, Reich observed a cigar-shaped craft through a telescope aimed at the eastern sky. He clearly observed windows in the object and continued to observe it through December 17th. While at first theorizing that UFOs were "benign observers", his views shifted to believe that they were impacting the weather, (intentionally or unintentionally) contributing to pollution.

During Wilhelm Reich's stay in Tucson, he deduced that a mountain range prevented rain from reaching Tucson. So for the next several months, Reich would travel further west with his cloudbuster until it rained in March 1955. Reich packed up and returned to Maine. In August of that very year, Tucson experienced the wettest month on record. No one can really say that Reich was responsible for clearing the way for the record rainfall. It rained in August 1955 like it hasn't rained since, as documented on the National Weather Service website.

Where have all the UFOs gone?

You just don't hear much about UFO sightings nowadays, at least not like during the heyday of the flying saucer scare in the 1950s and the height of television's "The X-Files" in the 1990s.

After watching all nine seasons of "The X-Files" on DVD recently – nearly 200 hours worth – I went looking through the Observer-Dispatch's old archives to see if I could find any quirky headlines touting invaders from Mars.

Well, guess what? On July 22, 1952, the O-D's sister paper, The Daily Press, hyped a wire story on the front page about weird lights in the sky over Washington, D.C.

Here's how the blurb read:

"Capital Mystery: Radar Detects 'Slow Saucers'

"The Air Force disclosed last night it has received reports of an eerie visitation of unidentified aerial objects – perhaps a new type of 'flying saucer' – over the vicinity of the nation's capital.

"For the first time, so far as known, the objects were picked up by radar – indicating actual substance rather than mere light," around midnight July 19 and July 20 in 1952.

"In addition, they were described as traveling at a slow 100 to 130 miles per hour – instead of with incredible swiftness attributed to earlier saucers – although at times they shot up and down.

"The 'objects' also were described as hovering in one position.

"The Air Force said no planes were sent out in an attempt to intercept the objects."

The O-D at the time also published an article that went on to state the Air Force can't "prove or disprove" the existence of "flying saucers," while concluding that such reported sightings sharply rise in number when there's a "splurge" in national publicity on mysterious lights in the sky.

Now, I've seen a lot of "breaking news" in my time at the O-D, but I really, really wish I could write such a story about UFOs or little green men.

Show me a UFO, give me a UFO!



UFO sightings here create a stir

Numerous websites focusing on UFOs, extraterrestrials and unusual phenomena picked up the report of the sightings

UFO websites were buzzing this week over a report of two sightings of unusual objects over East Hempfield Township.

A woman said she saw a Hershey Kiss-shaped object, accompanied by two Chinook military helicopters, around noon Monday, and then another similar lighted object later that evening over Spring Valley Road.

She reported the sightings to the Mutual UFO Network, or MUFON, which is based in Colorado.

It's likely no surprise to scoffers or conspiracy theorists that neither Lancaster County emergency dispatchers nor air traffic controllers at the Lancaster Airport tower said they received any reports of helicopters or unusual sightings Monday.

According to her report, the Lancaster woman said of the second sighting, "I remember yelling, 'What the frig is that?' or a similar expletive and just being held in awe by the size and apparent low-flying flight path of the object."

Numerous websites focusing on UFOs, extraterrestrials and unusual phenomena picked up the report of the sightings, including Lights in the Texas Sky, the Unexplainable, Whales in Space, UFO World News and Area 51 Disclosure.

Such sites are a door into an unusual universe populated by aliens, the Jersey Devil and Bigfoot. They buzz with reports that entertainer Jackie Gleason claimed that President Nixon showed him alien bodies, and they feature lots of

conjecture on the military's involvement with and cover-up of UFOs.

Indeed, callers to MUFON's toll-free number are instructed: "To report a UFO sighting ... please press 1. To report an abduction experience, please press 2."

Bill Weber, the MUFON investigator assigned to the case, said he knows that people mock the idea of UFOs. He also thinks many of those people are scared by the prospect.

"The first reaction when somebody sees something is they're inquisitive, they're curious," he said, adding, "they're also afraid."

MUFON is not primed to see little green men behind every bush, said the 63-year-old Downingtown man, a sales manager for a computer-based test equipment company.

Many things that people think are UFOs turn out to be something else: meteors, regular aircraft, planets or easily explainable phenomenon, Weber said. But there are other things, too, that cannot be explained, he said.

"I think people should keep an open mind," he said. "When the evening sky is clear and you see all those stars, our sun is one of them. How can you say this star, in the vastness of everything you're seeing, is the only star that has intelligent life circling around that? I can't do that."

Weber said he plans to contact the woman to interview her and her 13-year-old daughter, who saw the first object over Spring Valley, a road that runs north of and parallel to Route 30 from Centerville Road to Rohrerstown Road.

He also might knock on the doors of neighbors who, the woman said, saw — and possibly videotaped — the first object.

Weber said he could end up asking federal authorities, via a Freedom of Information request, if they were tracking anything on radar in the area at that time.

John Moeller, air traffic manager for Lancaster Airport, said it's not unusual to see military helicopters flying over Lancaster County. Some come from Fort Indiantown Gap and others from a Maryland airport that has a military unit.

Both he and Rick Harrison, the county's emergency management operations manager, said they occasionally get calls about unusual things in the sky. Sometimes they are low-flying aircraft such as crop dusters, or helicopters checking power lines.

Weber said MUFON gets about a dozen reports of UFOs or other phenomena every month in Pennsylvania.

"I have to believe there's something out there," he said. "It just makes sense."

UFO hovers above while Maine witnesses report movement on the ground

Two Maine witnesses report a triangle UFO 100 yards away and "40 feet off the tops of the pines" while something appeared to be moving around at ground level below with a light at 6:30 p.m. on November 24, 2010, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

The two friends had gone to a nearby ridge area to test a second-hand four-wheel-drive vehicle one of them had purchased, according to the reporting witness. They stopped the vehicle and cut off the headlights, noticed the hovering triangle object, and then saw the light at ground level.

"It was to the right of the truck about 100 yards, and it was kinda shiny and just the corners were lit up on it," the reporting witness stated. "It was in the shape of a triangle, maybe 40 foot off the tops of the pines. But as I was just about to ask my friend what he thought it was, the tops of the pines lit up about 100 feet from us, so my friend shut the truck off including the parking lights in seconds flat, cause something was on the ground with a light and it was looking for something."

The two now watched the object on the ground.

"It scanned the ground for 5 mins, then the lights went away, but just as fast as it went away, it came back and started to search around again. But this time the lights were brighter and closer."

The two watched the scene for another 10 minutes - and did not notice any sound being produced except a "low frequency hum."

As the ground lights seemed to be getting brighter, the two became frightened, started the truck, and moved away. As they left the area, they said the light on the ground appeared to continue "searching for something like it didn't care that we were there."

No town name was mentioned in the public portion of the MUFON report, which was filed on November 25, 2010. No video or images were provided with the report.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON. Please keep in mind that most UFO reports can be explained as something natural or manmade. ME, November 24, 2010 -the object had a being on the ground searching for something. MUFON Case # 26734.

My buddy had just traded his plow truck for a green 95 ford f150 4x4. later that night we decided that we would test the 4 wheel drive in it on his property, besides, noone else was home so we were pretty bored. we ended up going to the ridge cause its close, (we didnt want to go far because we didnt have much fuel and didnt know if it would break down).

Now up here in the winter its dark by 430pm, and it was roughly 630 when we got up there. my bud left the truck running cause it was cold and he shut off the lights so only the parking lights were on, but we were talkin and i had just finished my smoke, while my buddy was just lighting one, and as i threw the ciggerette out of the truck somthing caught my eye.

it was to the right of the truck about 100 yards, and it was kinda shiny and just the corners were lit up on it. it was in the shape of a triangle, maybe 40 foot off the tops of the pines. but as i was just about to ask my friend what he thought it was the tops of the pines lit up about 100 feet from us, so my friend shut the truck off including the parking lights in seconds flat cause something was on the ground with a light and it was looking for something.

it scanned the ground for 5 mins then the lights went away, but just as fast as it went away it came back and started to search around again. but this time the lights were brighter and closer.

we sat and watched quietly, for another 10 mins and to be honest i was scared shitless and im a good sized guy.

i know that it wasnt a chopper cause they fly over head all the time, this was dead silent. the only thing that we heard was a low frequency hum.....thats it. well it seemed like the lights kept gettin brighter like they were gettin closer so i told my buddy we needed to get the hell out of there. but even after he started the truck and turn around it was still there, searching for something like it didnt care that we were there.

it could have been up there for hours after we left. all i know is there is only one way in and there is NO possible way to get a truck in were we saw these lights. i thought at first maybe some one had a wheeler up there but its posted property.....and no sounds, not even the sound of someone walking which there was something walking around cause we could see its light. this was a very intense situation. i know people get all freeked out when they see things in the sky, but how would they react if that something was out of the ship walkin around by them????

Missouri couple reports chevron-shaped UFO over I-70

A Missouri couple watched a large, chevron-shaped object under 5,000 feet slowly moving across the sky as they drove west along I-70 about 50 miles east of Columbia on November 21, 2010, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

The object at first appeared to be a very large and very bright light about the size of an aspirin held at arm's length. When the object changed course, they noticed the chevron shape. "We kept watching it for about 15 minutes, when it changed course or position slightly north, to where I could see a silver color chevron shaped structure with rounded edges," the reporting witness stated.

They estimated the craft at under 5,000 feet. "I realized at that point that it must have been fairly close to us - somewhere between 3,000 and 5,000 ft. I looked for wings or tail and saw nothing. As it moved, the white light only appeared on the left side, which would have been the back part of the craft, and partially obscuring the craft." The object moved into cloud cover and disappeared from view. No video or images were submitted with the MUFON report, which was filed on November 23, 2010.

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON.. MO, November 21, 2010 - Large Chevron craft south of I-70. MUFON Case # 26713.

My husband and I were traveling West on I-70 from St. Louis to Kansas City and were about 50 miles East of Columbia when he opened the sunroof of the vehicle and noticed a bright planet. He asked me what planet that was and after I looked at it a few times (I was driving) I saw that it was moving and too large and bright to be a planet.

It was a very large very bright light and the size of an aspirin or a bit larger held at arm's length. We kept watching it for about 15 minutes, when it changed course or position slightly north, to where I could see a silver color chevron shaped structure with rounded edges.

I realized at that point that it must have been fairly close to us - somewhere between 3,000 and 5,000 ft. I looked for wings or tail and saw nothing. As it moved, the white light only appeared on the left side, which would have been the back part of the craft, and partially obscuring the craft.

About 15 seconds later it moved behind clouds and was partially visible for a minute, then no longer visible as the clouds got heavier. The object did not move like conventional aircraft and must have been moving slowly in order for us to see it for that length of time. See the

UFO Sighting in Virginia: Centreville Residents Spot Blue UFO

UFO Sighting in Virginia: Centreville Residents Spot Blue UFO. An unidentified object spotted in the night sky by the residents of Centreville, Virginia has caused an alarm throughout the town.

A bright blue light was spotted in the sky by a number of people. The object did not make any noise and hung about the sky for about 10 minutes before it took off. It moved a bit, but appeared to not have a planned route. It has not been seen since and has left the residents perplexed.

A resident of Centreville, Mr. Bryan Fains, was able to capture footage of the unidentified flying object with his mobile phone.

Fains said, "The light was so bright, at night time," he said. "It would stop (in the sky) and then go back. At one point it stopped and then went up. I thought it was a UFO."

Mr. Fains, who lives near the Dullus airport said, "I've never seen a blue light flying around before." He was amazed at how silent the light was. "You only see this type of stuff in the movies. Just as long as we are here, I'm sure there are other people, or things, here," he added. Using an HTC EVO 4G, Mr. Fains recorded a footage that lasts more than two and half minutes.

Leading to a wide debate on the credibility of the "UFO" footage, the sightings are being perceived differently by the world. It may have been a Police helicopter hovering around a crime scene, an aircraft or something else, we will have to wait to get further insights on that.

12 UFOs in formation witnessed by North Carolina couple

Two North Carolina witnesses attempted and failed to get photos of "at least 12" objects in the sky on December 7, 2010, including one disc-shaped UFO and other cigar-shaped UFOs, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

The reporting witness said she pointed the objects out to her fiancée as she was driving, but he at first thought they were "fighter jets." The woman said she asked him to look again, as the objects were hovering in place, one looked disc-shaped, and the others looked cigar-shaped. The fiancée then told the woman to pull over.

They then attempted to take pictures using a camera phone, but they objects "would not show up."

"I pointed to the disc shaped one and told him to try and get it. At that point that thing took off like nothing I have ever seen. It was there and then gone in an instant," the reporting witness stated.

They continued to watch as more objects showed up, 12 total, and all staying in a tight formation.

"We heard no sound coming from them and they were all headed southwest. I finally got a little afraid and told my fiancée we were leaving the area."

Star-like UFO hovers near Texas family's home

A Texas couple and their son watched a silent, star-like object hovering near their home off Highway 95 just after dusk on November 13, 2010, and a second object that seemed to emerge from under the first object and move away, according to testimony from the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON) witness reporting database.

The wife was first to see the object as she pulled into the home driveway. She then drove up their quarter-mile-long driveway to get her son to return with her to the bottom of their driveway. She also called her husband, who arrived with a video camera to take pictures of the object.

As they watched the first object, a second object appeared under the first object and moved away.

"As soon as I looked through the binoculars, a white orb appeared right under the object and it began to travel to the southeast," the woman stated. I asked my son if he could see it and he said 'no.' I removed the binoculars and all I could see was an occasional really bright flash where it was traveling."

The first object seemed to spin, and to move up and down.

"When viewed through the binoculars you could make out a shape, but then it would shift. It appeared star-like with many points and faceted like a diamond. Sometimes it would look saucer-like but on its side with white spikes coming out of it. It seemed to have a protruding light on its side which I called a nose."

The husband and son returned home after the object moved further down the highway away from their home. The wife decided to telephone the neighbor where the object had moved to and to drive there. The neighbor stepped outside.

"Armed with my binoculars and Mary with hers, we both watched in amazement this brilliant colorful morphing object. She said, 'Well that's not a plane, a helicopter, satellite, planet or star, then what is it!?' The object was moving upwards and to the north but very, very slowly. At times it had a purple halo around it like a black light. After watching it for about 20 or 30 minutes with her, she then noticed a second object that was pulsating! This one was gold, smaller but also star-like, shaped (like a Christmas tree topper with many points). It also made the same movements as the other one."

The following is the unedited and as yet uninvestigated report filed with MUFON.

TX, November 13, 2010 - thought it was helicopter hovering above field but no noise/lasted for hours.
MUFON Case # 26573.

Last night Saturday November 13, 2010 at around 6:30 or just as dusk was ending I was driving home north on HWY 95 from Cistern Genreal store. As I approached our driveway I noticed an object across the street (east from our driveway) that looked like a plane with its white, red & blue lights on approaching.

Then I noticed it just seem to hover so I thought it was an helicopter. I crossed our cattle guard ,parked my tahoe, and got out to have a better look.It wast going anywhere except up and down and side to side. The object didnt make a noise.Since it was rapidly getting dark I couldn't define the shape of the object. I watched it for about 10 minutes.The darker it got outside the lights became very brilliant and sharp.

I drove home on my 1/4 mile driveway to get binoculars and my son to go back with me to see the object.He took forever (15 minutes)to get ready packing blankets,hats & gloves since it was a cold night.WE returned to the end of our driveway and parked the car again right in front of the field where the object was hoovering. It seemed as if it had moved a bit upwards and to the north from where I oriiginally spotted it.My sons first thoughts were that it was either a plane or helicopter. I told him impossible beacuse there was no noise and it hadnt really moved for the past 30 minutes or so.

As soon as I looked thru the binoculars a white orb appeared right under the object and it began to travel to the S.E.. I asked my son if he could see it and he said no. I removed the binocs and all I could see was an occasional really bright flash where it was traveling. I continued to look again thru them for about 20 secs until it was gone.

Coinsidently last Saturday 11/6/2010 I made another MUFON report regarding a daytime sighting of a traveling orb that looked exactly like what I saw last night. The case # is 26461 for that sighting!

Back to the hovering object....my son & I watched it spin,move up and down and side to side. When viewed thru the binocs you could make out a shape but then it would shift, It appeared star like with many points and faceted like a diamond.Sometimes it would look saucer like but on it's side with white spikes coming out of it. It seemed to have a protruding light on it's side which I called a nose.

After watching this with my son for about 15 minutes I called my husband to come up front and take pictures with his new toy a cannon powershot 4000.He took about 10 pics with different settings which I will try to upload. They came out really good for his first attempt filming at night a non-stationary object.Well after about 30 minutes of this my husband and son were cold tired and bored with it so the went home.

I decided to drive down the highway about a mile to where the object had slowly moved (probably not a good idea for

a woman on a lonely country highway chasing a ufo to do).It was now across the street from my friend Mary's house. I pulled over the side of the road and called her and told her to go outside and look across the street up in the air, above the trees at the light. WE have had other interesting sightings that have not been reported but told to our MUFON invevstigator Jeremy Ray.,Jeremy has visited our ranch out side Austin and witnessed with us unussual activities in our clar clean night sky.My friend NIKI who I met on the MUFON chat board call where I live UFO Alley.....

Saucers "Jam" Pierre Skies

State Police Report Half Dozen Seen

PIERRE (UP) — The skies around Pierre reportedly were jammed with unidentified objects early this morning.

The State Police radio reported at least a half dozen sightings of the mysteriously lighted and flying objects in the Pierre region.

State Motor Patrolman William Pulver of Murdo reported seeing one which flitted around in the sky between Murdo and Kadoka for some time after midnight before disappearing to the southwest.

He said the object constantly changed directions. He said it had a string of lights as a tail.

Pulver watched the object from the sheriff's office at Murdo. He reportedly sighted another one later while travelling toward Vivian.


Game Warden Charles Burn of Piraha also reported seeing a couple of strange objects in the sky about 15 miles south of Fort Pierre on U. S. 83.

And Sheriff Warren Grandle of Pierre and State Police Radio relief dispatcher Alton Lower also reported seeing a number of strange objects about 24 miles south of Pierre along State Highway 31. Lower said, however, none of them appeared very vividly.

They were in the same area where a motor patrolman and a police radio dispatcher reported sighting one close to the ground Sunday morning.

The State Police Radio said the sky was cloudless at the time of the sightings last night.

What Is It . . . U. F. O. ???



These pictures of what may be a flying saucer were taken early Sunday morning by Jack Peters state police radio dispatcher, on Highway 31 about 30 miles east of Pierre. He and Don Kelm spotted a peculiar, bowl shaped object, looking like an egg shell cut in half, giving off a bright red light, lighting the entire highway. These were taken with a 35mm camera on fast film, 1/120 sec. at 1/3.5, then they were enlarged 180 times with a microscope. Peters said they followed the object for six or seven miles and were as close as a city block to it when they first came upon it as they drove over a hill. It appeared to be about the size of an automobile. In the picture on the right the moon may be seen in the background.

Motor Patrolmen Sight, Chase, Photograph "Flying Saucer;" Saucer "Chases" Back, Fades Away

PIERRE — Don Kelm and Jack Peters, South Dakota state motor patrolmen, got a good look at and a picture of an "unidentified flying object" (Airforce parlance) Sunday—and it scared them.

They drove over a hill on Highway 31 about 30 miles east of Pierre and there was the "flying saucer" alongside the road.

"It was almost in the ditch," said Peters.

The object was bowl-shaped—like an eggshell cut in half—and it gave off a red light which illuminated the highway.

"I don't know what it was but it definitely was there," Peters said.

He estimated it was about the size of a semi trailer. His partner, Kelm, said it was about automobile-sized. That seems to be close enough.

When first sighted, it was about a block away.

Evidently the "spacemen" were more scared than Peters and Kelm because they took off over the road in their "vehicle" with the two patrolmen hot on their trail.

During the six or seven mile chase, the object always kept about a mile or so ahead of the pursuers. At first the patrolmen (by their own admission) were "so scared" they didn't think of taking a picture.

Toward the end of the chase, however, Peters did take several pictures of the object, two of which are reproduced on this page.

During the chase, the "saucer" seemed to stay about 1,000 feet off the ground. It didn't make any noise. There didn't seem to be any exhaust and it never changed color.

Finally, after about seven miles of this, the two patrolmen decided to turn around to see if the "saucer" would follow them.

"It seemed to," they said.

But it didn't follow long and finally disappeared.

This Sunday's appearance was followed last night by other sightings of similar aerial objects at Murdo, Redfield and Martin, on Highway 83 about 15 miles southwest of Ft. Pierre; and on Highway 16, southwest of Ft. Pierre.

Some of these sightings were investigated by the motor patrol.

Phenomenon Believed To Be Illusions

Say "Objects" Sighted Over
Washington May Be Mirages
Reflected By Light

WASHINGTON, (UP) — The Air Force offered today a combination of summer heat waves and optical and radar illusions as a plausible explanation of the latest flurry of "flying saucers."

Intelligence officers ridiculed the notion that the mysterious objects in the sky hail from other planets or Russia—or pose a menace to the United States.

They were confident that new scientific investigations with powerful telescopes and special cameras would explain away the objects as "physical phenomena," such as mirages. And, maybe, cure the nation of sauceritis.

As for three flocks of objects sighted by radar over Washington in the past 10 days, Maj. Gen. John A. Samford, Air Force director of intelligence, told a news conference late Tuesday that "my own mind is satisfied" they resulted from temperature inversion.

This was explained in detail later by two electronics experts from the Air Technical Intelligence Center Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Dayton, Ohio. They were Dr. B. L. Griffing and Capt. Roy James.

Air temperature, they pointed out, decreases with altitude. When a warm air mass passes over a relatively cooler one, temperature temporarily increases and an "inversion layer" of warm air is formed.

This inversion will cause radar beams to bend earthward. Radar impulses then bounce off ground "targets." What then appear as unidentified "blips" or tiny white lights on radarscopes are not objects in the sky but objects on the ground.

With a large inversion, street or automobile lights may be similarly reflected, as if in formation, on clouds. If there is sufficient wind velocity or turbulence, these lights will appear to dance or "dog fight" with the phenomenal gyrations attributed to "flying saucers."

To settle the "flying saucer" mystery once and for all, Samford disclosed that the Air Force investigation is going to take a new, scientific turn.

Now the Air Force is going to concentrate on some precise means of measurement of the eerie objects so that scientists can be handed "manageable material" for analysis, Samford said.

One device to be used is a special camera that will photograph the objects and break into its constituents the light they give off. These basic colors then may be compared with colors cast by known objects—say, a neon sign or an airport approach light—so the source of "flying saucer" light can be determined.

Another device is the Schmidt telescope, with which vast portions of the sky and what goes on there during the night can be recorded.

Propose "Saucer" Watch

SOUTH BEND, Ind. (UP)—The Air Force and a newspaper appealed to thousands of persons in two states today to spend two hours watching for "flying saucers."

The South Bend Tribune enlisted cooperation from the Air Force for a sky search between 9 and 11 p. m. CDT Aug. 2, in seven northern Indiana and two southwestern Michigan counties.

"We hope to obtain the cooperation of thousands of volunteer observers who will go out in backyards and up on roofs Saturday night to watch the sky," said Capt. Forest R. Shafer, commanding officer of the Air Force filter center here.

The Tribune and its radio station, WSBT, set up an elaborate communications system and urged residents to notify the Tribune of "anything unusual" in the sky.

Shafer said Air Force radar teams would be used in the search.



Object shot out of sky above Israeli nuclear plant, military says

Jerusalem (CNN) -- The Israeli Air Force shot down an unidentified flying object over the Dimona nuclear plant in the Negev Desert Thursday, the Israel Defense Forces said.

The object appeared in a designated no-fly zone, the air force was scrambled and the object was shot down, the IDF said.

The object could have been a party balloon, the IDF said, but forces have not yet found the debris to determine what it was.

There have been unconfirmed media reports that it was a motor-driven object. The air force reacted according to procedure when the object was spotted, the IDF said.

The Israeli daily newspaper Haaretz reported that last October "IDF warplanes intercepted an Israeli ultralight aircraft that accidentally flew into the area and forced it to land at an airstrip in southern Israel."

It also reported that "an Israeli surface-to-air missile downed a crippled Israeli fighter-bomber that strayed into the restricted zone" during the Six Day War in 1967. The craft's pilot was killed.

GLADSTONE is being visited by UFOs, according to a Gladstone local.

The local listed sighting a strange, bright red object Monday morning on a UFO sighting website.

The website, The UFO Clearinghouse, accepts reports from people who have seen something they can't explain, hence, an unidentified flying object (UFO).

"While at work in the state forest north of Gladstone, I noticed to my left a bright red light," the local who remained anonymous said.

"We have people from small business owners to professional people like lawyers, teachers and pilots. We get reports from basically everybody," she said.

Anger at closure of Plain road near Warminster

UFO spotters, horse riders and dog walkers plan to stage a protest at Cradle Hill near Warminster after access to the area was restricted by the Ministry of Defence.

Civilian vehicles can no longer access the area from Cradle Hill to Parsonage Field Barn after reports of dog fouling, abuse of troops and attacks on other animals.

The hill, which is a mile north east of the town centre and on the edge of Salisbury Plain, became famous in the 1960s and 70s for UFOs and crop circles.

A Ministry of Defence Estates spokesman said: "We have received a number of complaints about dog walkers failing to control dogs in the area. These include very significant dog fouling, abuse of troops, attacks on sheep, deer and horse riders.

"We have, therefore, decided to protect the safety of other people using this area by stopping civilian vehicle access to the road from Cradle Hill to Parsonage Field barn.

"Pedestrians, cyclists, riders and drivers of horse drawn vehicles still have unrestricted access."

But UFO spotter and author Kevin Goodman said: "We are hoping to hold a peaceful protest in January to let the Army know we're here and we have a right to use the land."

Sylvia Sullivan-Tailyour, who is a member of the British Horse Society, said: "The elderly and disabled won't be able to drive up there now. There is a lot of irresponsible behaviour by a minority."

Ball lightning may explain UFOs

SYDNEY--Some UFO sightings could be explained by ball lightning and other atmospheric phenomena, claims Australian astrophysicist Stephen Hughes.

The scientist has made a detailed study of an unusual event in 2006 when large meteors were observed over Brisbane. Their appearance occurred at the same time as a brilliant green object was seen to roll over nearby mountains.


Dr Hughes has put forward a theory linking the object, presumed to be ball lightning - to the fireballs.

His idea is that one of the fireballs may have momentarily triggered an electrical connection between the upper atmosphere and the ground, providing energy for the ball lightning to appear above the hills.

Dr Hughes says the extraordinary episode, which occurred during a night of fine weather, is just the sort of happening that might lead some to think they had witnessed UFO activity.

"If you put together inexplicable atmospheric phenomena, maybe of an electrical nature, with human psychology and the desire to see something, that could explain a lot of these UFO sightings," he told BBC News.

The scientist, who is a senior lecturer at the Queensland University of Technology, initiated the study after being called in by the local TV station to look over and explain photos of the fireballs captured by members of the public on camera phones. (Source: BBC)

**Doritos Invade Britain: Or
UFO's Shaped Like Them**By Amy Scattergood

If you wanted another sign that we're all eating far, far too much junk food, consider this story from Britain's *Daily Mail*.

There have been many UFO sightings, it seems, in the English Midlands: at least three in the last three years. But what is perhaps more remarkable than the possible UFO's themselves is the shape of the objects: reporters and experts alike have been describing them as shaped like Doritos. Not something more geometrically accurate like, say, a *triangle*, but the American snack item.

The most recent "Dudley Dorito" (not kidding) was sighted a week ago in the skies above Tipton, West Midlands. A previous sighting, above Boldmere in November, was described as being "four or five times the size of a commercial airliner." A Dorito 4-5 times as big as a plane, that is. The rash of sightings in the last few years comes after the Ministry of Defense released their previously classified UFO "X-Files" in 2008, in an effort to be more transparent with UFO sightings and research.

No word on whether Frito-Lay, the American company that owns the Doritos brand, has any particular lobby in the UK, or if UFO-watchers in the middle of England favor Doritos over other locally produced chips. Somebody should probably find out.



"The other light was to my left and it was changing direction in the sky at high speed then I lost sight of it over buildings."

The sighting have heralded a new wave of interest in UFO spotting in the south of the county on the final frontier with Co. Monaghan.

It seems to be a case of 2010: A Space Odyssey as in the last eighteen months many such sightings of E.T. craft have been recorded across the skies of Tyrone.

Russ to Speak on UFO Sightings

SCARBOROUGH will be making international headlines after it was revealed that the area has become the latest hotspot for UFO sightings.

Russ Kellett, a Filey-based UFO investigator, will be interviewed by a major American broadcaster and a Japanese TV station in the wake of the revelations.

Tomorrow he will be interviewed for ABC News after the station spotted a recent story in the Evening News.

He said: "They seemed to be really interested. They said they had seen me on the internet and were really interested in my story. They contacted me because of your article."

The article was published last month and offered a possible explanation for an unusual sight in the sky above Osgodby. A video had appeared on a national newspaper's website which showed a strange formation moving about.

Mr Kellett said at the time that he had witnessed similar sightings in the past and the phenomenon was caused by flocks of birds.

He said: "North Yorkshire is a hotspot. We've had just as many sightings here as other areas which have been hotspots. These areas change from time to time. You will get a lot of things going on and then it will cool off."

As well as recent sightings Mr Kellett will be talking about historic sightings from this area including the Silpho Saucer in the 1950s and when a jet fighter crashed off Flamborough Head in 1970.

The small saucer was said to have landed near Silpho in November 1957 and was said to have been witnessed by three men. The object was reported to have weighed 35lb, was 18in in diameter and covered in strange symbols. It was claimed the saucer also contained a copper book, with 17 thin sheets, which were covered in more than 2,000 words.

It was later proved to have been a hoax and it was believed to have been built in a workshop in a back street off North Marine Road.

The Lightning jet fighter was piloted by Captain William Schaffner of the United States Air Force – a vastly experienced pilot

with combat experience behind him in Vietnam.

He reported seeing a strange object flying alongside him before he ditched in the North Sea. When the wreckage was recovered, a month later, the cockpit was empty and no trace of the pilot's body could be found.

Mr Kellett has organised two UFO conferences in the Scarborough area and agreed that reported sightings in this area had increased over recent months but added that verifying their authenticity was more difficult in the age of email.

He said: "When it was handwritten you had something solid and you could still check a person's identity."

Mr Kellett said that it was more difficult to check an anonymous email. He added: "I don't take their reports seriously if you can't get back to that person on a landline I don't want to know." that'.

He first became interested in the subject after he experienced a "close encounter" in West Yorkshire, in 1988, when he was at a level crossing.

He said: "I was hit by a beam of light. I was on my motorbike and it was coming from above. I thought it was my friend messing about. I looked round and there was nothing. "Then I realised that the light was coming down from the sky."

At the time he thought nothing more of the event until the next day at work when people asked if he had seen himself in the mirror – his face and hands were completely sunburned.

Egyptian archaeologist admits pyramids contain UFO technology





DID CYBER HACKERS WANT GARY?

SCOTTISH computer hacker Gary McKinnon's mother yesterday hit back at claims he was part of a major cyber gang before the US authorities caught him accessing secrets.

Author Peter Warren, 50, has just published extraordinary allegations on his technology website, Future Intelligence, about Mr McKinnon, 44, whose fight against extradition to the United States on charges of hacking military computers reaches a crucial stage this week.

Mr Warren, who has co-written a book about the world of hacking called Cyber Alert, says his investigations show the Asperger's Syndrome sufferer was "not a lone hacker roving through US computer systems but was instead the most junior member of an informal five-strong group that regularly exchanged information on US systems."

He also claims Mr McKinnon first came to the attention of the authorities during a monitoring exercise carried out by police into the activities of a "hacking gang whose members were spread Europe-wide and included hackers based in Spain, Bristol and Scotland."

His story quotes a source as saying: "McKinnon was a long way from being the leader. There was someone much bigger than McKinnon in the group.

"One of the reasons that we were blinded-sided by McKinnon in the original investigation was because this particular Mr Big had been responsible for damaging a lot of things in the UK."

However, Gary's mother, Janis Sharp, was angered by the allegations, coming just days before Home Secretary Theresa May will give evidence on the controversial case to the Home Affairs Select Committee.

Mr McKinnon faces up to 60 years in an American jail for hacking into Nasa and Pentagon computers in 2001 and 2002 whilst looking for evidence of UFOs.

But Mrs May is considering refusing extradition and has been given very strong medical evidence about his condition and a history of mental illness in other members of his family. In response to Mr Warren's claims, Ms Sharp told the Sunday Express: "Gary may well have entered into dialogue with other hackers prior to his alleged hacking but Gary was not involved in their exploits and nor were they involved in his UFO search – it would be wrong of them to suggest otherwise.

"What Gary said showed his obvious naivety. However talking on a forum is one thing but Gary was never part of any hacking group and what he did, he did on his own because of his fascination with UFOs. The US and UK authorities have confirmed and accept this."

She added: "In Gary's cyber messages he told the US their security was c*** and that someone had to listen.

"He said he would continue to disrupt by leaving cyber notes until someone at the top listened and sorted it out.

"Gary also expressed empathy with the American people. Gary told the authorities that when he did a simple net scan there were people from all over the world wandering around through US security systems and the US need to up their security.

"Unfortunately no one listened to Gary, so it's not surprising got WikiLeaks, as their security was as poor as ever we've later years that ten ten years on."

Two weeks ago files released by WikiLeaks revealed former Prime Minister Gordon Brown told the Americans there was a risk the hacker could commit suicide if jailed in the US. Mr Brown suggested Mr McKinnon could plead guilty in return for not being extradited.

A secret cable from Louis Susman, the US ambassador in Britain, to Secretary of State Hillary Clinton in 2009 said Mr Brown had proposed the deal and added: "Brown cited deep public concern that McKinnon, with his medical condition, would commit suicide or suffer injury if imprisoned in a US facility."

Alien sightings grow in Tweed

Images of an alleged alien in Bilambil Heights have UFO experts scratching their heads.

The footage was captured by Alex Player, detailed by the Tweed Daily News yesterday, and is to be used in a UFO documentary to be released in 2011.

UFO Research New South Wales Incorporated media spokesman Doug Moffett has been researching UFO activity for the past 18 years, and said the footage taken by 16-year-old Alex is inconclusive.

"I'm not saying it is not (an alien), but I cannot say what it could be. Even to say it has a humanoid form could be a stretch," Mr Moffett said.

"From the height they say it was you have to think that logically what would a small child be doing outside at that time of night with a flashlight."

Mr Moffett said when it comes to this type of unexplained footage it is important to consider the back-story.

"You have to look at the background of the story as well. From what has been said, it does not appear to be a hoax. You have to look at someone's reason for doing this."

UFO Research NSW aims to promote a greater understanding of the UFO phenomenon and to investigate and research UFOs with a developed, logical and structured approach.


Unidentified sightings have surrounded the Tweed region in recent years, with residents sighting strange lights and objects in the sky.

Hills alive with UFOs

A PROSPECTOR who went to find gold in the hills thinks he may have found something better - evidence that aliens really do exist.

Adam Cainero believes he captured a photograph of an alien spacecraft hovering above an escarpment near Majors Creek, in the Southern Tablelands near Braidwood.

After an unsuccessful weekend fossicking for gold Mr Cainero and a friend were making the long trip home when he stopped to take a snap of the steep mountain they had driven down.

When he got home, Mr Cainero said he realised he had found gold of another kind after all.

"I just took a picture of the mountain range and the sun was in my eyes so I just kind of pointed and shot," Mr Cainero said. "Then we looked at the picture - we were, like, no way."

With its shape and its position in the sky, Mr Cainero said he immediately knew the black object was a UFO.

"We always see really weird things as we go out to places where there is no one around," he said. There had been talk among fossickers about UFOs being in the area, he said. "A lot of people I know who go into the bush reckon they have seen one," Mr Cainero said.

Earlier this year *The Daily Telegraph* revealed the suburbs around Gosford, on the Central Coast, were the state's biggest hot spot when it came to UFO sightings, with dozens of cases reported every year. Each month people turn up to meetings to share their UFO experiences.

The region was the scene of one of Australia's most baffling UFO cases - a series of sightings in 1995 and 1996 - reported by police and many other credible witnesses.

Residents saw shiny UFOs hovering above water.

UFOs or lanterns? The mystery deepens

Unidentified flying objects moving through the Moray skies are continuing to baffle local residents, with sightings of airborne orange lights leaving witnesses wondering what on earth they have seen.

Numerous sightings of a strange orange glow over Elgin have been reported since just before Hallowe'en, with witnesses detailing a light in the distance that moves across the sky from left to right or right to left.

One man, who did not wish to be named, contacted 'The Northern Scot' after capturing his October 30 sighting on video on his mobile phone.

The Pinefield resident said he watched the light from his back window for five to 10 minutes, in a direction across the A96 road and above trees in the distance. He said it moved slowly from right to left, appeared to hover, and then moved quickly before disappearing.

The man said the same orange light – approximately the colour of a street light – then re-appeared on the right hand side of the sky, before following an identical path and disappearing. The Pinefield man's account has since been supported by others.

Another Elgin resident said he captured a strange light on the camera on his mobile phone. Others have since said they have seen the orange light in a similar location as described by the Pinefield man.

An unnamed Elgin woman said she saw a glow in the sky at around 7.30pm on November 6.

"I was walking home after the firework display at Cooper Park and saw an orange-pink light in the sky travelling southwards over the town," she said.

"It was moving at speed in a straight line and there was no noise so it obviously wasn't a firework or aircraft.

"I suppose it could have been a satellite, but who knows?"

The most recent sighting has been by Sally McDonald, of Croft Road, New Elgin.

She said that at 5.45pm last Friday (November 19), she was driving on Oakfield Road towards Linkwood Road in Elgin when she looked upwards to see an orange light.

"At first I thought it was a firework shooting up, but on closer scrutiny I noticed it appeared to be navigating very well for a firework," she added.

"It went from left to right... it appeared to be low and there was absolutely no noise. I actually stopped my car and turned the engine off to listen."

The latest UFO sightings follow similar accounts across Moray.

On September 3, Forres couple Don and Pat MacArthur said they spotted a strange airborne light through their window.

They filmed a bright pink, diamond-like object in the sky. This shape disappeared, but they then saw a black object which appeared from roughly the same direction but was much higher up.

Further unexplained lights have also been spotted above Moray this year, according to the UK UFO Sightings website, with sightings in locations including Burghead and Kinloss.

Stan Barber, the chairman of Moray astronomy club Sigma, said that if a person is stationary and the object he or she sees in the sky is apparently moving, then it is "hard to explain it away as a celestial object".

Mr Barber said he would not rule out Chinese lanterns as being responsible for some of the sightings. When cloud is patchy and winds are blustery, he said the weather conditions can make one of these lanterns disappear at a fast rate.

Vice-chairman Pete Sherman said possible explanations for mysterious lights in the sky include light pollution from street lights, reflecting and lighting up low level cloud.

A bright light in the east/south-east direction may also be the planet Jupiter, he pointed out.

Spokesmen from RAF Lossiemouth and RAF Kinloss said there has been little to suggest that activity from either of the bases has been responsible for what has been witnessed recently.

NBC news station WVLA, Baton Rouge, feels it looks like a cross between a human and an animal, with long slender appendages and glowing eyes.

Perhaps tongue-in-cheek, the hunter says he just hopes it's a vegetarian, if he runs into it in the woods again.

The national media, via MSNBC, has widely shown this photograph on television.



Berwick is a town in St. Mary Parish (shown above), Louisiana, United States. The population was 4,418 at the 2000 census. The first white settler to trek through the wilderness in this area was Thomas Berwick, a surveyor from Pennsylvania who was working in Opelousas, Louisiana. He settled along the banks of the Atchafalaya River in the late 18th century. Today the town of Berwick is home to several seafood processing plants and numerous boat companies.

Nearby, relatively speaking, are the reports of the Honey Island Swamp monster, a hairy humanoid or anthropoid cryptid reported from Honey Island Swamp, Louisiana since 1963. To Native Americans, this cryptid is called Letiche. Cajun have named it the Tainted Keitre.



The Honey Island Swamp (French: *Marais de l'Île-de-Miel*) is a marshland located in the eastern portion of the U.S. state of Louisiana in St. Tammany Parish (above). Honey Island earned its name because of the honeybees once seen on a nearby isle. The swamp is bordered on the north by U.S. 90, on the south by Lake Borgne, on the east by the Pearl River and the west by the West Pearl River.
